FORT LAUDERDALE, Fla. — <u>Florida's Turnpike Enterprise</u> announces lane closures and work zone information for construction and maintenance projects in Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Martin, St. Lucie, Okeechobee and Indian River counties, for the week beginning Sunday, April 6. Motorists should drive with caution through the work zones and adhere to posted detour signs and speed limits. Please pay special attention to the closures noted in red.

Tandem truckers should also pay special attention to the closures noted in red which include full road and ramp closures and closures of special significance.

TURNPIKE EXTENSION/SR 821 (Mileposts 0 to 47) MIAMI-DADE and BROWARD COUNTIES

TURNPIKE EXTENSION/SR 821 WIDENING PROJECT FROM NW 106 STREET TO INTERSTATE 75 (I-75)

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 between NW 106 Street and I-75 (Milepost 34 to Milepost 39)

Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, April 6, and nightly through Thursday, April 10.

Eastbound and westbound Okeechobee Road between NW 138 Street and NW 118 Avenue

Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, April 6, and nightly through Thursday, April 10.

Eastbound and westbound Frontage Road between NW 138 Street and NW 107 Avenue

Overnight flagging operations, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, April 6, and nightly through Thursday, April 10. * *Please note, access to businesses will be maintained.*

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 is being widened to 10 lanes between NW 106 Street and I-75. The project entails constructing a new eastbound Okeechobee Road to southbound Florida's Turnpike entrance ramp and a new northbound Florida's Turnpike exit ramp to eastbound Okeechobee Road, as well as an additional lane in each direction on Okeechobee Road between west of the Turnpike and NW 107 Avenue. Work also consists of constructing a new diverging diamond interchange at Florida's Turnpike and NW 170 Street. Resurfacing, guardrail and fencing, lane striping, stormwater drainage, signage and lighting improvements will also be performed as part of this project. Construction will continue through late 2025. Approximate cost: \$370 million.

SOUTHERN TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 (Mileposts 0X to 86) and SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869 MIAMI-DADE, BROWARD, and PALM BEACH COUNTIES

GOLDEN GLADES INTERCHANGE (GGI) PROJECT

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Miami Gardens Drive/NW 183 Street and I-95

Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, April 6, and nightly through Thursday, April 10.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 TSM&O PROJECT FROM TURNPIKE EXTENSION/SR 821 TO GRIFFIN ROAD/SR 818

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Turnpike Extension/SR 821 and Griffin Road/SR 818 (Milepost 47 to Milepost 54)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, April 6, and nightly through Thursday, April 10.

Overnight multiple lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, April 6, and nightly through Thursday, April 10.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Auxiliary Lanes are being added to Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 from the Turnpike Extension/SR 821 to Griffin Road/SR 818. This project will increase roadway capacity, reduce congestion and improve travel times. The project also includes safety improvements at Hollywood Boulevard/SR 820 and SW 63 Terrace by closing the median to reduce vehicle conflict points and accidents, and at Hollywood Boulevard and S. 62 Avenue by eliminating the eastbound and westbound turn lanes. Construction will continue through mid-2029. Approximate cost: \$230 million.

SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869 AND ATLANTIC BOULEVARD INTERCHANGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

Northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 at Atlantic Boulevard (Exit 8)

Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, April 6, and nightly through Thursday, April 10.

Northbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 exit ramp to Atlantic Boulevard (Exit 8)

Overnight full ramp closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Tuesday, April 8, and nightly through Thursday, April 10.

Detour information:

 Northbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 traffic wishing to access Atlantic Boulevard (Exit 8) will be directed to exit at Commercial Boulevard/SR 870 (Exit 5), travel east on Commercial Boulevard to Coral Ridge Drive/NW 100 Avenue/Nob Hill Road and travel north on Coral Ridge Drive to access Atlantic Boulevard.

Eastbound and westbound Atlantic Boulevard underneath Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869

Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, April 6, and nightly through Thursday, April 10.

Daytime single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday, April 7, and daily through Friday, April 11.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 is being widened from six to 10 lanes from north of Commercial Boulevard (Exit 5) to north of Atlantic Boulevard (Exit 8). The new lanes constructed as part of this project will open upon completion of future adjacent widening projects. Work includes reconstructing the northbound and southbound entrance and exit ramps at Atlantic Boulevard, widening Atlantic Boulevard from two to three lanes and adding bike lanes, and stormwater management enhancements and modifications to the pond west of the roadway. Construction will continue through early 2026. Approximate cost: \$72.5 million.

SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869 WIDENING PROJECT FROM ATLANTIC BOULEVARD TO SAMPLE ROAD/SR 834

Northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 between north of Atlantic Boulevard and north of Sample Road/SR 834 (Milepost 9 to Milepost 12)

Overnight single and double lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, April 6, and nightly through Thursday, April 10.

Southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 entrance and exit ramps at Sample Road/SR 834 (Exit 11)

Overnight full ramp closures, 11:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, April 7, and nightly through Thursday, April 10.

Detour information:

- Sample Road/SR 834 traffic wishing to access southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 will be
 directed to Coral Ridge Drive, travel south on Coral Ridge Drive to Atlantic Boulevard/SR 814, and

Daytime single and double lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, April 7, and daily through Friday, April 11.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 is being widened from six to 10 lanes from north of Atlantic Boulevard to north of Sample Road/SR 834, in Broward County. The new lanes constructed as part of this project will open upon completion of future adjacent widening projects. The Sample Road interchange will be converted to a partial diverging diamond interchange. Construction will continue through early 2028. Approximate cost: \$99.7 million.

SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869 RESURFACING AND ROADSIDE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM US 441/SR 7 TO FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91

Northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 between south of US 441/SR 7 and Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 (Milepost 18 to Milepost 21)

Overnight single and double lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, April 6, and nightly through Thursday, April 10.

Northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 entrance ramps from Lyons Road Overnight single lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, April 6, and nightly through Thursday, April 10.

Northbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 exit ramps to northbound and southbound US 441/SR 7 (Exit 18A and 18B)

Overnight full ramp closures, 9:30 p.m. to 8:30 a.m., Sunday, April 6, and nightly through Thursday, April 10.

Detour information:

- Northbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 traffic wishing to access northbound US 441/SR 7
 (Exit 18B) will be directed to exit at Lyons Road (Exit 19), travel north on Lyons Road to Hillsboro

 (Exit 18A) will be directed to exit at Lyons Road (Exit 19), travel south on Lyons Road to Sample
 Road/SR 834, and travel west on Sample Road to access southbound US 441.

Northbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 entrance and exit ramps at Lyons Road (Exit 19) Overnight full ramp closures, 9:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, April 6, and nightly through Thursday, April 10.

Detour information:

- Northbound Lyons Road traffic wishing to access northbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 will
 be directed to Johnson Road, travel west on Johnson Road to US 441/SR 7, and travel south on
 US 441 to access northbound Sawgrass Expressway.
- Southbound Lyons Road traffic wishing to access northbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 will be directed to Sample Road/SR 834, travel east on Sample Road to Powerline Road/SR 845, and travel north on Powerline Road to access SW 10 Street.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 is being resurfaced from US 441/SR 7 to Florida's Turnpike/SR 91, in Broward County. Construction will continue through late 2025. Approximate cost: \$21 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 BRIDGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT OVER HILLSBORO CANAL IN BROWARD COUNTY

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 at Milepost 73

Overnight single lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 6:30 a.m., Sunday, April 6, and nightly through Thursday, April 10.

Overnight double lane closures, 10:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, April 6, and nightly through Thursday, April 10.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 bridges are being improved over the Hillsboro canal (milepost 73) in Broward County. Construction will continue through late 2025. Approximate cost: \$6 million.

CENTRAL TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 (Mileposts 86 to 188) PALM BEACH, MARTIN, ST. LUCIE, and OKEECHOBEE COUNTIES

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 AND BOYNTON BEACH BOULEVARD/SR 804 INTERCHANGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 at Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 (Milepost 86 to Milepost 87)

Overnight single lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 6:30 a.m., Sunday, April 6, and nightly through Thursday, April 10.

Overnight multiple lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, April 6, and nightly through Thursday, April 10.

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 exit ramp to Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 (Exit 86) Overnight full ramp closures, 11 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, April 6, and nightly through Thursday, April 10.

