PUBLIC HEARING ANNOUNCEMENT

You are invited to a Public Hearing for the Florida's Turnpike (SR 91) and I-95 Direct Connection Interchange PD&E Study in Martin County. There are three participation options to select from:

- Virtual via a computer, tablet or smartphone on Monday, October 20, 2025
- By telephone in listen-only mode on Monday, October 20, 2025
- In-Person on Tuesday, October 21, 2025

This Public Hearing will give interested people an opportunity to review the study, ask questions, and provide comments concerning the conceptual design and potential social, economic, and environmental effects of the proposed improvements.

IN-PERSON OPTION - TUESDAY, OCTOBER 21, 2025 (5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m.)

You may participate in-person by going to the Indian River State College | Clare & Gladys Wolf High-Technology Center | 2400 SE Salerno Road, Stuart, FL 34997 from 5:30 p.m. to 7:30 p.m. The hearing will begin at 6:00 p.m. with introductions and a formal presentation, followed by a formal comment period. If you desire to make a verbal statement during the formal comment period, you will be asked to complete a Speaker Request Card. Verbal comments can also be made directly to a Court Reporter. Project exhibits will be on display, and members of the study team will be available to answer questions. The same informational project video played at the virtual hearing will be shown at the in-person hearing. People wishing to submit written comments/questions may do so at the hearing venue or directly to the Project Manager.

PUBLIC HEARING MATERIALS



PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

The proposed improvements include a new direct connection interchange between Florida's Turnpike and I-95 near the existing I-95 / Bridge Road interchange in Martin County. New ramps will be added between Florida's Turnpike and I-95 to provide northbound to northbound, and southbound to southbound movements.
