

Turnpike Mainline Widening from Midway Rd to SR 70 (MP 149-154) (FPID 446580-1)

Project Needs & Benefits

- ✓ Adds capacity for future travel demand

- Relieves interchange congestion at connections from local streets
- ✓ Facilitates traffic movement during emergency response and evacuation periods



Project Description

This project widens Turnpike Mainline / SR 91 from Midway Rd (MP 149) to Okeechobee Rd / SR 70 (MP 152) in St. Lucie County. The interchanges at Midway Rd and Okeechobee Rd / SR 70 will be improved. The modified interchanges will provide improved traffic flow.

The estimated construction cost for this project is approximately \$191 million. Additional Right-of-Way is anticipated to be needed for the construction of the interchanges and for offsite stormwater ponds.

Project Status

A Project Development and Environment (PD&E) Study was completed in March 2022. Design for this project is programmed in FY 2026 and is anticipated to take up to four years to complete, which includes utility coordination, permitting, and Right-of-Way acquisition. Construction for this project is not yet programmed in the Five-Year Work Program.
