OCOEE, Fla. – Florida's Turnpike Enterprise announces lane closures and work zone information for construction and maintenance projects in Central Florida beginning Sunday, June 15. Motorists should drive with caution through work zones and adhere to posted detour signs and speed limits. Please pay special attention to the closures noted in red.

Tandem truckers should also pay special attention to the closures noted in red which include full road and ramp closures and closures of special significance.

CENTRAL TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 (Mileposts 188 to 240) OSCEOLA COUNTY

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 ELECTRONIC TOLLING CONVERSION PROJECT PHASE 8 FROM LANTANA TOLL PLAZA TO THREE LAKES TOLL PLAZA

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Milepost 235 and Milepost 236

Overnight single lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, June 16, and nightly through Thursday, June 19.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being converted to an Electronic Tolling Collection system from milepost 88 to milepost 236. This project includes the installation of new gantries on the mainline, removal of the existing mainline and existing toll plazas on the interchange ramps and addition of several new Dynamic Message Signs. Construction will continue through mid-2025. Approximate cost: \$107 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM CLAY WHALEY ROAD TO US 192 AND W. NOLTE ROAD INTERCHANGE

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Clay Whaley Road and US 192 (Milepost 239 to Milepost 242)

Daytime shoulder closures, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday, June 16, and daily through Friday, June 20.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being widened from two to four lanes in each direction, from Clay Whaley Road (formerly Kissimmee Park Road) to US 192 in Osceola County. This project includes constructing a new interchange at W. Nolte Road and removing the existing ramps at Clay Whaley Road once the new interchange is open to traffic. Construction will continue through early 2029. Approximate cost: \$193 million.

NORTHERN TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 (Mileposts 240 to 309) OSCEOLA, ORANGE, SEMINOLE, BRVARD, LAKE, and SUMTER COUNTIES

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 AND SAND LAKE ROAD/SR 482 INTERCHANGE DEVELOPMENT PROJECT

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Beachline Expressway/SR 528 and Interstate 4 (Milepost 255 to Milepost 258)

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, June 15, and nightly through Thursday, June 19.

Daytime shoulder closures, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday, June 16, and daily through Friday, June 20.

Eastbound Sand Lake Road/SR 482 between John Young Parkway/SR 423 and Chancellor Drive

Overnight single lane closures, 7 p.m. to 7 a.m., Sunday, June 15, and nightly through Thursday, June 19.

Daytime shoulder closures, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday, June 16, and daily through Friday, June 20. Long-term single lane closure through late 2027.

Westbound Sand Lake Road/SR 482 between Chancellor Drive and John Young Parkway/SR 423

Overnight double lane closures, 7 p.m. to 7 a.m., Sunday, June 15, and nightly through Thursday, June 19.

Daytime single lane and shoulder closures, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday, June 16, and daily through Friday, June 20.

Long-term single lane closure through late 2027.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: A new interchange will be constructed at Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 and Sand Lake Road/SR 482 in Orange County. The project includes enhancing connectivity by constructing a new interchange at Sand Lake Road, increasing roadway longevity and resiliency with the reconstruction of the Sand Lake Road bridge to accommodate new ramps, improving traffic flow by enhancing the intersection of Presidents Drive and Sand Lake Road and providing sidewalks from John Young Parkway to Presidents Drive. Construction will continue through late 2027. Approximate cost: \$114.6 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM CLERMONT/SR 50 TO MINNEOLA/HANCOCK ROAD

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Clermont/SR 50 and Minneola/Hancock Road (Milepost 273 to Milepost 279)

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, June 15, and nightly through Thursday, June 19.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance ramp from W. Colonial Drive/SR 50

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, June 15, and nightly through Thursday, June 19.

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 exit ramp to W. Colonial Drive/SR 50/Winter Garden/Clermont (Exit 272)

Overnight full ramp closures, 10 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Monday, June 16, and nightly through Thursday, June 19.

Detour Information:

 Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access W. Colonial Drive/SR 50/Winter Garden/Clermont (Exit 272) will be directed to exit at Ocoee/SR 50 (Exit 267B).

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being widened from four to eight lanes from Clermont/SR 50 to Minneola/Hancock Road in Lake and Orange counties. This project includes constructing a new Fosgate Road bridge over the Turnpike. The CR 438 and CR 455 bridges will be replaced, as well as the Turnpike bridges over Jones Road, Old Highway 50, and Blackstill Lake Road. The West Orange Trail bridge over the Turnpike will be replaced with a prefabricated structure. New electronic tolling gantries will be installed, and the existing toll booths and canopies at the SR 50 entrance and exit ramps will be demolished. Safety improvements for this project include a new Intelligent Transportation system, signage, pavement markings, signalization, lighting, and drainage. Construction will continue through mid-2026. Approximate cost: \$162.3 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM MINNEOLA/HANCOCK ROAD TO O'BRIEN ROAD

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Minneola/Hancock Road and north of O'Brien Road (Milepost 279 to Milepost 286)

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, June 15, and nightly through Thursday, June 19.

