



Construction Alert

Full Closure of Southbound Florida's Turnpike Between Allapattah Road and Biscayne Drive in Miami-Dade County

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise has scheduled a full closure of southbound Florida's Turnpike/State Road (S.R.) 821 between Allapattah Road/SW 112 Avenue/S.R. 989 (Exit 9) and Biscayne Drive/SW 288 (Exit 5) Street to allow crews to perform construction activities.

To perform this work, traffic will be detoured during the following dates and times:

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 821 between Allapattah Road/SW 112 Avenue/ S.R. 989 South (Exit 9A) and Biscayne Drive/SW 288 Street (Exit 5).

Overnight full road closure, 10 p.m. Tuesday, April 21, to 6 a.m. Wednesday, April 22. If necessary, this closure may also occur from 10 p.m. Wednesday, April 22, to 6 a.m. Thursday, April 23.

Detour information:

- Southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 821 traffic wishing to continue south will be directed to exit at Allapattah Road/SW 112 Avenue/S.R. 989 South (Exit 9), travel south on Allapattah Road to Moody Drive/SW 268 Street, travel west on Moody Drive to Tallahassee Road/SW 137 Avenue, travel south on Tallahassee Road to Biscayne Drive/SW 288 Street, and travel west on Biscayne Drive to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.

This work is part of the Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 821 Widening Project from Campbell Drive/SW 312 Street to Tallahassee Road/SW 137 Avenue. Please note, this schedule may change to inclement weather or unforeseen conditions.

Drivers are encouraged to stay alert, follow posted signs, and exercise caution through the work zone.
