Central and West Central Florida Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory

OCOEE, Fla. – <u>Florida's Turnpike Enterprise</u> announces lane closures and work zone information for construction and maintenance projects in Central Florida beginning Sunday, August 24. Motorists should drive with caution through work zones and adhere to posted detour signs and speed limits. Please pay special attention to the closures noted in red.

Regularly scheduled construction and maintenance-related lane closures on Florida's Turnpike operated roads are suspended for the Labor Day holiday from 6 a.m. Friday, August 29, to 10 p.m. Monday, September 1, unless otherwise indicated below.

Tandem truckers should also pay special attention to the closures noted in red which include full road and ramp closures and closures of special significance.

CENTRAL TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 (Mileposts 188 to 240) OSCEOLA COUNTY

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 ELECTRONIC TOLLING CONVERSION PROJECT PHASE 8 FROM LANTANA TOLL PLAZA TO THREE LAKES TOLL PLAZA

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being converted to an Electronic Tolling Collection system from milepost 88 to milepost 236. This project includes the installation of new gantries on the mainline, removal of the existing mainline and existing toll plazas on the interchange ramps and addition of several new Dynamic Message Signs. Construction will continue through late 2025. Approximate cost: \$107 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM CLAY WHALEY ROAD TO US 192 AND W. NOLTE ROAD INTERCHANGE

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Clay Whaley Road and US 192 (Milepost 239 to Milepost 242)

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, August 24, and nightly through Thursday, August 28.

Daytime shoulder closures, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday, August 25, and daily through Friday, August 29.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being widened from two to four lanes in each direction, from Clay Whaley Road (formerly Kissimmee Park Road) to US 192 in Osceola County. This project includes constructing a new interchange at W. Nolte Road and removing the existing ramps at Clay Whaley Road once the new interchange is open to traffic. Construction will continue through early 2029. Approximate cost: \$193 million.

NORTHERN TURNPIKE MAINLINE/SR 91 (Mileposts 240 to 309) OSCEOLA, ORANGE, SEMINOLE, BREVARD, LAKE, and SUMTER COUNTIES

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 AND SAND LAKE ROAD/SR 482 INTERCHANGE DEVELOPMENT PROJECT

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Beachline Expressway/SR 528 and Interstate 4 (I-4) (Milepost 255 to Milepost 258)

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, August 24, and nightly through Thursday, August 28.

Daytime shoulder closures, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday, August 25, and daily through Thursday, August 28.

Eastbound and westbound Sand Lake Road/SR 482 between John Young Parkway/SR 423 and Chancellor Drive

Long-term single lane closures through late 2027.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 at Interstate 4 (I-4)/Tampa/Daytona Beach (Exit 259)

Overnight full road closures, 12 a.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, August 25, and nightly through Wednesday, August 27.

Detour information:

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to continue south will be directed to exit at
Interstate 4 (I-4)/Tampa/Daytona Beach (Exit 259), follow signs for I-4 West/Tampa, travel west on
I-4 to exit at Beachline Expressway/SR 528 East/Int'l Airport/Cape Canaveral (Exit 72), travel east
on Beachline Expressway to exit at Florida's Turnpike/US 17/US 92/US 441 (Exit 4), travel south on
Consulate Drive to Orange Blossom Trail/SR 441, and travel north on Orange Blossom Trail to
access southbound Florida's Turnpike.

- Westbound Interstate 4 (I-4) traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91/Miami
 (Exit 77) will be directed to exit at Beachline Expressway/SR 528 East/Int'l Airport/Cape Canaveral
 (Exit 72), travel east on Beachline Expressway to exit at Florida's Turnpike/US 17/US 92/US 441
 (Exit 4), travel south on Consulate Drive to Orange Blossom Trail/US 441, and travel north on
 Orange Blossom Trail to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.
- Eastbound Interstate 4 (I-4) traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91/Miami (Exit 77) will be directed to exit at Conroy Road (Exit 78), travel west on Conroy Road to westbound I-4, travel west on I-4 to exit at Beachline Expressway/SR 528 East/Int'l Airport/Cape Canaveral (Exit 72), travel east on Beachline Expressway to exit at Florida's Turnpike/US 17/US 92/US 441 (Exit 4), travel south on Consulate Drive to Orange Blossom Trail/US 441, and travel north on Orange Blossom Trail to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: A new interchange will be constructed at Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 and Sand Lake Road/SR 482 in Orange County to enhance connectivity. This project also includes increasing roadway longevity and resiliency with the reconstruction of the Sand Lake Road bridge to accommodate new ramps, improving traffic flow by enhancing the intersection of Presidents Drive and Sand Lake Road, and providing sidewalks from John Young Parkway to Presidents Drive. Construction will continue through late 2027. Approximate cost: \$114.6 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM PARTIN SETTLEMENT ROAD TO OSCEOLA PARKWAY

