CENTRAL TURNPIKE MAINLINE/STATE ROAD (S.R.) 91 (Mileposts 188 to 240) **OSCEOLA COUNTY**

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/S.R. 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM CLAY WHALEY ROAD TO U.S. 192 AND W. NOLTE ROAD INTERCHANGE

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 between Clay Whaley Road and U.S. 192 (Milepost 239 to Milepost 242)

Daytime shoulder closures, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday, November 17, and daily through Friday, November 21.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 is being widened from two to four lanes in each direction, from Clay Whaley Road (formerly Kissimmee Park Road) to U.S. 192 in Osceola County. This project includes constructing a new interchange at W. Nolte Road and removing the existing ramps at Clay Whaley Road once the new interchange is open to traffic. Construction will continue through early 2029. Approximate cost: \$193 million.

**FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/S.R. 91 AND SAND LAKE ROAD/S.R. 482
INTERCHANGE DEVELOPMENT PROJECT**

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 between Beachline Expressway/S.R. 528 and Interstate 4 (I-4) (Milepost 255 to Milepost 258)

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, November 16, and nightly through Thursday, November 20.

Daytime shoulder closures, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday, November 17, and daily through Friday, November 21.

Eastbound and westbound Sand Lake Road/S.R. 482 between John Young Parkway/S.R. 423 and Chancellor Drive

Overnight single lane closures, 7 p.m. to 7 a.m., Sunday, November 16, and nightly through Thursday, November 20.

Long-term single lane closures through late 2027.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: A new interchange is being constructed at Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 and Sand Lake Road/S.R. 482 in Orange County to enhance connectivity. This project also includes increasing roadway longevity and resiliency with the reconstruction of the Sand Lake Road bridge to accommodate new ramps, improving traffic flow by enhancing the intersection of Presidents Drive and Sand Lake Road, and providing sidewalks from John Young Parkway to Presidents Drive. Construction will continue through late 2027. Approximate cost: \$114.6 million.

**FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/S.R. 91 WIDENING PROJECT
FROM PARTIN SETTLEMENT ROAD TO OSCEOLA PARKWAY**

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 between Partin Settlement Road and Osceola Parkway (Milepost 243 to Milepost 249)

Overnight single lane closures, 7:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Sunday, November 16, and nightly through Thursday, November 20.

Intermittent daytime shoulder closures, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday, November 17, and daily through Saturday, November 22.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 between Osceola Parkway and Partin Settlement Road (Milepost 243 to Milepost 249)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, November 16, and nightly through Thursday, November 20.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 is being widened from two to four lanes, in each direction, from Partin Settlement Road to Osceola Parkway in Osceola County. As part of this project, interchange improvements are planned at Osceola Parkway (milepost 249), as well as bridge improvements and replacements throughout the project limits. This project also includes installing new roadway lighting, updated signage, fresh pavement markings, and guard rail to promote safer and more efficient travel. Construction will continue through early 2031. Approximate cost: \$321 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/S.R. 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM CLERMONT/S.R. 50 TO MINNEOLA/HANCOCK ROAD

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 between Clermont/S.R. 50 and Minneola/Hancock Road (Milepost 273 to Milepost 279)

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, November 16, and nightly through Thursday, November 20.

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 exit ramp to W. Colonial Drive/Winter Garden/Clermont/S.R. 50 (Exit 272)

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, November 16, and nightly through Thursday, November 20.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 entrance ramp from W. Colonial Drive/S.R. 50

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, November 16, and nightly through Thursday, November 20.

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 at W. Colonial Drive/S.R. 50 (Exit 272)

Overnight full road closure, 10 p.m. Thursday, November 20, to 5 a.m. Friday, November 21.

