



NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING Florida's Turnpike (SR 91) and I-95

Direct Connection Interchange







The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), Florida's Turnpike Enterprise, will hold a Public Hearing for the above-referenced project. Attendance options are as follows:

Virtual Hearing:

Monday, October 20, 2025, at 6:00 p.m. Attend via a computer, tablet, or smartphone, or by telephone in listenonly mode.

In-Person Hearing:

Tuesday, October 21, 2025, at 5:30 p.m. Attend at the Indian River State College, Clare & Gladys Wolf High-Technology Center, 2400 SE Salerno Rd, Stuart, FL 34997

The virtual Public Hearing will begin with a formal presentation followed by a public comment period. The in-person Public Hearing will begin with an informal open house, continue with a formal presentation at 6:00 p.m. and conclude with a public comment period. Please visit the project website, www.TPK-I-95-Interchange-Study.com, to register for the Public Hearing and to select your participation option. **Please note that registration works best in Google Chrome, Microsoft Edge, or Firefox web browsers.** Once registered, you will receive a confirmation email that includes instructions on how to join the Public Hearing. The proposed improvements include the addition of direct connection ramps between Florida's Turnpike and I-95, near Bridge Road (County Road 708). This public hearing is being conducted to give interested persons an opportunity to express their views concerning the location, conceptual design, and social, economic, and environmental effects of the proposed improvements.



Persons wishing to submit written or verbal comments may do so at the hearing or may contact the Project Manager. Any questions will be answered outside of the Public Hearing's formal comment period. All comments received or postmarked on or before October 31, 2025, will be included in the Public Hearing record. For assistance registering for the hearing, or for additional information, please contact the Project Manager.

The environmental review, consultation, and other actions required by applicable federal environmental laws for this project are being, or have been, carried out by the FDOT pursuant to 23 U.S.C § 327 and a Memorandum of Understanding dated May 26, 2022, and executed by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and FDOT.

Public participation is solicited without regard to race, color, national origin, age, sex, religion, disability, or family status. Persons who require special accommodations under the Americans with Disabilities Act or persons who require translation services (free of charge) should contact the Project Manager at the information above at least seven days prior to the Public Hearing.