Intermittent daytime shoulder closures, 10 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, June 16, and daily through Friday, June 20.

Northbound and southbound SR 19 underneath Florida's Turnpike/SR 91

Continuous full road closure, 10 p.m. Friday, June 20, to 5 a.m. Monday, June 23. **Detour information:**

- Northbound SR 19 traffic wishing to continue north will be directed to US 27, travel northwest on US 27 to O'Brien Road and travel northeast on O'Brien Road to access SR 19.
- Southbound SR 19 traffic wishing to continue south will be directed to O'Brien Road, travel southwest on O'Brien Road to US 27, travel northwest and U-turn on US 27 to access SR 19.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being widened from four to eight lanes from Minneola to O'Brien Road in Lake County. This project includes replacing the bridges at Scrub Jay Lane, CR 561, US 19, and US 27/SR 19 South. New electronic tolling gantries and buildings will be installed, as well as new stormwater treatment facilities. Safety improvements for this project include new signage, pavement markings, signalization, and lighting. Construction will continue through late 2028. Approximate cost: \$233 million.

SEMINOLE EXPRESSWAY/SR 417 WIDENING PROJECT FROM ALOMA AVENUE/SR 426 TO SR 434

Northbound and southbound Seminole Expressway/SR 417 between south of Aloma Avenue/SR 426 and north of SR 434 (Milepost 38 to Milepost 44)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, June 15, and nightly through Wednesday, June 18.

Daytime shoulder closures, 10 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, June 16, and daily through Wednesday, June 18.

Northbound Seminole Expressway/SR 417 entrance and exit ramps at Aloma Avenue/SR 426 (Exit 38)

Overnight full ramp closures, 11:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, June 15, and nightly through Thursday, June 19.

Detour Information:

- Aloma Avenue/SR 426 traffic wishing to access northbound Seminole Expressway/SR 417 will be directed to Red Bug Lake Road, and travel west on Red Bug Lake Road to access northbound Seminole Expressway.
- Northbound Seminole Expressway/SR 417 traffic wishing to access Aloma Avenue (Exit 38) will be directed to exit at Red Bug Lake Road (Exit 42), and travel east on Red Bug Lake Road to access Aloma Avenue.

Southbound Seminole Expressway/SR 417 entrance and exit ramps at Red Bug Lake Road (Exit 42)

Overnight full ramp closures, 11:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, June 15, and nightly through Thursday, June 19.

Detour Information:

- Red Bug Lake Road traffic wishing to access southbound Seminole Expressway/SR 417 will be directed to Aloma Avenue/SR 426, and travel west on Aloma Avenue to access southbound Seminole Expressway.
- Southbound Seminole Expressway/SR 417 traffic wishing to access Red Bug Lake Road (Exit 42) will be directed to exit at Aloma Avenue/SR 426 (Exit 38), and travel east on Aloma Avenue to access Red Bug Lake Road.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Seminole Expressway/SR 417 is being widened from four to eight lanes between Aloma Avenue/SR 426 and north of SR 434 in Seminole County. This project includes the addition of two lanes in each direction of Seminole Expressway and replacing five bridges and widening and enhancing 12 existing bridges. Work also consists of underdeck

lighting in all bridge spans, crossing roadways and pedestrian facilities and replacing signage and pavement markings. Construction will continue through late 2030. Approximate cost: \$300 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 AT DANIEL WEBSTER WESTERN BELTWAY/SR 429 BRIDGE PAINTING PROJECT

Southbound Daniel Webster Western Beltway/SR 429 exit ramp to Florida's Turnpike/SR 91/SR 408 (Exit 22)

Overnight single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, June 15, and nightly through Thursday, June 19.

Northbound and southbound Daniel Webster Western Beltway/SR 429 between Florida's Turnpike/SR 91/SR 408 (Exit 22) and West Colonial Drive/SR 50 (Exit 23)

Overnight single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, June 15, and nightly through Thursday, June 19.

Westbound W. Colonial Drive/SR 50 between Carter Road and Marshall Farms Road

Overnight single lane closure, 8 p.m. Wednesday, June 18, to 6 a.m. Thursday, June 19; and 8 p.m. Thursday, June 19, to 6 a.m. Friday, June 20.

