You are invited to a Public Hearing for the widening of Florida's Turnpike Mainline (SR 91) from North of SR 60 to South of Clay Whaley Road (Mile Post 193.5-238.5) PD&E Study in Osceola County. There are three participation options to select from:

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OPTION 1: VIRTUAL/ONLINE - Monday, November 17, 2025 (6:00 p.m.)

The webinar will begin at 6:00 p.m. with introductions and a formal presentation, followed by a formal comment period. If you desire to make a verbal statement, your microphone will be unmuted by the hearing moderator at the appropriate time. OPTION 2: BY TELEPHONE (LISTEN ONLY) - Monday, November 17, 2025 (6:00 p.m.)

The virtual Public Hearing will begin at 6:00 p.m. with introductions and a formal presentation, followed by a formal comment period. If you select this option, you will be unable to provide a verbal comment during the formal comment period. 'By telephone in listen-only mode' participants can provide verbal or written comments directly to the Project Manager, Greg Moore, P.E. before or after the Public Hearing.

OPTION 3: IN-PERSON - Tuesday, November 18, 2025 or Thursday, November 20, 2025 (5:30 p.m.)

You may participate in-person by going to the **St. Cloud Civic Center (Gym B), 3001 17th Street, St. Cloud, FL 34769 on November 18, 2025** or the **Intergenerational Recreation Center, 1590 9th Street SW, Vero Beach, FL 32962 on November 20, 2025**. The doors will open at 5:30 p.m. The hearing will begin at 6:00 p.m. with introductions and a formal presentation, followed by a formal comment period. If you desire to make a verbal statement during the formal comment period, you will be asked to complete a Speaker Request Card. Verbal comments can also be made directly to a Court Reporter. Project exhibits will be on display, and members of the study team will be available to answer questions. The same informational project video played at the virtual hearing will be shown at the in-person hearing. People wishing to submit written comments/questions may do so at the hearing venue or by contacting the Project Manager. *If the in-person Public Hearing cannot be held due to severe weather or unforeseen conditions, it will be held on the alternate dates of Tuesday, December 16, 2025 (Intergenerational Recreation Center), and Thursday, December 18, 2025 (St. Cloud Civic Center, Gym B), at 5:30 p.m.*

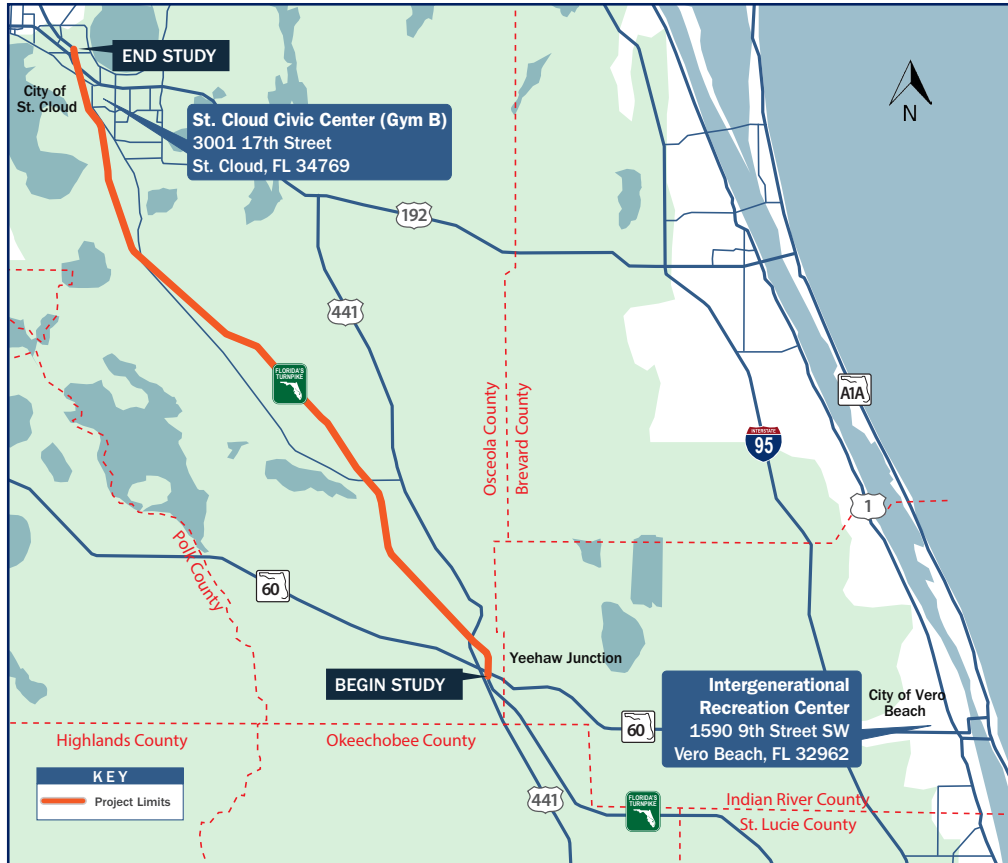

PROPOSED IMPROVEMENTS

The PD&E Study involves evaluating alternatives for widening Florida's Turnpike Mainline (SR 91) from North of SR 60 to South of Clay Whaley Road (Mile Post 193.5-238.5) in Osceola County, Florida. The Turnpike Mainline within the project area is currently a four-lane (two lanes in each direction) limited-access toll facility. The study area extends approximately 45 miles.
