

Seminole Expressway/SR 417 Resurfacing and Safety Improvements Project from Airport Boulevard to Towne Center Boulevard

Project Overview

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise (Enterprise) is resurfacing Seminole Expressway/State Road (SR) 417 from south of Airport Boulevard (milepost 49) to north of Towne Center Boulevard (milepost 55) in Seminole County. The project is designed to extend roadway life, enhance safety, and improve roadside conditions.

Project Benefits

- Improved Rideability: Resurfacing travel lanes, shoulders and the entrance and exit ramps at Rinehart Road, W 25th Street/H.E. Thomas Jr. Parkway, and Airport Boulevard to provide a smoother and more consistent driving experience.
- Increased Resilience: Extending the life of bridges by installing new joints to the northbound bridges over US 17/92, Rinehart Road and Towne Center Boulevard, along with the southbound bridge over Airport Boulevard.
- Enhanced safety: Installing new signage, fresh pavement markings, and new guardrail.

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction activities will occur during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience occasional impacts from construction-related light, noise, vibration, or dust. The Enterprise is committed to minimizing these disruptions and takes steps to limit traffic delays and noise.

Lane closures will generally take place during off-peak hours to reduce impacts to drivers. Information about closures will be provided in advance through the Central and West Central Florida Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.

Project Schedule and Funding

Construction Timeline: Work is anticipated to be completed by late 2026.

Project Cost: Approximately \$17.4 million.
