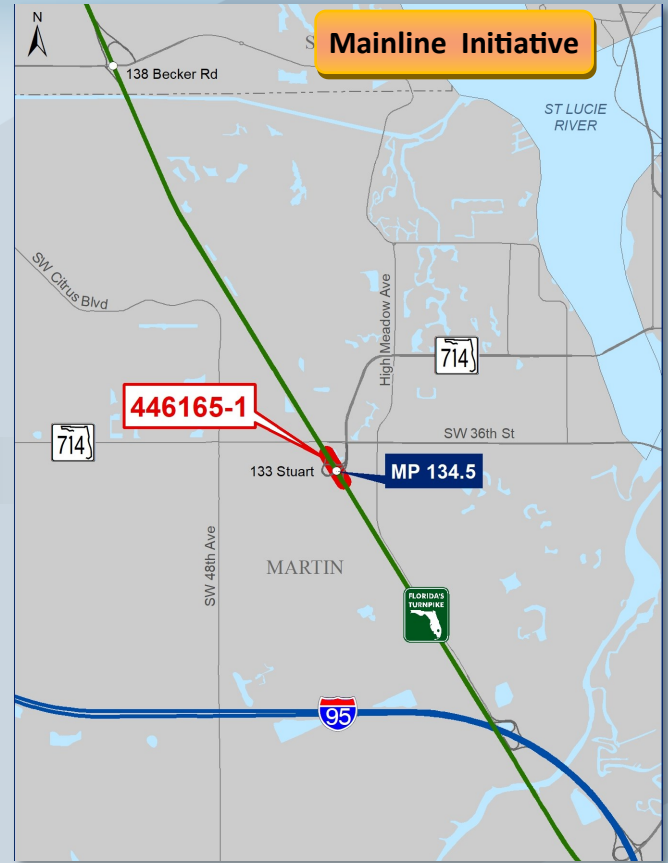


Fast Facts

Project Needs & Benefits

- ✓ Adds capacity for future travel demand
- ✓ Improves travel time reliability, safety, and regional mobility options in the Treasure Coast
- ✓ Relieves interchange congestion at connections from local streets
- ✓ Facilitates traffic movement during emergency response and evacuation periods



Project Description

This project improves the interchange at Turnpike Mainline / SR 91 and SW Martin Highway / SR 714 (MP 134.5) in Martin County. The new interchange accommodates the eight lane mainline widening and provides improved traffic flow.

The estimated construction cost for this project is approximately \$158 million. Additional Right-of-Way is anticipated to be needed for the construction of the interchange.

Project Status

A Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study was completed in March 2022. Design for this project is programmed in FY 2024 and is anticipated to take up to four years to complete, which includes utility coordination, permitting, and Right-of-Way acquisition. Construction for this project is not yet programmed in the Five-Year Work Program.
