



Polk Parkway/SR 570 Resurfacing and Roadside Improvements Project from west of Lakeland Highlands Road to south of US 92

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is resurfacing Polk Parkway/State Road (SR 570) from west of Lakeland Highlands Road (milepost 8) to south of US 92 (milepost 17) in Polk County.

This project is designed to extend the life of the roadway, enhance safety, and improve roadside conditions.

Benefits of this project include:

- Extending roadway life and resiliency by paving Polk Parkway and the ramps at US 98, Lakeland Highlands Road, and Winter Lake Road/SR 540
- Enhancing roadside safety with the installation of new guardrail and rumble strips
- Improving drainage by upgrading existing drainage pipes
- Increasing visibility with new highly reflective signs and pavement markings

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction will take place during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience periodic construction noise, vibration, and dust. The Enterprise takes steps to reduce construction impacts and efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions.

Lane closures will generally take place during off-peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers. Closures and detours will be announced in advance in the Central and West Central Florida Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.

Schedule and Funding

Construction Schedule

Work is anticipated to continue through mid-2026.

Cost and Funding

The project cost is approximately \$20 million.

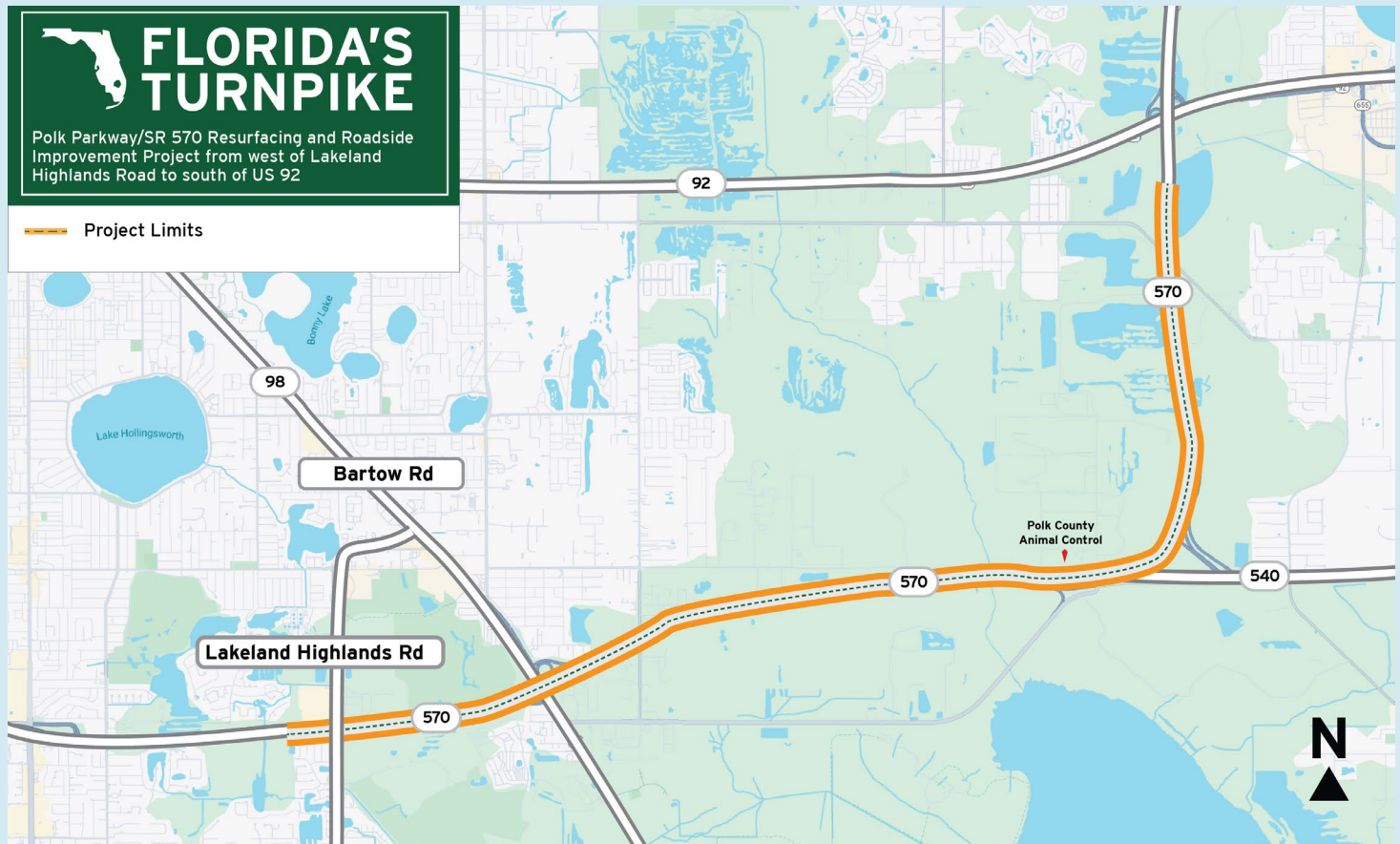
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
