TURNPIKE EXTENSION/SR 821 WIDENING PROJECT **FROM NW 106 STREET TO INTERSTATE 75 (I-75)**

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 between NW 106 Street and I-75 **(Milepost 34 to Milepost 39)**

Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, April 27, and nightly through Thursday, May 1.

Eastbound and westbound Okeechobee Road between NW 138 Street and NW 118 Avenue

Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, April 27, and nightly through Thursday, May 1.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 is being widened to 10 lanes between NW 106 Street and I-75. The project entails constructing a new eastbound Okeechobee Road to southbound Florida's Turnpike entrance ramp and a new northbound Florida's Turnpike exit ramp to eastbound Okeechobee Road, as well as an additional lane in each direction on Okeechobee Road between west of the Turnpike and NW 107 Avenue. Work also consists of constructing a new diverging diamond interchange at Florida's Turnpike and NW 170 Street. Resurfacing, guardrail and fencing, lane striping, stormwater drainage, signage and lighting improvements will also be performed as part of this project. Construction will continue through late 2025. Approximate cost: \$370 million.

and SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869

GOLDEN GLADES INTERCHANGE (GGI) PROJECT

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Miami Gardens Drive/NW 183 Street and I-95

Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, April 27, and nightly through Friday, May 2.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 TSM&O PROJECT
FROM TURNPIKE EXTENSION/SR 821 TO GRIFFIN ROAD/SR 818

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Turnpike Extension/SR 821 and Griffin Road/SR 818 (Milepost 47 to Milepost 54)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, April 27, and nightly through Thursday, May 1.
Overnight double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, April 27, and nightly through Thursday, May 1.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Auxiliary Lanes are being added to Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 from the Turnpike Extension/SR 821 to Griffin Road/SR 818. This project will increase roadway capacity, reduce congestion and improve travel times. The project also includes safety improvements at Hollywood Boulevard/SR 820 and SW 63 Terrace by closing the median to reduce vehicle conflict points and accidents, and at Hollywood Boulevard and S. 62 Avenue by eliminating the eastbound and westbound turn lanes. Construction will continue through mid-2029. Approximate cost: \$230 million.

SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869 AND ATLANTIC BOULEVARD
INTERCHANGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

Northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 at Atlantic Boulevard (Exit 8)

Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, April 27, and nightly through Thursday, May 1.

Northbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 entrance ramp from Atlantic Boulevard

Overnight full ramp closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Tuesday, April 29, and nightly through Thursday, May 1.

Detour information:

- Atlantic Boulevard traffic wishing to access northbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 will be directed to Coral Ridge Drive, travel north Coral Ridge Drive to Sample Road/SR 834, and travel west on Sample Road to access northbound Sawgrass Expressway.

Eastbound and westbound Atlantic Boulevard underneath Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869

Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, April 27, and nightly through Thursday, May 1.

Daytime single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday, April 28, and daily through Friday, May 2.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 is being widened from six to 10 lanes from north of Commercial Boulevard (Exit 5) to north of Atlantic Boulevard (Exit 8). The new lanes constructed as part of this project will open upon completion of future adjacent widening projects. Work includes reconstructing the northbound and southbound entrance and exit ramps at Atlantic Boulevard, widening Atlantic Boulevard from two to three lanes and adding bike lanes, and stormwater management enhancements and modifications to the pond west of the roadway. Construction will continue through early 2026. Approximate cost: \$72.5 million.

**SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869 WIDENING
PROJECT FROM ATLANTIC BOULEVARD TO SAMPLE ROAD/SR 834**

Northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 between north of Atlantic Boulevard and north of Sample Road/SR 834 (Milepost 9 to Milepost 12)

Overnight single and double lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, April 27, and nightly through Thursday, May 1.

Southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 entrance and exit ramps at Sample Road/SR 834 (Exit 11)

Overnight full ramp closures, 11:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, April 27, and nightly through Thursday, May 1.

Detour information:

- Sample Road/SR 834 traffic wishing to access southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 will be directed to Coral Ridge Drive, travel south on Coral Ridge Drive to Atlantic Boulevard/SR 814, and travel west on Atlantic Boulevard to access southbound Sawgrass Expressway.
- Southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 traffic wishing to access Sample Road/SR 834 (Exit 11) will be directed to exit at Coral Ridge Drive (Exit 14), and travel south on Coral Ridge Drive to access Sample Road.