Detour Information:

- Northbound Florida's Turnpike traffic wishing to continue north will be directed to exit at W. Colonial Drive/S.R. 50 (Exit 272), travel west on S.R. 50 to N. Hancock Road, and travel north on N. Hancock Road to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 is being widened from four to eight lanes from Clermont/S.R. 50 to Minneola/Hancock Road in Lake and Orange counties. This project includes constructing a new Fosgate Road bridge over the Turnpike. The County Road (C.R.) 438 and C.R. 455 bridges will be replaced, as well as the Turnpike bridges over Jones Road, Old Highway 50, and Blackstill Lake Road. The West Orange Trail bridge over the Turnpike will be replaced with a prefabricated structure. New electronic tolling gantries will be installed, and the existing toll booths and canopies at the S.R. 50 entrance and exit ramps will be demolished. Safety improvements for this project include a new Intelligent Transportation system, signage, pavement markings, signalization, lighting, and drainage. Construction will continue through mid-2026. Approximate cost: \$162.3 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/S.R. 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM MINNEOLA/HANCOCK ROAD TO O'BRIEN ROAD

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 between Minneola/Hancock Road and north of O'Brien Road (Milepost 279 to Milepost 286)

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, November 16, and nightly through Thursday, November 20.

Intermittent daytime shoulder closures, 10 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, November 17, and daily through Friday, November 21.

Northbound and southbound Howey Road/S.R. 19 underneath Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91

Overnight full road closures, 9 p.m. Tuesday, November 18, to 5 a.m. Wednesday, November 19; and 9 p.m. Wednesday, November 19, to 5 a.m. Thursday, November 20.

Detour information:

- Northbound Howey Road/S.R. 19 traffic wishing to continue north will be directed to U.S. 27, travel northwest on U.S. 27 to O'Brien Road and travel northeast on O'Brien Road to access S.R. 19.
- Southbound Howey Road/S.R. 19 traffic wishing to continue south will be directed to O'Brien Road, travel southwest on O'Brien Road to U.S. 27, travel northwest and U-turn on U.S. 27 to access S.R. 19.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 is being widened from four to eight lanes from Minneola/Hancock Road to north of O'Brien Road in Lake County. This project includes replacing the bridges at Scrub Jay Lane, C.R. 561, U.S. 19, and U.S. 27/S.R. 19 South. New electronic tolling gantries and buildings will be installed, as well as new stormwater treatment facilities. Safety improvements for this project include new signage, pavement markings, signalization, and lighting. Construction will continue through late 2028. Approximate cost: \$233 million.

SOUTHERN CONNECTOR EXTENSION/S.R. 417 RESURFACING AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM CELEBRATION AVENUE TO INTERNATIONAL DRIVE

Northbound and southbound Southern Connector Extension/S.R. 417 between Celebration Avenue and International Drive/World Center Drive (Milepost 2 to Milepost 6)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, November 16, and nightly through Thursday, November 20.

Southbound Southern Connector Extension/S.R. 417 exit ramp to Osceola Parkway (Exit 3)

Overnight full ramp closures, 8 p.m. Tuesday, November 18, to 6 a.m. Wednesday, November 19.

Detour Information:

- Southbound Southern Connector Extension/S.R. 417 traffic wishing to access Osceola Parkway will be directed to exit at Celebration Ave (Exit 2), travel north on Celebration Avenue to W. Irlo Bronson Memorial Highway/U.S. 192, travel east on U.S. 192 to International Drive, and travel north on International Drive to access Osceola Parkway.

Southbound Southern Connector Extension/S.R. 417 entrance ramp from Osceola Parkway

Overnight full ramp closures, 8 p.m. Wednesday, November 19, to 6 a.m. Thursday, November 20.

Detour Information:

- Osceola Parkway traffic wishing to access southbound Southern Connector Extension/SR 417 will be directed to travel west to International Drive, travel south on International Drive to W. Irlo Bronson Memorial Highway/U.S. 192, travel west on U.S. 192 to Celebration Avenue, and travel south on Celebration Avenue to access southbound S.R. 417.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Southern Connector Extension/S.R. 417 is being resurfaced from Celebration Avenue (milepost 2) to International Drive/World Center Drive (milepost 6) in Osceola and Orange counties. Work will include paving the Southern Connector Extension mainline and the interchanges at Celebration Avenue (Exit 2) and Osceola Parkway (Exit 3). This project also includes installing new guardrails, rumble strips, and highly reflective signs and pavement markings, and upgrading existing drainage. Construction will continue through early 2026. Approximate cost: \$10.7 million.

SEMINOLE EXPRESSWAY/S.R. 417 RESURFACING AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM AIRPORT BOULEVARD TO TOWNE CENTER BOULEVARD

Northbound and southbound Seminole Expressway/S.R. 417 between Airport Boulevard and Rinehart Road (Milepost 49 to Milepost 55)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, November 16, and nightly through Thursday, November 20.

