



Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 Widening Project from West Palm Beach Service Plaza to North of Southern Boulevard

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is widening Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 from the West Palm Beach Service Plaza (milepost 94) to north of Southern Boulevard/US 98/SR 80 (Exit 98) in Palm Beach County.

Project benefits include:

- Improving traffic flow with the addition of two lanes in each direction from the West Palm Beach Service Plaza (milepost 94) to north of Southern Boulevard/US 98/SR 80 (Exit 98).
- Enhancing connectivity by reconstructing the interchange at Southern Boulevard/SR 80.
- Increasing roadway longevity and resiliency with the reconstruction of the bridges at Forest Hill Boulevard/SR 882 and Belvedere Road.
- Strengthening safety with new highly reflective signing and pavement markings which will increase visibility in all lighting and weather conditions.

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction will take place during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience periodic construction light, noise, vibration, and dust through the project's duration. Florida's Turnpike Enterprise takes steps to reduce construction impacts and efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions.

Lane closures will generally take place during off peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers. Closures will be announced in advance in the South Florida and Treasure Coast Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.

Schedule and Funding

Work is anticipated to continue through early 2030.

Cost and Funding

The project cost is approximately \$258 million.

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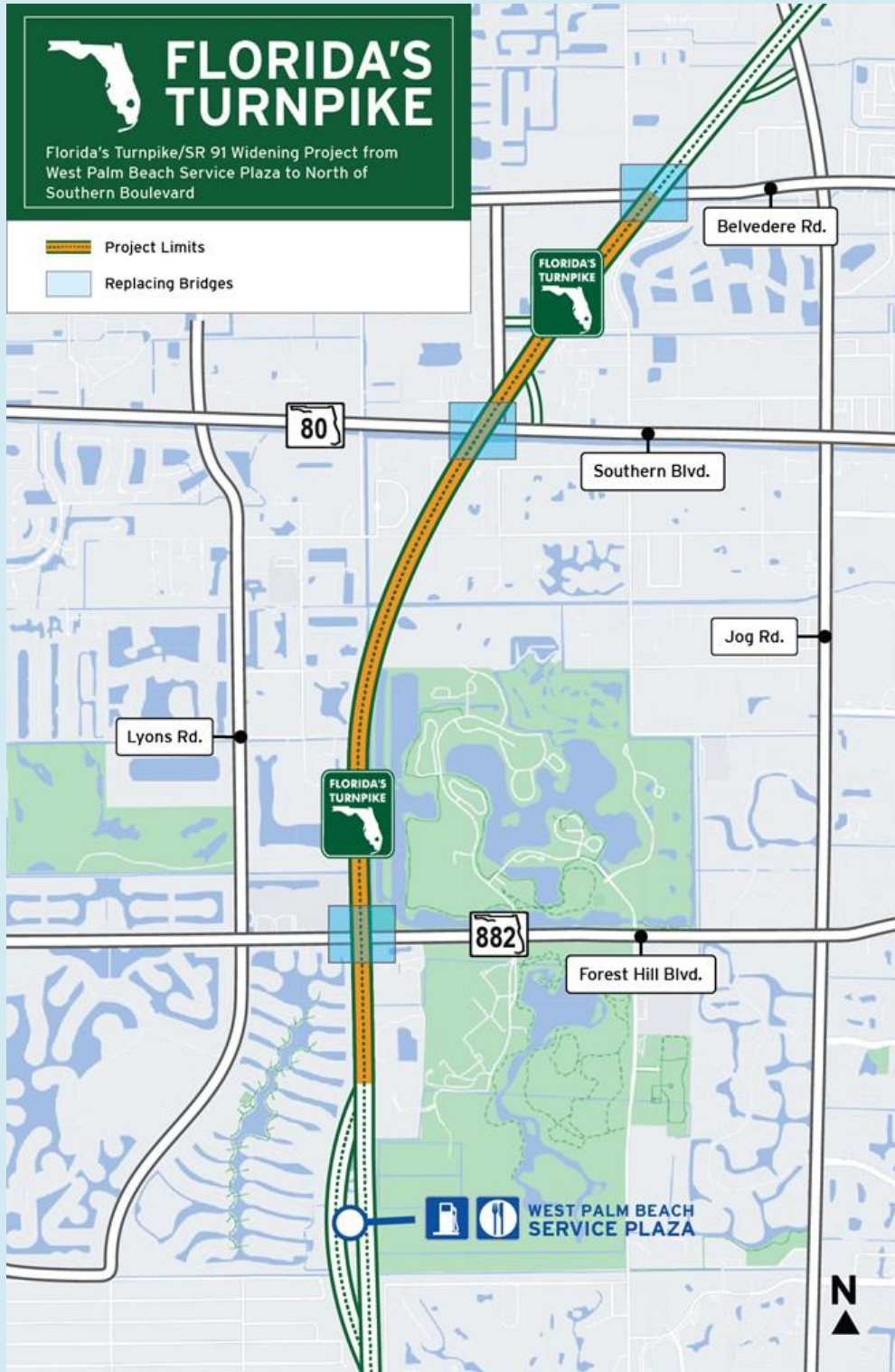
