



Turnpike Extension/S.R. 821 Lighting Improvements Project

Project Overview

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is improving the existing roadway lighting along Florida's Turnpike Extension/State Road (S.R.) 821 from high-pressure sodium to LED lighting, from SW 152 Street to SW 137 Avenue in Miami-Dade County. This work includes lighting enhancements at the SW 152 Street, SW 137 Avenue, and SW 112 Avenue interchanges.

This upgrade will increase roadway safety by providing better visibility for drivers while reducing long-term maintenance costs using modern, energy-efficient lighting.

Construction activities will occur during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience occasional impacts from construction-related light, noise, vibration, or dust. The Enterprise is committed to minimizing these disruptions and takes steps to limit traffic delays and noise.

Lane closures will generally take place during off-peak hours to reduce impacts on drivers. Information about closures will be provided in advance through the South Florida Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.

Project Schedule and Funding

Construction Timeline: Work is anticipated to continue through late 2026.

Project Cost: Approximately \$2.7 million.