Daytime shoulder closures, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday, November 17, and daily through Friday, November 21.

Southbound Seminole Expressway/S.R. 417 exit ramp to Sanford/U.S. 17/US 92 (Exit 50)

Overnight full ramp closures, 8 p.m. Wednesday, November 19, to 6 a.m. Thursday, November 20; and 8 p.m. Thursday, November 20, to 6 a.m. Friday, November 21.

Detour information:

- Southbound Seminole Expressway/ S.R. 417 traffic wishing to access U.S. 17/U.S. 92 (Exit 50) will be directed to exit at H.E. Thomas Jr. Parkway/C.R.46A (Exit 52), and travel east on C.R. 46A to access U.S. 17/U.S. 92.

Northbound Seminole Expressway/S.R. 417 exit ramp to Rinehart Road/C.R. 431B/Sanford/Lake Mary (Exit 54)

Overnight full ramp closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, November 16, and nightly through Thursday, November 20.

Detour information:

- Northbound Seminole Expressway/S.R. 417 traffic wishing to access Rinehart Road/C.R. 431B/Sanford/Lake Mary (Exit 54) will be directed to exit at H.E. Thomas Jr Parkway/C.R. 46A (Exit 52), and travel west on C.R. 46A to access Rinehart Road.

Northbound Seminole Expressway/S.R.417 entrance ramp from Rinehart Road

Overnight full ramp closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, November 17, and nightly through Thursday, November 20.

Detour information:

- Rinehart Road traffic wishing to access northbound Seminole Expressway/S.R. 417 will travel south on Rinehart Road to C.R. 46A, travel west on C.R. 46A to International Parkway, and travel north on International Parkway to access northbound Seminole Expressway.

Southbound Seminole Expressway/S.R.417 entrance ramp from Rinehart Road

Overnight full ramp closure, 10 p.m. Tuesday, November 18, to 6 a.m. Wednesday, November 19.

Overnight full ramp closures, 8 p.m. Wednesday, November 19, to 6 a.m. Thursday, November 20; and 8 p.m. Thursday, November 20, to 6 a.m. Friday, November 21.

Detour information:

- Rinehart Road traffic wishing to access southbound Seminole Expressway/S.R. 417 will travel south on Rinehart Road to C.R. 46A, and travel east on C.R. 46A to access southbound Seminole Expressway.

Southbound Seminole Expressway/S.R. 417 entrance ramp from C.R. 46A

Overnight full ramp closures, 8 p.m. Wednesday, November 19, to 6 a.m. Thursday, November 20; and 8 p.m. Thursday, November 20, to 6 a.m. Friday, November 21.

Detour information:

- C.R. 46A traffic wishing to access southbound Seminole Expressway/S.R. 417 will travel east on C.R. 46A to West Airport Boulevard, and travel south on West Airport Boulevard to access southbound Seminole Expressway.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Seminole Expressway/S.R. 417 is being resurfaced from south of Airport Boulevard (milepost 49) to north of Towne Center Boulevard (milepost 55) in Seminole County. Work will include paving Seminole Expressway and the ramps at Rinehart Road, W. 25th Street/H.E. Thomas Jr. Parkway, and Airport Boulevard. This project also includes enhancing the bridge deck expansion joints, installing new guardrails, signs and wrong-way vehicle detection system, and upgrading existing drainage. Construction will continue through late 2026. Approximate cost: \$17.4 million.

SEMINOLE EXPRESSWAY/S.R. 417 WIDENING PROJECT FROM ALOMA AVENUE/S.R. 426 TO S.R. 434

Northbound and southbound Seminole Expressway/S.R. 417 between south of Aloma Avenue/S.R. 426 and north of S.R. 434 (Milepost 38 to Milepost 44)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, November 16, and nightly through Thursday, November 20.

Daytime shoulder closures, 10 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, November 17, and daily through Friday, November 21.

Northbound Seminole Expressway/S.R. 417 entrance ramp from Aloma Avenue/S.R. 426

Daytime shoulder closures, 10 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, November 17, and daily through Friday, November 21.

