FORT LAUDERDALE, Fla. — <u>Florida's Turnpike Enterprise</u> announces lane closures and work zone information for construction and maintenance projects in Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Martin, St. Lucie, Okeechobee and Indian River counties, for the week beginning Sunday, October 26. Motorists should drive with caution through the work zones and adhere to posted detour signs and speed limits. Please pay special attention to the closures noted in red.

Tandem truckers should also pay special attention to the closures noted in red which include full road and ramp closures and closures of special significance.

TURNPIKE EXTENSION/SR 821 WIDENING PROJECT FROM CAMPBELL DRIVE TO TALLAHASSEE ROAD

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 between Campbell Drive and Tallahassee Road (Milepost 3 to Milepost 7)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 26, and nightly through Thursday, October 30.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 is being widened from four to six lanes from Campbell Drive/SW 312 Street to Tallahassee Road/SW 137 Avenue in Miami-Dade County. This project includes reconstructing the Turnpike bridges within the corridor, interchange improvements at Biscayne Drive and Tallahassee Road and constructing a new northbound entrance ramp from Tallahassee Road. Construction is scheduled to continue through mid-2028. Approximate cost: \$99 million.

TURNPIKE EXTENSIONS/SR 821 AND SURFACE STREET IMPROVEMENTS FROM HAINLIN MILL ROAD TO US 1

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 between Cutler Bay Drive and US 1 (Milepost 11 to Milepost 12.5)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 26, and nightly through Thursday, October 30.

Eastbound and westbound Caribbean Boulevard/SW 200 Street between SW 107 Avenue and US 1

Overnight single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 26, and nightly through Thursday, October 30.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 is being improved between Hainlin Mill Road/216 Street and Caribbean Boulevard/SW 200 Street in Miami-Dade County. Work includes widening Hainlin Mill Road, Cutler Ridge Boulevard, the northbound Turnpike bridge over Caribbean Boulevard, westbound Eureka Drive and southbound frontage road. Additional improvements include bridge repairs, noise walls along qualifying residential areas, upgraded signalization, pedestrian features, and lighting. Construction is scheduled to continue through mid-2027. Approximate cost: \$37 million.

TURNPIKE EXTENSION/SR 821 WIDENING PROJECT FROM NW 106 STREET TO INTERSTATE 75 (I-75)

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 between NW 106 Street and I-75 (Milepost 34 to Milepost 39)

Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, October 26, and nightly through Thursday, October 30.

Okeechobee Road/US 27 to southbound NW 107 Avenue

Continuous partial closure, 9 p.m. Sunday, October 26, to 5 a.m. Sunday, November 9.

- Westbound Okeechobee Road/US 27 traffic wishing to access southbound NW 107 Avenue will be directed to NW 121 Way, travel south on NW 121 Way to NW South River Drive, travel west on NW South River Drive to NW 127 Street, and travel west on NW 127 Street to access NW 107 Avenue.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 is being widened to 10 lanes between NW 106 Street and I-75. The project entails constructing a new eastbound Okeechobee Road to southbound Florida's Turnpike entrance ramp and a new northbound Florida's Turnpike exit ramp to eastbound Okeechobee Road, as well as an additional lane in each direction on Okeechobee Road between west of the Turnpike and NW 107 Avenue. Work also consists of constructing a new diverging diamond interchange at Florida's Turnpike and NW 170 Street. Resurfacing, guardrail and fencing, lane striping, stormwater drainage, signage and lighting improvements will also be installed as part of this project. Construction will continue through early 2026. Approximate cost: \$370 million.

GOLDEN GLADES INTERCHANGE (GGI) PROJECT

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Miami Gardens Drive/NW 183 Street and I-95

Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, October 26, and nightly through Thursday, October 30.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 TRANSPORTATION SYSTEMS MANAGEMENT & OPERATIONS (TSM&O) PROJECT FROM TURNPIKE EXTENSION/SR 821 TO GRIFFIN ROAD/SR 818

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Turnpike Extension/SR 821 and Griffin Road/SR 818 (Milepost 47 to Milepost 54)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 26, and nightly through Thursday, October 30. A second lane may close at 9 p.m. and reopen at 5 a.m.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Auxiliary Lanes are being added to Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 from the Turnpike Extension/SR 821 to Griffin Road/SR 818. This project will increase roadway capacity, reduce congestion and improve travel times. The project also includes safety improvements at Hollywood Boulevard/SR 820 and SW 63 Terrace by closing the median to reduce vehicle conflict points and accidents, and at Hollywood Boulevard and S. 62 Avenue by eliminating the eastbound and westbound turn lanes. Construction will continue through mid-2029. Approximate cost: \$230 million.

SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869 AND ATLANTIC BOULEVARD INTERCHANGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

Northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 at Atlantic Boulevard (Exit 8)

Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 26, and nightly through Thursday, October 30.

Northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 entrance and exit ramps at Atlantic Boulevard (Exit 8)

Overnight full ramp closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 26, and nightly through Thursday, October 30.

- Atlantic Boulevard traffic wishing to access southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 will be directed to Coral Ridge Drive, travel south on Coral Ridge Drive/NW 100 Avenue/Nob Hill Road to Commercial Boulevard/SR 870, and travel west on Commercial Boulevard to access southbound Sawgrass Expressway.
- Northbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 traffic wishing to access Atlantic Boulevard (Exit 8) will be directed to exit at Commercial Boulevard/SR 870 (Exit 5), travel east on Commercial Boulevard to Nob Hill Road, and travel north on Nob Hill Road/Coral Ridge Drive to access Atlantic Boulevard.
- Southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 traffic wishing to access Atlantic Boulevard (Exit 8) will be directed to exit at Sample Road/SR 834 (Exit 11), travel east on Sample Road to Coral Ridge Drive, and travel south on Coral Ridge Drive to access Atlantic Boulevard.

Eastbound and westbound Atlantic Boulevard underneath Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869

Overnight single lane closure, 10 p.m. Friday, October 31, to 6 a.m. Saturday, November 1. Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 26, and nightly through Thursday, October 30.

Daytime single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday, October 27, and daily through Friday, October 31.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 is being widened from six to 10 lanes from north of Commercial Boulevard (Exit 5) to north of Atlantic Boulevard (Exit 8). The new lanes constructed as part of this project will open upon completion of future adjacent widening projects. Work includes reconstructing the northbound and southbound entrance and exit ramps at Atlantic Boulevard, widening Atlantic Boulevard from two to three lanes and adding bike lanes, and stormwater management enhancements and modifications to the pond west of the roadway. Construction will continue through early 2026. Approximate cost: \$72.5 million.

SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/SR 869 WIDENING PROJECT FROM ATLANTIC BOULEVARD TO SAMPLE ROAD/SR 834

Northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 between north of Atlantic Boulevard and north of Sample Road/SR 834 (Milepost 9 to Milepost 12)

Overnight single and double lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 26, and nightly through Thursday, October 30.

Northbound Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 entrance and exit ramps at Sample Road/SR 834 (Exit 11)

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Sawgrass Expressway/SR 869 is being widened from six to 10 lanes from north of Atlantic Boulevard to north of Sample Road/SR 834, in Broward County. The new lanes constructed as part of this project will open upon completion of future adjacent widening projects. The Sample Road interchange will be converted to a partial diverging diamond interchange. Construction will continue through early 2028. Approximate cost: \$99.7 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 BRIDGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT OVER L-38 CANAL AT MILEPOST 80

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 bridge approaches are being improved over the L-38 canal at milepost 80, in Palm Beach County. This project includes improving roadway safety by replacing the asphalt at the bridge approaches and installing new pavement markings. Construction will continue through early 2026. Approximate cost: \$2 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 AND BOYNTON BEACH BOULEVARD/SR 804 INTERCHANGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 at Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 (Milepost 86 to Milepost 87)

Overnight single lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 6:30 a.m., Sunday, October 26, and nightly through Thursday, October 30. A second lane may close at 10 p.m. and reopen by 6 a.m.

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 exit ramp to Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 (Exit 86)

Overnight full ramp closure, 11 p.m. Sunday, October 26, to 5 a.m. Monday, October 27; and 10 p.m. Monday, October 27, to 5 a.m. Tuesday, October 28.

Overnight full ramp closures, 11 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, October 28, and nightly through Thursday, October 30.

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 traffic wishing to access Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804
(Exit 86) will be directed to exit at Atlantic Avenue/SR 806 (Exit 81), travel west on Atlantic
Avenue to US 441/SR 7, and travel north on US 441 to access Boynton Beach Boulevard.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 and Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 (Exit 86) interchange is undergoing significant enhancements to improve traffic flow and safety. This project includes: a new westbound turn lane from Boynton Beach Boulevard to northbound Florida's Turnpike and an additional lane from the northbound Florida's Turnpike exit ramp to Boynton Beach Boulevard. Safety upgrades feature the installation of new highly reflective overhead signage and pavement markings, designed for optimal visibility in all lighting and weather conditions. Construction is scheduled to continue through late 2025. Approximate cost: \$9.5 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM NORTH OF BOYNTON BEACH BOULEVARD/SR 804 TO NORTH OF LAKE WORTH ROAD/SR 802

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 and north of Lake Worth Road/SR 802 (Milepost 87 to Milepost 95)

Overnight single lane closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, October 26, to 5 a.m. Monday, October 27. Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, October 27, and nightly through Thursday, October 30.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being widened to four lanes in each direction, from north of Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804 to north of Boynton Beach Boulevard/SR 804. This project also includes reconstructing the Hypoluxo Road bridge over Southern Turnpike Mainline to allow for the new road configuration. Additionally, sound barrier walls will be constructed along qualifying residential areas. Bridge widening, road milling and resurfacing, signage and signal improvements are planned. Construction will continue through early 2026. Approximate cost: \$170 million.

