Ocoee, Fla. — The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), Florida's Turnpike Enterprise will hold a Corridor Alternatives Public Information Meeting for the **Alternative Corridor Evaluation for Central Polk Parkway East from SR 60 to US 17/92 in Polk County (Financial Project Identification Number 451419-2)**.

The Corridor Alternatives Public Information Meeting will be held at 6:00 p.m. on Monday, May 5, 2025 (virtual), and from 4:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. on Wednesday, May 7, 2025 (in-person).
