

Florida's Turnpike Mainline/SR 91 Resurfacing and Safety Improvements Project from Milepost 169 to Milepost 178

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is resurfacing and making safety improvements to Florida's Turnpike Mainline/State Road (SR) 91 from milepost 169 to 178 in St. Lucie and Indian River counties.

Benefits from this project include:

- Increasing roadway longevity and resiliency by paving the road
- Improving roadside safety with the installation of new guardrail and rumble strips
- Improving drainage by upgrading existing drainage pipes
- Improving roadside safety with new highly reflective signing and pavement markings which will increase visibility in all lighting and weather conditions

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction will take place during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience periodic construction light, noise, vibration, and dust throughout the project's duration. Florida's Turnpike Enterprise takes steps to reduce construction impacts, and efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions.

Lane closures will generally take place during off-peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers. Closures will be announced in advance in the South Florida and Treasure Coast Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.