Northbound Seminole Expressway/S.R. 417 entrance ramp from Aloma Avenue/S.R. 426

Overnight full ramp closures, 11:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, November 16, and nightly through Thursday, November 20.

Detour information:

- Aloma Avenue/S.R. 426 traffic wishing to access northbound Seminole Expressway/S.R. 417 will be directed to Red Bug Lake Road, and travel west on Red Bug Lake Road to access northbound Seminole Expressway.

Southbound Seminole Expressway/S.R. 417 exit ramp to Aloma Avenue/S.R. 426 (Exit 38)

Overnight full ramp closures, 11:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, November 16, and nightly through Thursday, November 20.

Detour Information:

- Southbound Seminole Expressway/S.R. 417 traffic wishing to access Aloma Avenue/S.R. 426 (Exit 38) will be directed to exit at Red Bug Lake Road (Exit 44), and travel east on Red Bug Lake Road to access Aloma Avenue.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Seminole Expressway/S.R. 417 is being widened from four to eight lanes between Aloma Avenue/S.R. 426 and north of S.R. 434 in Seminole County. This project includes adding two lanes in each direction of Seminole

Expressway, replacing five bridges, and widening 12 existing bridges. Work also consists of installing new underdeck lighting, highly reflective signage, and pavement markings. Construction will continue through late 2030. Approximate cost: \$300 million.

BEACHLINE EAST EXPRESSWAY/S.R. 528 INTELLIGENT TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM ENHANCEMENTS PROJECT FROM S.R. 520 TO INDUSTRY ROAD

Eastbound and westbound Beachline East Expressway/S.R. 528 between S.R. 520 and Industry Road/Clearlake Road/S.R. 524

Intermittent daytime shoulder closures, 7 a.m. to 6 p.m., Monday, November 17, and daily through Friday, November 21.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Intelligent Transportation System (ITS) devices along Beachline East Expressway/S.R. 528 are being enhanced at various locations between S.R. 520 and Industry Road in Orange and Brevard counties. This project includes adding roadway weather systems, closed circuit television, overhead dynamic messaging signs, and full color overhead electronic signs. A new lighting system will also be installed at the Industry Road/Clearlake Road/S.R. 524 interchange. Construction will continue through early 2026. Approximate cost: \$19.5 million.

TRANSPORTATION SYSTEMS MANAGEMENT AND OPERATIONS (TSM&O) PROJECT DANIEL WEBSTER WESTERN BELTWAY/S.R. 429 AND U.S. 192 INTERCHANGE

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Daniel Webster Western Beltway/S.R. 429 and U.S. 192 interchange is undergoing significant enhancements to increase capacity, improve mobility, and enhance safety in Orange County. As part of these improvements, we are adding a new lane and extending the existing southbound S.R. 429 exit ramp to U.S. 192. At the intersection of the southbound S.R. 429 exit ramp and U.S. 192, three right-turn lanes and two left-turn lanes will also be constructed. This project also includes installing new signage, pavement markings, and lighting. Construction will continue through late 2026. Approximate cost: \$14.5 million.

VETERANS EXPRESSWAY/SUNCOAST PARKWAY & POLK PARKWAY HILLSBOROUGH, PASCO, HERNANDO, CITRUS and POLK COUNTIES

SUNCOAST PARKWAY/S.R. 589 RESURFACING AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM S.R. 54 TO S.R. 52

Northbound Suncoast Parkway/S.R. 589 between Milepost 22.5 and Milepost 28.5

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 7 a.m., Sunday, November 16, and nightly through Thursday, November 20.

Southbound Suncoast Parkway/S.R. 589 between San Antonio/Dade City/New Port Richey/S.R. 52 (Exit 27) and New Port Richey/Zephyrhills/S.R. 54 (Exit 19)

Overnight single lane closures, 7:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Sunday, November 16, and nightly through Thursday, November 20.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Suncoast Parkway/S.R. 589 is being resurfaced from south of S.R. 54 (milepost 17.5) to north of S.R. 52 (milepost 28.5) in Pasco County. Safety improvements for this project include new signage, pavement markings, and replacing the bridge joints over Ridge Road. Construction will continue through early 2027. Approximate cost: \$23 million.