Eastbound and westbound Sample Road/SR 834 between Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 and west of Sportsplex Drive

Daytime single and double lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., Sunday, April 27, and daily through Friday, May 2.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 is being widened from six to 10 lanes from north of Atlantic Boulevard to north of Sample Road/SR 834, in Broward County. The new lanes constructed as part of this project will open upon completion of future adjacent widening projects. The Sample Road interchange will be converted to a partial diverging diamond interchange. Construction will continue through early 2028. Approximate cost: \$99.7 million.

**SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869 RESURFACING AND ROADSIDE IMPROVEMENTS
PROJECT FROM US 441/SR 7 TO FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91**

Northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 between south of US 441/SR 7 and Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 (Milepost 18 to Milepost 21)

Overnight single and double lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, April 27, and nightly through Thursday, May 1.

Northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 entrance ramps from Lyons Road

Overnight single lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, April 27, and nightly through Thursday, May 1.

Northbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 exit ramps to northbound and southbound US 441/SR 7 (Exit 18A and 18B)

Overnight full ramp closures, 7:30 p.m. to 8:30 a.m., Sunday, April 27, and nightly through Thursday, May 1.

Detour information:

- Northbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 traffic wishing to access northbound US 441/SR 7 (Exit 18B) will be directed to exit at Lyons Road (Exit 19), travel north on Lyons Road to Hillsboro Boulevard/SR 810, and travel west on Hillsboro Boulevard to access northbound US 441.
- Northbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 traffic wishing to access southbound US 441/SR 7 (Exit 18A) will be directed to exit at Lyons Road (Exit 19), travel south on Lyons Road to Sample Road/SR 834, and travel west on Sample Road to access southbound US 441.

** Please note, the Lyons Road (Exit 19) entrance and exit ramps will remain open during this closure.*

Southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 entrance ramp from southbound US 441/SR 7

Overnight full ramp closures, 7:30 p.m. to 8:30 a.m., Sunday, April 27, and nightly through Thursday, May 1.

Detour information:

- Southbound US 441/SR 7 traffic wishing to access southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 will be directed to Sample Road/SR 834, travel east on Sample Road to Lyons Road, and travel north on Lyons Road to access southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869.

** Please note, the Lyons Road (Exit 19) entrance and exit ramps will remain open during this closure.*

Northbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 entrance and exit ramps at Lyons Road (Exit 19)

Overnight full ramp closures, 9:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, April 27, and nightly through Thursday, May 1.

Detour information:

- Northbound Lyons Road traffic wishing to access northbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 will be directed to Johnson Road, travel west on Johnson Road to US 441/SR 7, and travel south on US 441 to access northbound Sawgrass Expressway.

- Southbound Lyons Road traffic wishing to access northbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 will be directed to Sample Road/SR 834, travel east on Sample Road to Powerline Road/SR 845, and travel north on Powerline Road to access SW 10 Street.
- Northbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 traffic wishing to access Lyons Road (Exit 19) will be directed to exit at US 441/SR 7 South (Exit 18A), travel south on US 441 to Sample Road/SR 834, and travel east on Sample Road to access Lyons Road.

**FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 BRIDGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT
OVER HILLSBORO CANAL IN BROWARD COUNTY**

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 at Milepost 73

Overnight single lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 6:30 a.m., Sunday, April 27, and nightly through Thursday, May 1.

Overnight double lane closures, 10:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, April 27, and nightly through Thursday, May 1.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 bridges are being improved over the Hillsboro canal (milepost 73) in Broward County. Construction will continue through late 2025. Approximate cost: \$6 million.

**FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 AND BOYNTON BEACH BOULEVARD/SR 804
INTERCHANGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT**

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 at Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 (Milepost 86 to Milepost 87)

Overnight single lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m., Sunday, April 27, and nightly through Thursday, May 1.

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 at Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 (Milepost 86 to Milepost 87)

Overnight multiple lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 p.m., Sunday, April 27, and nightly through Thursday, May 1.

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 exit ramp to Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 (Exit 86)

Overnight full ramp closures, 11 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, April 27, and nightly through Thursday, May 1.