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Partin Settlement Road and Osceola Parkway (Milepost 243 to Milepost 249)

Overnight single lane closures, 7:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Sunday, August 24, and nightly through Thursday, August 28.

Intermittent daytime shoulder closures, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday, August 25, and daily through Saturday, August 30.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Osceola Parkway and Partin Settlement Road (Milepost 243 to Milepost 249)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, August 24, and nightly through Thursday, August 28.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being widened from two to four lanes, in each direction, from Partin Settlement Road to Osceola Parkway in Osceola County. As part of this project, interchange improvements are planned at Osceola Parkway (milepost 249), as well as bridge improvements and replacements throughout the project limits. This project also includes installing new roadway lighting, updated signage, fresh pavement markings, and guard rail to promote safer and more efficient travel. Construction will continue through early 2031. Approximate cost: \$321 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM CLERMONT/SR 50 TO MINNEOLA/HANCOCK ROAD

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Clermont/SR 50 and Minneola/Hancock Road (Milepost 273 to Milepost 279)

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, August 24, and nightly through Thursday, August 28.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance ramp from W. Colonial Drive/SR 50

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, August 24, and nightly through Thursday, August 28.

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 exit ramp to W. Colonial Drive/SR 50/Winter Garden/Clermont (Exit 272)

Overnight full ramp closures, 10 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Sunday, August 24, and nightly through Thursday, August 28.

Detour Information:

 Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access W. Colonial Drive/SR 50/Winter Garden/Clermont (Exit 272) will be directed to exit at Ocoee/SR 50 (Exit 267B).

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being widened from four to eight lanes from Clermont/SR 50 to Minneola/Hancock Road in Lake and Orange counties. This project includes constructing a new Fosgate Road bridge over the Turnpike. The CR 438 and CR 455 bridges will be replaced, as well as the Turnpike bridges over Jones Road, Old Highway 50, and Blackstill Lake Road. The West Orange Trail bridge over the Turnpike will be replaced with a prefabricated structure. New electronic tolling gantries will be installed, and the existing toll booths and canopies at the SR 50 entrance and exit ramps will be demolished. Safety improvements for this project include a new Intelligent Transportation system, signage, pavement markings, signalization, lighting, and drainage. Construction will continue through mid-2026. Approximate cost: \$162.3 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM MINNEOLA/HANCOCK ROAD TO O'BRIEN ROAD

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Minneola/Hancock Road and north of O'Brien Road (Milepost 279 to Milepost 286)

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, August 24, and nightly through Thursday, August 28.

Intermittent daytime shoulder closures, 10 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, August 25, and daily through Friday, August 29.

Northbound and southbound CR 561 underneath Florida's Turnpike/SR 91

Weekend full road closure, 9 p.m. Friday, August 22, to 5 a.m. Monday, August 25.

Detour information:

- Northbound CR 561 traffic wishing to continue north will be directed south to US 27, travel south on US 27 to Citrus Grove, travel east on Citrus Grove to N. Hancock Road, travel north on N. Hancock Road to CR 561A, and travel west on CR 561A to access CR 561.
- Southbound CR 561 traffic wishing to continue south will be directed to CR 561A, travel east on CR 561A to N. Hancock Road, travel south on N. Hancock Road to Citrus Grove, travel west on Citrus Grove to US 27, and travel north on US 27 to access CR 561.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being widened from four to eight lanes from Minneola to O'Brien Road in Lake County. This project includes replacing the bridges at Scrub Jay Lane, CR 561, US 19, and US 27/SR 19 South. New electronic tolling gantries and buildings will be installed, as well as new stormwater treatment facilities. Safety improvements for this project include new signage, pavement markings, signalization, and lighting. Construction will continue through late 2028. Approximate cost: \$233 million.

