TURNPIKE EXTENSION/S.R. 821 (Mileposts 0 to 47) MIAMI-DADE and BROWARD COUNTIES

TURNPIKE EXTENSION/STATE ROAD (S.R.) 821 WIDENING PROJECT FROM CAMPBELL DRIVE TO TALLAHASSEE ROAD

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 821 between Campbell Drive/SW 312 Street and Tallahassee Road/SW 137 Avenue (Milepost 3 to Milepost 7)

Overnight single lane closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, January 4, to 6 a.m. Monday, January 5.
Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, January 5, and nightly through Thursday, January 8.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 821 between Tallahassee Road/SW 137 Avenue and Campbell Drive/SW 312 Street (Milepost 7 to Milepost 3)

Overnight single lane closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, January 4, to 7 a.m. Monday, January 5.
Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 7 a.m., Monday, January 5, and nightly through Thursday, January 8.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 821 is being widened from four to six lanes from Campbell Drive/SW 312 Street to Tallahassee Road/SW 137 Avenue in Miami-Dade County. This project includes reconstructing the Turnpike bridges within the corridor, improving the interchanges at Biscayne Drive and Tallahassee Road and constructing a new northbound entrance ramp from Tallahassee Road. Construction is scheduled to continue through mid-2028. Approximate cost: \$99 million.

**TURNPIKE EXTENSION/S.R. 821 AND SURFACE STREET IMPROVEMENTS
FROM HAINLIN MILL ROAD/SW 216 STREET TO U.S. 1**

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 821 between Cutler Ridge Boulevard/SW 211 Street and U.S. 1 (Milepost 11 to Milepost 12.5)

Overnight single lane closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, January 4, to 7 a.m. Monday, January 5. Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 7 a.m., Monday, January 5, and nightly through Thursday, January 8.

Eastbound Caribbean Boulevard/SW 200 Street between SW 107 Avenue and U.S. 1

Overnight single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 7 a.m., Sunday, January 4, and nightly through Thursday, January 8.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 821 is being improved between Hainlin Mill Road/SW 216 Street and Caribbean Boulevard/SW 200 Street in Miami-Dade County. Work includes widening Hainlin Mill Road, Cutler Ridge Boulevard/SW 211 Street, the northbound Turnpike bridge over Caribbean Boulevard, westbound Eureka Drive underneath the Turnpike and southbound Frontage Road. Additional improvements include bridge repairs, noise walls along qualifying residential areas, upgrading signalization, pedestrian features, and lighting. Construction is scheduled to continue through mid-2027. Approximate cost: \$37 million.

**TURNPIKE EXTENSION/S.R. 821 WIDENING PROJECT
FROM NW 106 STREET TO INTERSTATE 75 (I-75)**

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 821 between NW 106 Street and I-75 (Milepost 34 to Milepost 39)

Overnight single and double lane closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, January 4, to 5 a.m. Monday, January 5.

Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, January 5, and nightly through Thursday, January 8.

Eastbound and westbound Okeechobee Road/U.S. 27 between NW 138 Street and NW 118 Avenue

Overnight single and double lane closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, January 4, to 5 a.m. Monday, January 5. Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, January 5, and nightly through Thursday, January 8.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 821 is being widened to 10 lanes between NW 106 Street and I-75. The project entails constructing a new eastbound Okeechobee Road to southbound Florida's Turnpike entrance ramp and a new northbound Florida's Turnpike exit ramp to eastbound Okeechobee Road, as well as an additional lane in each direction on Okeechobee Road between west of the Turnpike and NW 107 Avenue. Work also consists of constructing a new diverging diamond interchange at Florida's Turnpike and NW 170 Street. Resurfacing, guardrail and fencing, lane striping, stormwater drainage, signage and lighting improvements will also be installed as part of this project. Construction will continue through mid-2026. Approximate cost: \$370 million.

GOLDEN GLADES INTERCHANGE (GGI) PROJECT

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 between Miami Gardens Drive/NW 183 Street and I-95

Overnight single and double lane closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, January 4, to 5 a.m. Monday, January 5. Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, January 5, and nightly through Thursday, January 8.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/S.R. 91 TRANSPORTATION SYSTEMS MANAGEMENT & OPERATIONS (TSM&O) PROJECT FROM TURNPIKE EXTENSION/S.R. 821 TO GRIFFIN ROAD/S.R. 818

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 between Turnpike Extension/S.R. 821 and Griffin Road/S.R. 818 (Milepost 47 to Milepost 54)