WEST PALM BEACH SERVICE PLAZA PARKING IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between south of Lake Worth Road/SR 802 and south of Southern Boulevard/US 98/SR 80 (Milepost 94 to Milepost 95)

Overnight single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, October 27, and nightly through Thursday, October 30.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The truck parking facility at the West Palm Beach Service Plaza is being improved. Truck parking will be consolidated in the northern section of the service plaza to enhance traffic flow and increase the number of available truck spaces. Construction will continue through late 2026. Approximate cost: \$32.4 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM WEST PALM BEACH SERVICE PLAZA TO NORTH OF SOUTHERN BOULEVARD/US 98/SR 80

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between West Palm Beach Service Plaza and north of Southern Boulevard/US 98/SR 80 (Milepost 94 to Milepost 98)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 26, and nightly through Thursday, October 30.

Eastbound and westbound Southern Boulevard/US 98/SR 80 between Drawdy Road and Pike Road

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. Thursday, October 30, to 7 a.m. Friday, October 31.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being widened from two to four lanes in each direction, from West Palm Beach Service Plaza to north of Southern Boulevard/US 98/SR 80 in Palm Beach County. This project includes reconstructing the Turnpike bridges over Forest Hill Boulevard/SR 882, Southern Boulevard, and Belvedere Road. Additionally, sound barrier walls will be constructed along qualifying residential areas. Safety upgrades feature the installation of new highly reflective overhead signage and pavement markings, designed for optimal visibility in all lighting and weather conditions. Construction will continue through early 2030. Approximate cost: \$258 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM NORTH OF SOUTHERN BOULEVARD TO NORTH OF OKEECHOBEE BOULEVARD

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Jog Road and north of Okeechobee Boulevard/SR 704 (Milepost 99 to Milepost 101)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, October 26, and nightly through Thursday, October 30.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 between Jog Road and north of Okeechobee Boulevard/SR 704 (Milepost 99 to Milepost 101)

Overnight single lane closure, 10 p.m. Friday, October 24, to 6 a.m. Saturday, October 25.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance ramp from Jog Road (Milepost 99)

Overnight full ramp closures, 8 p.m. to 6 p.m., Sunday, October 26, and nightly through Tuesday, October 28.

<u>Eastbound and westbound Okeechobee Boulevard/SR 704 between Vista Parkway and West</u> Drive

Overnight double lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 6:30 a.m., Sunday, October 26, and nightly through Thursday, October 30.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 is being widened from two to four lanes in each direction, from north of Southern Boulevard/SR 80 to north of Okeechobee Boulevard/SR 704 in Palm Beach County. This project includes reconstructing the Turnpike interchanges at Okeechobee Boulevard and Jog Road, including the addition of a new northbound Turnpike entrance ramp from Jog Road and a southbound Turnpike exit ramp to Jog Road. Additionally, this project includes reconstructing the bridges at Okeechobee Boulevard and Jog Road to increase longevity and reinforce durability. Sound barrier walls will be constructed along qualifying residential areas. Safety upgrades feature the installation of new roadway lighting, updated signage, fresh pavement markings, and guardrail to promote safer and more efficient travel. Construction will continue through 2030. Approximate cost: \$236 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/SR 91 BRIDGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT AT MILEPOST 138 IN MARTIN COUNTY

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 entrance ramp from Becker Road

Overnight full ramp closures, 8:30 p.m. Wednesday, October 29, to 6:30 a.m. Thursday, October 30; and 8:30 p.m. Thursday, October 30, to 6:30 a.m. Friday, October 31.

 Becker Road traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 will be directed to travel west on Becker Road to Interstate 95/I-95, travel south on I-95 to SW Martin Highway/SR 714/CR 714 (Exit 110), travel east on SW Martin Highway to SW Martin Downs Boulevard, and travel south on SW Martin Downs Boulevard to access southbound Florida's Turnpike/SR 91.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 bridge is being improved at milepost 138 over C-23 canal, in Martin County. Safety upgrades feature the installation of new roadway lighting, updated signage, fresh pavement markings, and guardrail to promote safer and more efficient travel. Construction will continue through 2028. Approximate cost: \$42.5 million.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/SR 821 (Turnpike Extension) is implementing Wrong-Way Vehicle Detection Technology from Allapattah Road/SW 112 Avenue to Tamiami Trail/US 41/SW 8 Street in Miami-Dade County. The project aims to improve safety by providing wrong way driving detection systems along with new highly reflective signage and pavement markings, which will increase visibility in all lighting and weather conditions. These enhancements will assist in monitoring, detecting, and preventing wrong-way drivers, and notifying law enforcement and Traffic Management Center staff for response. Construction is scheduled to continue through late 2026. Approximate cost: \$3.3 million.