Detour information:

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804
(Exit 86) will be directed to exit at Atlantic Avenue/SR 806 (Exit 81), travel west on Atlantic Avenue
to US 441/SR 7, and travel north on US 441 to access Boynton Beach Boulevard.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 and Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 (Exit 86) interchange is undergoing significant enhancements to improve traffic flow and safety. This project includes: a new westbound turn lane from Boynton Beach Boulevard to northbound Florida's Turnpike and an additional lane from the northbound Florida's Turnpike exit ramp to Boynton Beach Boulevard. Safety upgrades feature the installation of new highly reflective overhead signage and pavement markings, designed for optimal visibility in all lighting and weather conditions. Construction is scheduled to continue through late 2025, with an approximate cost of \$9.5 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM NORTH OF BOYNTON BEACH BOULEVARD/SR 804 TO NORTH OF LAKE WORTH ROAD/SR 802

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 and north of Lake Worth Road/SR 802 (Milepost 87 to Milepost 95)

Overnight single lane closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, April 6, to 5 a.m. Monday, April 7. Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, April 7, and nightly through Thursday, April 10.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being widened to four lanes in each direction, from north of Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 to north of Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804. This project also includes reconstructing the Hypoluxo Road bridge over Southern Turnpike Mainline to allow for the new road configuration. Additionally, sound barrier walls will be constructed along qualifying residential areas. Bridge widening, road milling and resurfacing, signage and signal improvements are planned. Construction will continue through mid-2025. Approximate cost: \$170 million.

WEST PALM BEACH SERVICE PLAZA PARKING IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between south of Lake Worth Road/SR 802 and south of Southern Boulevard/US 98/SR 80 (Milepost 93 to Milepost 95)

Overnight intermittent single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, April 6, and nightly through Thursday, April 10.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The truck parking facility at the West Palm Beach Service Plaza is being improved. Truck parking will be consolidated in the northern section of the service plaza to enhance traffic flow and increase the number of available truck spaces. Construction will continue through late 2026. Approximate cost: \$32.4 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM WEST PALM BEACH SERVICE PLAZA TO NORTH OF SOUTHERN BOULEVARD/US 98/SR 80

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between West Palm Beach Service Plaza and north of Southern Boulevard/US 98/SR 80 (Milepost 94 to Milepost 98)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, April 6, and nightly through Thursday, April 10.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being widened from two to four lanes in each direction, from West Palm Beach Service Plaza to north of Southern Boulevard/US 98/SR 80 in Palm Beach County. This project includes reconstructing the Turnpike bridges over Forest Hill Boulevard/SR 882, Southern Boulevard, and Belvedere Road. Additionally, sound barrier walls will be constructed along qualifying residential areas. Safety upgrades feature the installation of new highly reflective

overhead signage and pavement markings, designed for optimal visibility in all lighting and weather conditions. Construction will continue through early 2030. Approximate cost: \$258 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 RESURFACING AND ROADSIDE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM MILEPOST 169 TO MILEPOST 178

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Milepost 169 and Milepost 178 Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 7 a.m., Sunday, April 6, and nightly through Thursday, April 10.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being resurfaced and the roadside improved from milepost 169 to milepost 178, in St. Lucie and Indian River counties. Construction will continue through late 2025. Approximate cost: \$25 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 ELECTRONIC TOLLING CONVERSION PROJECT PHASE 8 FROM LANTANA TOLL PLAZA TO THREE LAKES TOLL PLAZA

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between north of Beeline Highway/SR 710 (Exit 107) and south of PGA Boulevard/SR 704 (Exit 109)

Overnight single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, April 6, and nightly through Thursday, April 10.

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between north of Port St. Lucie Boulevard (Exit 142) and south of Okeechobee Road/SR 70/Ft. Pierce (Exit 152)

Overnight single lane closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, April 6, to 6 a.m. Monday, April 7. Overnight single lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, April 7, and nightly through Thursday, April 10.

and travel south on I-95 to exit at Okeechobee Road/Ft. Pierce/SR 70 (Exit 129).

Construction will continue through mid-2025. Approximate cost: \$107 million.

- Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 traffic wishing to access southbound University Drive/NW 27 Avenue/SR 817 (Exit 47) will be directed to exit at Red Road/NW 57 Avenue/SR 823 (Exit 43), travel south on NW 57 Avenue to NW 199 Street and travel east on NW 199 Street Drive to access NW 27 Avenue.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The queue warning system is being enhanced along the Turnpike system throughout Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Orange, Osceola, Sumter, and Hillsborough counties. Installation will occur along the Turnpike Extension/SR 821, Florida's Turnpike/SR 91, Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869, Daniel Webster Western Beltway/SR 429, and Veterans Expressway/SR 589. The system will alert motorists in advance of queueing or stopped traffic on the mainline that is backing up from specific congested interchanges through the Turnpike system. Construction will continue through early 2025. Approximate cost: \$6.8 million.