SOUTHERN CONNECTOR EXTENSION/SR 417 RESURFACING AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM CELEBRATION AVENUE TO INTERNATIONAL DRIVE

Northbound and southbound Southern Connector Extension/SR 417 between Celebration Avenue and International Drive

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, August 24, and nightly through Thursday, August 28.

Southbound Southern Connector Extension/SR 417 exit ramp to Celebration Avenue (Exit 2) Overnight full ramp closure, 8 p.m. Sunday, August 24, to 6 a.m. Monday, August 25. Detour Information:

 Southbound Southern Connector Extension/SR 417 traffic wishing to access Celebration Avenue (Exit 2) will be directed to exit at Osceola Parkway (Exit 3), travel west on Osceola Parkway to International Drive, travel south on International Drive to W. Irlo Bronson Memorial Highway/US 192, and travel west on W. Irlo Bronson Highway to access Celebration Avenue.

Southbound Southern Connector Extension/SR 417 exit ramp at Osceola Parkway (Exit 3) Overnight full ramp closure, 8 p.m. Sunday, August 24, to 6 a.m. Monday, August 25. Detour Information:

Southbound Southern Connector Extension/SR 417 traffic wishing to access Osceola Parkway (Exit 3) will be directed to exit at Celebration Ave (Exit 2), travel north on Celebration Avenue to W. Irlo Bronson Memorial Highway/US 192, travel east on W. Irlo Bronson Memorial Highway to International Drive, and travel north on International Drive to access Osceola Parkway.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Southern Connector Extension/SR 417 is being resurfaced from Celebration Avenue (milepost 2) to International Drive/World Center Drive (milepost 6) in Osceola and Orange counties. Work will include paving the Southern Connector mainline and the interchanges at Celebration Avenue (Exit 2) and Osceola Parkway (Exit 3). This project also includes installing new guardrails, rumble strips, and highly reflective signs and pavement markings, and upgrading existing drainage. Construction will continue through early 2026. Approximate cost: \$10.7 million.

SEMINOLE EXPRESSWAY/SR 417 RESURFACING AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM AIRPORT BOULEVARD TO TOWNE CENTER BOULEVARD

Northbound and southbound Seminole Expressway/SR 417 between Airport Boulevard and Rinehart Road (Milepost 49 to Milepost 55)

Overnight single lane closures, 9:30 p.m. to 7:30 a.m., Sunday, August 24, and nightly through Thursday, August 28.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Seminole Expressway/SR 417 is being resurfaced from south of Airport Boulevard (milepost 49) to north of Towne Center Boulevard (milepost 55) in Seminole County. Work will include paving Seminole Expressway and the ramps at Rinehart Road, W. 25th Street/H.E. Thomas Jr. Parkway, and Airport Boulevard. This project also includes bridge deck expansion joint rehabilitation, new guardrails, sign improvements, upgrading existing drainage, and wrong-way vehicle detection system. Construction will continue through late 2026. Approximate cost: \$17.4 million.

SEMINOLE EXPRESSWAY/SR 417 WIDENING PROJECT FROM ALOMA AVENUE/SR 426 TO SR 434

Northbound and southbound Seminole Expressway/SR 417 between south of Aloma Avenue/SR 426 and north of SR 434 (Milepost 38 to Milepost 44)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, August 24, and nightly through Thursday, August 28.

Daytime shoulder closures, 10 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, August 25, and daily through Friday, August 29.

Northbound Seminole Expressway/SR 417 entrance ramp from Aloma Avenue/SR 426

Overnight full ramp closures, 11:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, August 24, and nightly through Thursday, August 28.

Detour information:

 Aloma Avenue/SR 426 traffic wishing to access northbound Seminole Expressway/SR 417 will be directed to Red Bug Lake Road, and travel west on Red Bug Lake Road to access northbound Seminole Expressway.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Seminole Expressway/SR 417 is being widened from four to eight lanes between Aloma Avenue/SR 426 and north of SR 434 in Seminole County. This project includes the addition of two lanes in each direction of Seminole Expressway and replacing five bridges and widening and enhancing 12 existing bridges. Work also consists of new underdeck lighting and installing new highly reflective signage and pavement markings. Construction will continue through late 2030. Approximate cost: \$300 million.