Overnight single and double lane closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, January 4, to 6 a.m. Monday, January 5. Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, January 5, and nightly through Thursday, January 8. A second lane may close at 9 p.m. and reopen at 5 a.m.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Auxiliary Lanes are being added to Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 from the Turnpike Extension/S.R. 821 to Griffin Road/S.R. 818. This project will increase roadway capacity, reduce congestion and improve travel times. The project also includes safety improvements at Hollywood Boulevard/S.R. 820 and SW 63 Terrace by closing the median to reduce vehicle conflict points and accidents, and at Hollywood Boulevard and S. 62 Avenue by eliminating the eastbound and westbound turn lanes. Construction will continue through mid-2029. Approximate cost: \$230 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/S.R. 91 TSM&O PROJECT FROM SOUTH OF SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/S.R. 869 TO NORTH OF GLADES ROAD/S.R. 808

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 is undergoing significant enhancements between south of Sawgrass Expressway/S.R. 869 (milepost 71) and north of Glades Road/S.R. 808 (milepost 76) in Broward and Palm Beach counties. As part of these improvements, a new lane is being added in each direction within the project limits to increase capacity, reduce congestion, and enhance safety. This project also includes installing new roadway lighting, signage, fresh pavement markings, and upgrading the intelligent transportation system to promote safer and more efficient travel. Noise walls will be constructed along qualifying residential areas. Construction will continue through 2029. Approximate cost: \$100 million.

SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/S.R. 869 WIDENING PROJECT FROM ATLANTIC BOULEVARD TO SAMPLE ROAD/S.R. 834

Northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway/S.R. 869 between north of Atlantic Boulevard and north of Sample Road/S.R. 834 (Milepost 9 to Milepost 12)

Overnight single and double lane closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, January 4, to 6 a.m. Monday, January 5. Overnight single and double lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, January 5, and nightly through Thursday, January 8.

Northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway/S.R. 869 entrance and exit ramps at Sample Road/S.R. 834 (Exit 11)

Overnight full ramp closures, 11:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, January 4, and nightly through Thursday, January 8.

Detour information:

- Sample Road/S.R. 834 traffic wishing to access northbound Sawgrass Expressway/S.R. 869 will be directed to Coral Ridge Drive, and travel north on Coral Ridge Drive to access northbound Sawgrass Expressway.
- Sample Road/S.R. 834 traffic wishing to access southbound Sawgrass Expressway/S.R. 869 will be directed to Coral Ridge Drive, travel south on Coral Ridge Drive to Atlantic Boulevard, and travel west on Atlantic Boulevard to access southbound Sawgrass Expressway.
- Northbound Sawgrass Expressway/S.R. 869 traffic wishing to access Sample Road/S.R. 834 (Exit 11) will be directed to exit at Atlantic Boulevard (Exit 8), travel east on Atlantic Boulevard to Coral Ridge Drive, and travel north on Coral Ridge Drive to access Sample Road.
- Southbound Sawgrass Expressway/S.R. 869 traffic wishing to access Sample Road/S.R. 834 (Exit 11) will be directed to exit at Coral Ridge Drive (Exit 14), and travel south on Coral Ridge Drive to access Sample Road.

** Please note, the northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway/S.R. 869 entrance and exit ramps at Sample Road/S.R. 834 (Exit 11) will not be closed at the same time.*

Eastbound Sample Road/S.R. 834 between Sawgrass Expressway/S.R. 869 and west of Sportsplex Drive

Daytime single and double lane closures, 7 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, January 5, and daily through Friday, January 9.

Westbound Sample Road/S.R. 834 between Sawgrass Expressway/S.R. 869 and west of Sportsplex Drive

Daytime single and double lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, January 5, and daily through Friday, January 9.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Sawgrass Expressway/S.R. 869 is being widened from six to 10 lanes from north of Atlantic Boulevard to north of Sample Road/S.R. 834, in Broward County. The new lanes constructed as part of this project will open upon completion of future adjacent widening projects. The Sample Road interchange will be converted to a partial diverging diamond interchange. Construction will continue through early 2028. Approximate cost: \$99.7 million.

**FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/S.R. 91 AND BOYNTON BEACH BOULEVARD/S.R. 804
INTERCHANGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT**

**Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 at Boynton Beach Boulevard/S.R. 804
(Milepost 86 to Milepost 87)**

Overnight single lane closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, January 4, to 6:30 a.m. Monday, January 5. Overnight single lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 6:30 a.m., Monday, January 5, and nightly through Thursday, January 8. A second lane may close at 10 p.m. and reopen by 6 a.m.

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 exit ramp to Boynton Beach Boulevard/S.R. 804 (Exit 86)

Overnight full ramp closures, 11 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, January 4, and nightly through Thursday, January 8.

Detour information:

- Northbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 traffic wishing to access Boynton Beach Boulevard/S.R. 804 (Exit 86) will be directed to exit at Atlantic Avenue/S.R. 806 (Exit 81), travel west on Atlantic Avenue to U.S. 441/S.R. 7, and travel north on U.S. 441 to access Boynton Beach Boulevard.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 and Boynton Beach Boulevard/S.R. 804 (Exit 86) interchange is undergoing significant enhancements to improve traffic flow and safety. This project includes a new westbound turn lane from Boynton Beach Boulevard to northbound Florida's Turnpike and an additional lane from the northbound Florida's Turnpike exit ramp to Boynton Beach Boulevard. Safety upgrades feature the installation of new highly reflective overhead signage and pavement markings, designed for optimal visibility in all lighting and weather conditions. Construction is scheduled to continue through late 2025. Approximate cost: \$9.5 million.

**FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/S.R. 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM NORTH OF BOYNTON BEACH
BOULEVARD/S.R. 804 TO NORTH OF LAKE WORTH ROAD/S.R. 802**

**Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 between Boynton Beach
Boulevard/S.R. 804 and north of Lake Worth Road/S.R. 802 (Milepost 87 to Milepost 95)**

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, January 5, and nightly through Thursday, January 8.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 is being widened to four lanes in each direction, from north of Boynton Beach Boulevard/S.R. 804 to north of Boynton Beach Boulevard/S.R. 804. This project also includes reconstructing the Hypoluxo Road bridge over Southern Turnpike Mainline to allow for the new road configuration. Additionally, sound barrier

walls will be constructed along qualifying residential areas. Bridge widening, road milling and resurfacing, signage and signal improvements are planned. Construction will continue through early 2026. Approximate cost: \$170 million.

WEST PALM BEACH SERVICE PLAZA PARKING IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The truck parking facility at the West Palm Beach Service Plaza is being improved. Truck parking will be consolidated in the northern section of the service plaza to enhance traffic flow and increase the number of available truck spaces. Construction will continue through late 2026. Approximate cost: \$32.4 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/S.R. 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM WEST PALM BEACH SERVICE PLAZA TO NORTH OF SOUTHERN BOULEVARD/U.S. 98/S.R. 80

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 is being widened from two to four lanes, in each direction, from West Palm Beach Service Plaza to north of Southern Boulevard/U.S. 98/S.R. 80 in Palm Beach County. This project includes reconstructing the Turnpike bridges over Forest Hill Boulevard/S.R. 882, Southern Boulevard, and Belvedere Road. Additionally, sound barrier walls will be constructed along qualifying residential areas. Safety upgrades feature the installation of new highly reflective overhead signage and pavement markings, designed for optimal visibility in all lighting and weather conditions. Construction will continue through early 2030. Approximate cost: \$258 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/S.R. 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM NORTH OF SOUTHERN BOULEVARD TO NORTH OF OKEECHOBEE BOULEVARD/S.R. 704

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 between Jog Road and north of Okeechobee Boulevard/S.R. 704 (Milepost 99 to Milepost 101)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, January 5, and nightly through Thursday, January 8.

Eastbound and westbound Okeechobee Boulevard/S.R. 704 between Vista Parkway and West Drive

Overnight single lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 6:30 a.m., Monday, January 5, and nightly through Thursday, January 8.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 is being widened from two to four lanes in each direction, from north of Southern Boulevard/S.R. 80 to north of Okeechobee Boulevard/S.R. 704 in Palm Beach County. This project includes reconstructing the Turnpike interchanges at Okeechobee Boulevard and Jog Road, including the addition of a new northbound Turnpike entrance ramp from Jog Road and a southbound Turnpike exit ramp to Jog Road. Additionally, this project includes reconstructing the bridges at Okeechobee Boulevard and Jog Road to increase longevity and reinforce durability. Sound barrier walls will be constructed along qualifying residential areas. Safety upgrades feature the installation of new roadway lighting, updated signage, fresh pavement markings, and guardrail to promote safer and more efficient travel. Construction will continue through 2030. Approximate cost: \$236 million.

**FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/S.R. 91 BRIDGE IMPROVEMENTS
PROJECT AT MILEPOST 138**

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 at Becker Road (Milepost 138)

Overnight single lane closure, 8:30 p.m. Thursday, January 8, to 6:30 a.m. Friday, January 9.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 bridge is being improved at milepost 138 over the C-23 canal, in Martin County. Safety upgrades feature the installation of new roadway lighting, updated signage, fresh pavement markings, and guardrail. Construction will continue through 2028. Approximate cost: \$42.5 million.

**SOUTH FLORIDA WRONG-WAY VEHICLE DETECTION
TECHNOLOGY IMPLEMENTATION PROJECT**

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Wrong-Way Vehicle Detection Technology is being implemented at additional locations on Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 821, from Allapattah Road/SW 112 Avenue to Tamiami Trail/U.S. 41/SW 8 Street in Miami-Dade County. The project aims to improve safety by providing wrong way driving detection systems along with new highly reflective signage and pavement markings, which will increase visibility in all lighting and weather conditions. These enhancements will assist in monitoring, detecting, and preventing wrong-way drivers, and notifying law enforcement and Traffic Management Center staff for response. Construction is scheduled to continue through late 2026. Approximate cost: \$3.3 million.