Detour information:

- Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 (Exit 86) will be directed to exit at Atlantic Avenue/SR 806 (Exit 81), travel west on Atlantic Avenue to US 441/SR 7, and travel north on US 441 to access Boynton Beach Boulevard.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 and Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 (Exit 86) interchange is undergoing significant enhancements to improve traffic flow and safety. This project includes: a new westbound turn lane from Boynton Beach Boulevard to northbound Florida's Turnpike and an additional lane from the northbound Florida's Turnpike exit ramp to Boynton Beach Boulevard. Safety upgrades feature the installation of new highly reflective overhead signage and pavement markings, designed for optimal visibility in all lighting and weather conditions. Construction is scheduled to continue through late 2025, with an approximate cost of \$9.5 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM NORTH OF BOYNTON BEACH BOULEVARD/SR 804 TO NORTH OF LAKE WORTH ROAD/SR 802

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 and north of Lake Worth Road/SR 802 (Milepost 87 to Milepost 95)

Overnight single lane closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, April 27, to 5 a.m. Monday, April 28.

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, April 28, and nightly through Thursday, May 1.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being widened to four lanes in each direction, from north of Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 to north of Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804. This project also includes reconstructing the Hypoluxo Road bridge over Southern Turnpike Mainline to allow for the new road configuration. Additionally, sound barrier walls will be constructed along qualifying residential areas. Bridge widening, road milling and resurfacing, signage and signal improvements are planned. Construction will continue through mid-2025. Approximate cost: \$170 million.

WEST PALM BEACH SERVICE PLAZA PARKING IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between south of Lake Worth Road/SR 802 and south of Southern Boulevard/US 98/SR 80 (Milepost 94 to Milepost 95)

Overnight intermittent single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, April 27, and nightly through Thursday, May 1.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The truck parking facility at the West Palm Beach Service Plaza is being improved. Truck parking will be consolidated in the northern section of the service plaza to enhance traffic flow and increase the number of available truck spaces. Construction will continue through late 2026. Approximate cost: \$32.4 million.

**FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM
WEST PALM BEACH SERVICE PLAZA TO NORTH OF SOUTHERN BOULEVARD/US 98/SR 80**

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between West Palm Beach Service Plaza and north of Southern Boulevard/US 98/SR 80 (Milepost 94 to Milepost 98)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, April 27, and nightly through Thursday, May 1.

Eastbound and westbound Southern Boulevard/US 98/SR 80 underneath Florida's Turnpike/SR 91

Overnight double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 7 a.m. Monday, April 27, and nightly through Thursday, May 1.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being widened from two to four lanes in each direction, from West Palm Beach Service Plaza to north of Southern Boulevard/US 98/SR 80 in Palm Beach County. This project includes reconstructing the Turnpike bridges over Forest Hill Boulevard/SR 882, Southern Boulevard, and Belvedere Road. Additionally, sound barrier walls will be constructed along qualifying residential areas. Safety upgrades feature the installation of new highly reflective overhead signage and pavement markings, designed for optimal visibility in all lighting and weather conditions. Construction will continue through early 2030. Approximate cost: \$258 million.

**FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 RESURFACING AND ROADSIDE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT
FROM MILEPOST 169 TO MILEPOST 178**

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Milepost 169 and Milepost 178

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 7 a.m., Sunday, April 27, and nightly through Thursday, May 1.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being resurfaced and the roadside improved from milepost 169 to milepost 178, in St. Lucie and Indian River counties. Construction will continue through late 2025. Approximate cost: \$25 million.

**FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 ELECTRONIC TOLLING CONVERSION PROJECT PHASE 8
FROM LANTANA TOLL PLAZA TO THREE LAKES TOLL PLAZA**

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being converted to an Electronic Tolling Collection system from milepost 88 to milepost 236. This project includes the installation of new gantries on the mainline, removal of the existing mainline and existing toll plazas on the interchange ramps and addition of several new Dynamic Message Signs. Construction will continue through mid-2025. Approximate cost: \$107 million.

MIAMI-DADE, BROWARD, and PALM BEACH COUNTIES

**SYSTEM-WIDE QUEUE WARNING SYSTEM
ENHANCEMENTS PROJECT**

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The queue warning system is being enhanced along the Turnpike system throughout Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Orange, Osceola, Sumter, and Hillsborough counties. Installation will occur along the Turnpike Extension/SR 821, Florida's Turnpike/SR 91, Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869, Daniel Webster Western Beltway/SR 429, and Veterans Expressway/SR 589. The system will alert motorists in advance of queueing or stopped traffic on the mainline that is backing up from specific congested interchanges through the Turnpike system. Construction will continue through early 2025. Approximate cost: \$6.8 million.
