





About the Study

- Florida's Turnpike from north of SR 60 to south of Clay Whaley Road in Osceola County
- Approximately 45.5 miles
 (Mile Post 193 to Mile Post 238.5)
 - Rural Segment from SR 60 to just north of Canoe
 Creek Service Plaza
 - Urban Segment from north of Canoe Creek Service
 Plaza to south of Clay Whaley Road
- Evacuation Route

Purpose and Need

- Increase capacity
 - Rural Segment: three lanes in each direction
 - Urban Segment: four lanes in each direction
 - No-build alternative does not meet project's purpose and need
- Meet existing and future travel demands
- Address roadway deficiencies
- Improve safety, evacuation, and emergency response
