Continuous Single Lane Closure of Northbound Florida's Turnpike at Milepost 306.5 in Sumter County

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise has scheduled a continuous single lane closure of the outside lane of southbound Florida's Turnpike/State Road (SR) 91 at Milepost 306.5 in Sumter County beginning at 10 p.m. Monday, October 20, for roadway maintenance activities.

Drivers might experience delays traveling through the area and should seek alternate routes. Travelers heading north on Florida's Turnpike/SR 91 wishing to access northbound Interstate 75 (I-75) should consider exiting at US 301 (Exit 304), traveling north on US 301 to SR 44, and traveling west on SR 44 to enter northbound I-75.

The lane will remain closed until maintenance work has been completed. There will be periods of time where motorists will not see any work being performed. Please note that this schedule may change due to inclement weather or unforeseen conditions.
