Notes:

1. Tolls were suspended on west central Florida facilities and on a segment of the central Florida Turnpike Mainline from October 7, 2024, through October 18, 2024 (FY 2025) due to Hurricane Milton, resulting in a revenue loss of approximately \$18.3 million.
2. Tolls were suspended on west central Florida facilities and on a segment of the central Florida Turnpike Mainline from August 29, 2023, through September 5, 2023 (FY 2024) due to Hurricane Idalia, resulting in a revenue loss of approximately \$5.1 million.
3. The Garcon Point Bridge was transferred to the Turnpike on February 1, 2024 (FY 2024). Accordingly, transactions and toll revenues collected on the bridge are included in the Turnpike monthly transactions and revenues starting this date.
