





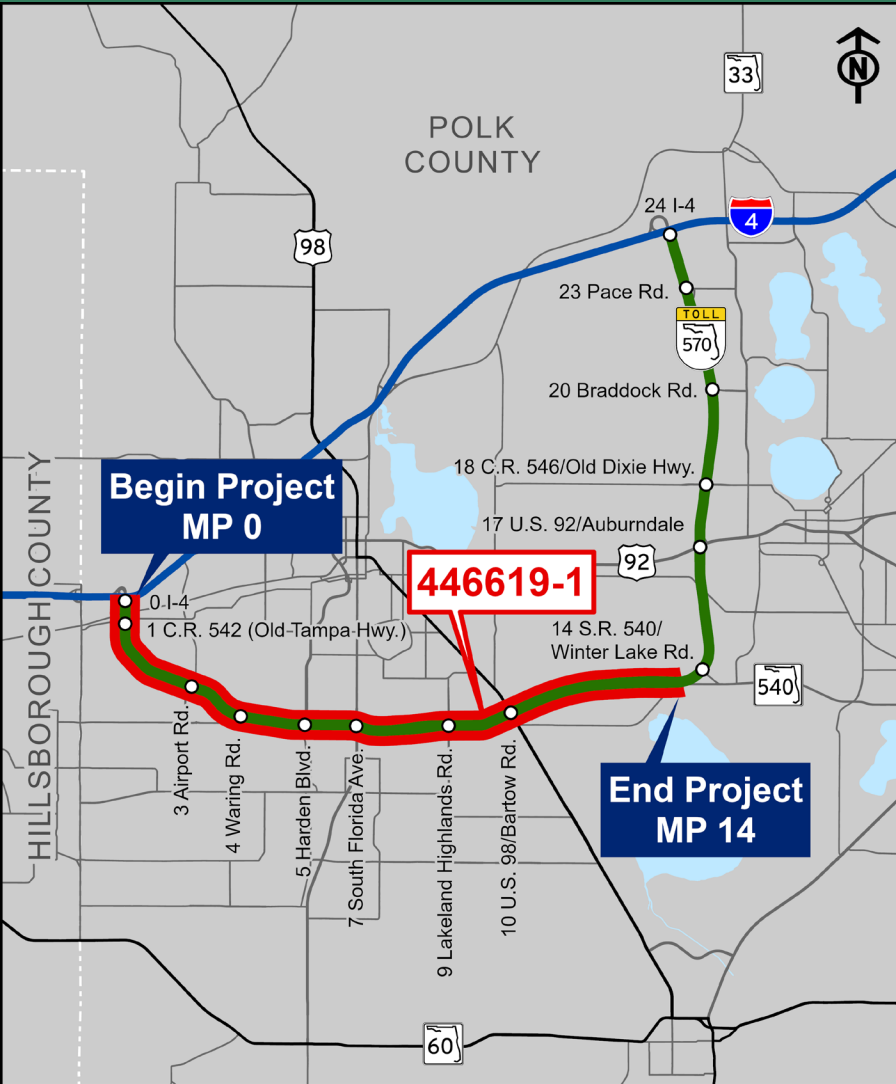

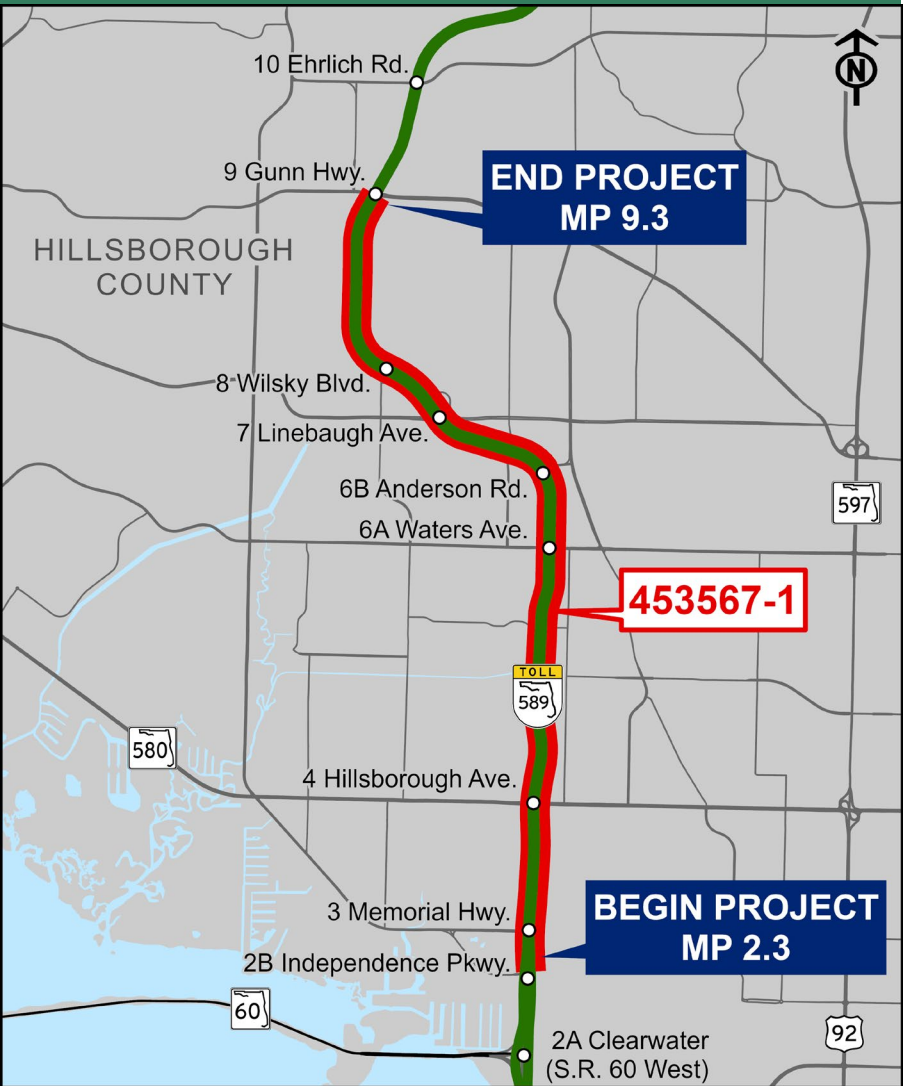

Existing conditions include 300-500 ft of limited access right-of-way, 35 bridges, and one box culvert. There are no existing noise walls / sound barriers within this segment.
