Florida's Turnpike Enterprise to Hold Public Information Meeting for the Widening of Florida's Turnpike from North of SR 60 to South of Clay Whaley Road in Osceola County, FL

OCOEE, Fla. – The Florida Department of Transportation, Florida's Turnpike Enterprise will hold an Alternatives Public Information Meeting for the project to Widen Florida's Turnpike (SR 91) from north of SR 60 to south of Clay Whaley Road in Osceola County.

The Alternatives Public Information Meeting will be held at 6 p.m. on March 4, 2025 (virtual), and at 5:30 p.m. on March 5, 2025 (in-person) and March 11, 2025 (in-person).