BEACHLINE EAST EXPRESSWAY/SR 528 INTELLIGENT TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM ENHANCEMENTS PROJECT FROM SR 520 TO INDUSTRY ROAD

Eastbound and westbound Beachline East Expressway/SR 528 between SR 520 and SR 524/Industry Road/Clearlake Road

Intermittent daytime shoulder closures, 7 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday, August 25, and daily through Friday, August 29.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) devices along Beachline East Expressway/SR 528 are being enhanced at various locations between SR 520 and Industry Road in Orange and Brevard counties. This project includes adding roadway weather systems, closed circuit television, overhead dynamic messaging signs, and full color overhead electronic signs. A new lighting system will also be installed at the Industry Road/Clearlake Road/SR 524 interchange. Construction will continue through early 2026. Approximate cost: \$19.5 million.

TRANSPORTATION SYSTEMS MANAGEMENT AND OPERATIONS (TSM&O) PROJECT DANIEL WEBSTER WESTERN BELTWAY/SR 429 AND US 192 INTERCHANGE

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Daniel Webster Western Beltway/SR 429 and US 192 interchange is undergoing significant enhancements to increase capacity, improve mobility, and enhance safety in Orange County. As part of these improvements, we are adding a new lane and extending the existing southbound SR 429 exit ramp to US 192. At the intersection of the southbound SR 429 exit ramp and US 192, three right-turn lanes and two left-turn lanes will also be constructed. This project also includes installing new signage, pavement markings, and lighting. Construction will continue through late 2026. Approximate cost: \$14.5 million.

<u>VETERANS EXPRESSWAY/SUNCOAST PARKWAY & POLK PARKWAY</u> <u>HILLSBOROUGH, PASCO, HERNANDO, CITRUS and POLK COUNTIES</u>

SUNCOAST PARKWAY/SR 589 EXPANSION PROJECT FROM SR 44 TO W. NORVELL BRYANT HIGHWAY/CR 486

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Suncoast Parkway/SR 589 is being extended three miles northward from SR 44 to W. Norvell Bryant Highway/CR 486 in Citrus County. This extension is a new, four-lane (two lanes in each direction) tolled roadway. Construction will continue through late 2025. Approximate cost: \$103 million.

SUNCOAST PARKWAY/SR 589 RESURFACING AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM SR 54 TO SR 52

Northbound Suncoast Parkway/SR 589 between Milepost 19.5 and Milepost 17.5

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 7 a.m., Monday August 18, and nightly through Wednesday, August 27.

Overnight single lane closure, 9 p.m. Thursday, August 28 to 6 a.m. Friday, August 29.

Southbound Suncoast Parkway/SR 589 between Milepost 17.5 and Milepost 19.5

Overnight single lane closures, 7:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Monday August 18, and nightly through Thursday, August 28.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Suncoast Parkway/SR 589 is being resurfaced from south of SR 54 (milepost 17.5) to north of SR 52 (milepost 28.5) in Pasco County. Safety improvements for this project include new signage, pavement markings, and replacing bridge joints over Ridge Road. Construction will continue through early 2027. Approximate cost: \$23 million.

CENTRAL POLK PARKWAY/SR 570B PROJECT FROM POLK PARKWAY/SR 570 TO US 17/SR 35

Westbound Polk Parkway/SR 570 exit ramp to Winter Lake Road/SR 540 (Exit 14)

Long-term full ramp closure through late 2025.

Detour information:

 Westbound Polk Parkway/SR 570 traffic wishing to access Winter Lake Road/SR 540 (Exit 14) will be directed to exit at US 92 (Exit 17), travel east on US 92 to Recker Highway/CR 655, travel southeast on Recker Highway to Spirit Lake Road, and travel south on Spirit Lake Road to access Winter Lake Road.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Central Polk Parkway/SR 570B, a new, four-lane (two lanes in each direction), tolled roadway is being constructed in Polk County. This new stretch of roadway will begin at Polk Parkway/SR 570 and Winter Lake Road/SR 540 and extend approximately 6.5 miles to US 17/SR 35. Construction will continue through 2029. Approximate cost: \$257 million.

