Project Needs & Benefits

- Adds capacity for future travel demand
- Improves travel time reliability, safety, and regional mobility options in the Treasure Coast
- Relieves interchange congestion at connections from local streets
- Facilitates traffic movement during emergency response and evacuation periods

Project Description

This project constructs a new interchange, connecting Turnpike Mainline / SR 91 with I-95 at Bridge Rd (MP 125-126) in Martin County. The new interchange facilities direct access between the Turnpike Mainline and I-95 to improve regional connectivity.

The estimated construction cost for this project is unknown at this time. Additional Right-of-Way is anticipated to be needed for the construction of the interchange.

Project Status

A Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study is currently underway. Design and construction for this project are not yet programmed in the Five-Year Work Program.
