

Turnpike Extensions/SR 821 and Surface Street improvements from Hainlin Mill Road to US1

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is improving the existing interchange Florida's Turnpike Extension/SR 821 from Hainlin Mill Road/SW 216th Street to Caribbean Boulevard/SW 200th Street in Miami-Dade County.

Benefits from this project include:

- Improving traffic flow by widening Hainlin Mill Road, Cutler Ridge Boulevard, and the northbound Turnpike bridge over Caribbean Boulevard.
- Enhancing driving conditions by resurfacing interchange ramps, westbound Eureka Drive (including a leftturn lane extension), and the southbound Turnpike frontage road from SW 184 Street to north of Caribbean Boulevard.
- Increasing roadway resilience by repairing five bridges within the project limits, including widening the bridge over Caribbean Boulevard.
- Increasing roadside safety and reducing impacts by constructing new noise walls at six locations and upgrade corridor lighting and Intelligent Transportation Systems

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction will take place during both daytime and night-time hours. Lane closures will generally take place during off-peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers. Efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions, but lane closures, ramp closures and detours will be necessary to accomplish the improvements.

Closures will be announced in advance in Florida's Turnpike weekly traffic advisory.

Schedule and Funding

Construction Schedule

Work is anticipated to continue through mid-2027.

Cost and Funding The project cost is approximately \$42 million.