POLK PARKWAY/SR 570 RESURFACING AND ROADSIDE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM WEST OF LAKELAND HIGHLANDS ROAD TO SOUTH OF US 92

Eastbound Polk Parkway/SR 570 between east of Lakeland Highlands Road (Exit 9) and west of Lakeland/Auburndale/US 92 (Exit 17)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, August 24, and nightly through Thursday, August 28.

Eastbound Polk Parkway/SR 570 exit ramp to Winter Lake Road/SR 540

Overnight single lane closure, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, August 24, and nightly through Thursday, August 28.

Westbound Polk Parkway/SR 570 exit ramp to US 98/Bartow Road (Exit 10)

Overnight full ramp closure, 8 p.m. Sunday, August 24, to 6 a.m. Monday, August 25.

Detour information:

 Westbound Polk Parkway/SR 570 traffic wishing to access US 98/Bartow Road (Exit 10) will be directed to exit at Lakeland Highlands Road (Exit 9), travel north on Lakeland Highlands Road to Edgewood Drive, and travel east on Edgewood Drive to access US 98/Bartow Road.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Polk Parkway/SR 570 is being resurfaced from west of Lakeland Highlands Road (milepost 8) to south of US 92 (milepost 17) in Polk County. Work includes paving Polk Parkway, US 98 ramps, Lakeland Highlands Road, and Winter Lake Road. This project also includes installing new guardrails, rumble strips, and highly reflective signs and pavement markings, and upgrading existing drainage. Construction will continue through mid-2026. Approximate cost: \$20 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE SYSTEM STATEWIDE OSCEOLA, ORANGE, SEMINOLE, LAKE, SUMTER, HILLSBOROUGH, PASCO, HERNANDO, CITRUS, POLK, DUVAL, and OKALOOSA COUNTIES

CENTRAL FLORIDA WRONG-WAY VEHICLE DETECTION TECHNOLOGY IMPLEMENTATION PROJECT

Eastbound and westbound Polk Parkway/SR570 exit ramps to Harden Boulevard (Exit 5)

Overnight full ramp closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, August 25, and nightly through Thursday, August 28.

Detour Information:

• Eastbound and westbound Polk Parkway/SR 570 traffic wishing to access Harden Boulevard (Exit 5) will be directed to exit at Airport Road/SR 572 (Exit 13), travel north on Airport Road to New Tampa Highway, and travel east on New Tampa Highway to access Harden Boulevard.

Eastbound Polk Parkway/SR570 exit ramp S. Florida Avenue (Exit 7)

Overnight full ramp closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, August 25, and nightly through Thursday, August 28.

Detour Information:

• Eastbound Polk Parkway/SR 570 traffic wishing to access South Florida Avenue (Exit 7) will be directed to exit at Lakeland Highlands Road/CR 37 B (Exit 9), travel north on Lakeland Highlands Road to E. Edgewood Drive and travel west on E. Edgewood Drive to access S. Florida Avenue.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Wrong-Way Vehicle Detection Systems (WWVDS) are being enhanced throughout Hillsborough, Pasco, Hernando, Polk, Orange, and Brevard counties. Work includes increasing the amount of wrong-way signage, roadway reflectors and pavement markings in locations along Florida's Turnpike/SR 91, Beachline Expressway/SR 528, Polk Parkway/SR 589, and Veterans Expressway/Suncoast Parkway/SR 589. Construction will continue through late 2025. Approximate cost: \$11 million.

FIRST COAST EXPRESSWAY/SR 23 SAFETY ENHANCEMENTS PROJECT FROM BLANDING BOULEVARD/SR 21 TO INTERSTATE 10 (I-10)

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: First Coast Expressway/SR 23 is undergoing enhancements between Blanding Boulevard/SR 21 (milepost 31) and I-10 (milepost 46) in Clay and Duval counties. Work consists of installing new wrong-way driving countermeasures, guardrail, and Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) components. This project also includes enhancing traffic monitoring by updating infrastructure for CCTV connectivity and backup generator power. Construction will continue through late 2026. Approximate cost: \$8.2 million.

TOLL EQUIPMENT & OPERATIONS MAINTENANCE

Polk Parkway/SR 570

Westbound Polk Parkway/SR 570 between Milepost 5 and Milepost 4.5