Northbound Daniel Webster Western Beltway/SR 429 exit ramp to northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91/SR 408 (Exist 22)

Overnight full ramp closures, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. Sunday, June 15, and nightly through Thursday, June 19.

Detour information:

 Northbound Daniel Webster Western Beltway/SR 429 traffic wishing to access northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will continue north to West Colonial Drive/SR 50, and travel west on SR 50 to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Five bridges at the Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 and Daniel Webster Western Beltway/SR 429 interchange are being repainted in Orange County. The life of these bridges will be prolonged by cleaning/repainting the steel components and concrete surfaces to prevent corrosion and reduce water infiltration. This project includes improving the overall aesthetics of the structures, ensuring quality and longevity. Construction will continue through late 2025. Approximate cost: \$4.7 million.

BEACHLINE EAST EXPRESSWAY/SR 528 INTELLIGENT TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM ENHANCEMENTS PROJECT FROM SR 520 TO INDUSTRY ROAD

Eastbound and westbound Beachline East Expressway/SR 528 between SR 520 and Industry Road

Intermittent daytime shoulder closures, 7 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday, June 16, and daily through Friday, June 20.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) devices are being enhanced along Beachline East Expressway/SR 528 at various locations between SR 520 and Industry Road in Orange and Brevard counties. This project includes adding roadway weather systems, closed circuit television, dynamic messaging sign devices, and full color overhead electronic signs. A new lighting system will also be installed at the Industry Road/Clearlake Road/SR 524 interchange. Construction will continue through early 2026. Approximate cost: \$19.5 million.

<u>VETERANS EXPRESSWAY/SUNCOAST PARKWAY & POLK PARKWAY</u> HILLSBOROUGH, PASCO, HERNANDO, CITRUS and POLK COUNTIES

VETERANS EXPRESSWAY/SR 589 EMERGENCY STOPPING SITES PROJECT

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: New emergency stopping sites on Veterans Expressway/SR 589 are being constructed between milepost 3 and milepost 12 in Hillsborough County. Work includes widening or resurfacing existing pavement, minor drainage improvements, lighting, signing, and pavement markings. Construction will continue through mid-2025. Approximate cost: \$4.8 million.

SUNCOAST PARKWAY/SR 589 EXPANSION PROJECT FROM SR 44 TO W. NORVELL BRYANT HIGHWAY/CR 486

Eastbound and westbound SR 44 between N. Maynard Road and N. Maylen Avenue

Daytime single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday, June 16, and daily through Friday, June 20.

Eastbound and westbound W. Norvell Bryant Highway/CR 486 between Pine Ridge Boulevard and N. Iron Point

Daytime single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday, June 16, and daily through Friday, June 20.

Northbound Suncoast Parkway/SR 589 between W. Cardinal Street/CR 482 (Exit 60) and Crystal River/Inverness/SR 44 (Exit 68)

Overnight full road closure, 10 p.m. Wednesday, June 18, to 6 a.m. Thursday, June 19. **Detour information:**

Northbound Suncoast Parkway/SR 589 traffic wishing to continue north will be directed to exit at W. Cardinal Street/CR 482 (Exit 60), travel east on W. Cardinal Street to CR 491, travel north on CR 491 to SR 44, and travel west on SR 44 to access Suncoast Parkway.

Southbound Suncoast Parkway/SR 589 entrance ramp from SR 44

Overnight full ramp closure, 10 p.m. Monday, June 16, to 6 a.m. Tuesday, June 17. Detour information:

Eastbound SR 44 traffic wishing to access southbound Suncoast Parkway/SR 589 will continue
east to CR 491, travel south on CR 491 to W. Cardinal Street, and travel west on W. Cardinal Street
to access Suncoast Parkway.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Suncoast Parkway/SR 589 is being extended three miles northward from SR 44 to W. Norvell Bryant Highway/CR 486 in Citrus County. This extension is a new, four-lane (two lanes in each direction) tolled roadway. Construction will continue through late 2025. Approximate cost: \$103 million.

POLK PARKWAY/SR 570 ELECTRONIC TOLLING CONVERSION PROJECT FROM INTERSTATE 4 (I-4) TO OLD DIXIE HIGHWAY

Eastbound and westbound Polk Parkway/SR 570 entrance and exit ramps to I-4

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, June 15, and nightly through Friday, June 20.