SUNCOAST PARKWAY/S.R. 589 EXTENSION PROJECT

FROM W. NORVELL HIGHWAY/C.R. 486 TO C.R. 495

Westbound W. Norvell Bryant Highway/C.R. 486 between W. Pine Ridge Boulevard and N. Miller Run Terrace

Daytime single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Monday, November 17, and daily through Friday, November 21.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Suncoast Parkway/S.R. 589 is being extended 5.5 miles from W. Norvell Bryant Highway/C.R. 486 to C.R. 495. This new four-lane tolled roadway (two lanes in each direction) will complete the interchange at C.R. 486, add a partial interchange at C.R. 495 and widen and realign C.R. 495. The project also includes installing new lighting, signage, pavement markings, guardrail and wrong-way driving vehicle detection technology. Construction will continue through mid-2030. Approximate cost: \$195 million.

CENTRAL POLK PARKWAY/S.R. 570B PROJECT FROM POLK PARKWAY/S.R. 570 TO U.S. 17/S.R. 35

Eastbound and westbound Polk Parkway/S.R. 570 between Milepost 13 and Milepost 16.5

Overnight single lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, November 16, and nightly through Thursday, November 20.

Westbound Polk Parkway/S.R. 570 at Winter Lake Road/S.R. 540 (Exit 14)

Overnight full road closures, 8:30 p.m. Sunday, November 16, to 6 a.m. Monday, November 17; and 8:30 p.m. Monday, November 17, to 6 a.m. Tuesday, November 18.

Detour information:

- Westbound Polk Parkway/S.R. 570 traffic wishing to access Winter Lake Road/S.R. 540 (Exit 14), will be directed to exit at U.S. 92 (Exit 17), travel east on U.S. 92 to Recker Highway/C.R. 655, travel south on C.R. 655 to Spirit Lake Road, and travel south on Spirit Lake Road to access Winter Lake Road.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Central Polk Parkway/S.R. 570B, a new, four-lane (two lanes in each direction), tolled roadway is being constructed in Polk County. This new stretch of roadway will begin at Polk Parkway/S.R. 570 and Winter Lake Road/S.R. 540 and extend approximately 6.5 miles to U.S. 17/S.R. 35. Construction will continue through 2029. Approximate cost: \$257 million.

POLK PARKWAY/S.R. 570 RESURFACING AND ROADSIDE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM WEST OF LAKELAND HIGHLANDS ROAD TO SOUTH OF U.S. 92

Eastbound and westbound Polk Parkway/S.R. 570 between east of Lakeland Highlands Road (Exit 9) and west of Lakeland/Auburndale/U.S. 92 (Exit 17)

Overnight single lane closures, 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, November 16, and nightly through Thursday, November 20.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Polk Parkway/S.R. 570 is being resurfaced from west of Lakeland Highlands Road (milepost 8) to south of U.S. 92 (milepost 17) in Polk County. Work includes paving Polk Parkway, the U.S. 98 ramps, Lakeland Highlands Road, and Winter Lake Road. This project also includes installing new guardrails, rumble strips, highly reflective signs and pavement markings and upgrading existing drainage. Construction will continue through mid-2026. Approximate cost: \$20 million.

**CENTRAL FLORIDA WRONG-WAY VEHICLE DETECTION
TECHNOLOGY IMPLEMENTATION PROJECT**

Southbound Suncoast Expressway/S.R. 589 exit ramp to S.R. 52 (Exit 27)

Overnight full ramp closures, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, November 17, and nightly through Thursday November 20.

Detour information:

- Southbound Suncoast Parkway/S.R. 589 traffic wishing to access S.R. 52 (Exit 27) will be directed to exit at Ayers Road/C.R. 578, travel east on Ayers Road to U.S. 41, and travel south on U.S. 41 to access S.R. 52.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Wrong-Way Vehicle Detection Systems (WWVDS) are being enhanced throughout Hillsborough, Pasco, Hernando, Polk, Orange, and Brevard counties. Work includes increasing the amount of wrong-way signage, roadway reflectors and pavement markings in locations along Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91, Beachline Expressway/S.R. 528, Polk Parkway/S.R. 570, and Veterans Expressway/Suncoast Parkway/S.R. 589.