<u>Eastbound and westbound Polk Parkway/SR 570 entrance and exit ramps between Airport Road</u> (Exit 3) and Lakeland Highlands Road (Exit 9)

 Eastbound Polk Parkway/SR 570 traffic wishing to continue east will be directed to exit at Lakeland/Auburndale/US 98 (Exit 10), travel north on US 98 to South Combee Road/CR 33A, travel north on South Combee Road to US 92, and travel east on US 92 to access Polk Parkway.

Westbound Polk Parkway/SR 570 entrance ramp from Lakeland Highlands Road

Overnight full ramp closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, June 15, and nightly through Friday, June 20.

Detour information:

 Southbound Lakeland Highlands Road traffic wishing to access westbound Polk Parkway/SR 570 will continue south on Lakeland Highlands Road to CR 540A, travel west on CR 540A to South Florida Avenue, and travel north on South Florida Avenue to access the westbound Polk Parkway.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: An 18-mile portion of Polk Parkway/SR 570 is being converted to electronic toll collection between I-4 and Old Dixie Highway/CR 546 in Polk County. This project includes constructing three new toll gantries at the Western Mainline (milepost 8), Central Mainline (milepost 13), and SR 540 New Mainline (milepost 15.5), replacing cash toll collections with electronic toll collection points and demolishing the existing Western and Central Mainline toll plazas. Construction will continue through mid-2025. Approximate cost: \$31.6 million.

CENTRAL POLK PARKWAY/SR 570B PROJECT FROM POLK PARKWAY/SR 570 TO US 17/SR 35

Eastbound and westbound Polk Parkway/SR 570 between north of Auburndale/Lakeland/US 92 and east of Winter Lake Road/SR 540 (Milepost 13 to Milepost 16.5)

Overnight single lane closure, 9 p.m. Sunday, June 15, to 6 a.m. Monday, June 16. Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, June 16, and nightly through Thursday, June 2.

Westbound Polk Parkway/SR 570 exit ramp to Winter Lake Road/SR 540 (Exit 14)

Long-term full ramp closure through late 2025.

Detour information:

 Westbound Polk Parkway/SR 570 traffic wishing to access Winter Lake Road/SR 540 (Exit 14) will be directed to exit at US 92 (Exit 17), travel east on US 92 to Recker Highway/CR 655, travel southeast on Recker Highway to Spirit Lake Road, and travel south on Spirit Lake Road to access Winter Lake Road.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Central Polk Parkway/SR 570B, a new, four-lane (two lanes in each direction), tolled roadway is being constructed in Polk County. This new stretch of roadway will begin at Polk Parkway/SR 570 and Winter Lake Road/SR 540 and extend approximately 6.5 miles to US 17/SR 35. Construction will continue through 2029. Approximate cost: \$257 million.

POLK PARKWAY/SR 570 RESURFACING AND ROADSIDE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM WEST OF LAKELAND HIGHLANDS ROAD TO SOUTH OF US 92

<u>Eastbound Polk Parkway/SR 570 between east of Lakeland Highlands Road (Exit 9) and west of Lakeland/Auburndale/US 92 (Exit 17)</u>

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, June 16, and nightly through Thursday, June 19.

Westbound Polk Parkway/SR 570 between east of Lakeland Highlands Road (Exit 9) and west of Lakeland/Auburndale/US 92 (Exit 17)

Continuous single lane closure, 8 p.m. Friday, June 20, to 6 a.m. Monday, June 23.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Polk Parkway/SR 570 is being resurfaced from west of Lakeland Highlands Road (milepost 8) to south of US 92 (milepost 17) in Polk County. Work will include paving Polk Parkway and the ramps at US 98, Lakeland Highlands Road and Winter Lake Road/SR 540. This project also includes installing new guardrails, rumble strips, and highly reflective signs and pavement markings, and upgrading existing drainage. Construction will continue through mid-2026. Approximate cost: \$20 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE SYSTEM STATEWIDE OSCEOLA, ORANGE, SEMINOLE, LAKE, SUMTER, HILLSBOROUGH, PASCO, HERNANDO, CITRUS, POLK, DUVAL, and OKALOOSA COUNTIES

CENTRAL FLORIDA WRONG-WAY DETECTION TECHNOLOGY IMPLEMENTATION PROJECT

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Wrong-Way Vehicle Detection Systems (WWVDS) are being enhanced throughout Hillsborough, Pasco, Hernando, Polk, Orange, and Brevard counties by increasing the amount of wrong-way signage, roadway reflectors and pavement markings in locations along Florida's Turnpike/State Road (SR) 91, Beachline Expressway/SR 528, Polk Parkway/SR 589, and Veterans Expressway/Suncoast Parkway/SR 589. Construction will continue through late 2025. Approximate cost: \$11 million.
