CENTRAL TURNPIKE MAINLINE/STATE ROAD (S.R.) 91 (Mileposts 188 to 240) **OSCEOLA COUNTY**

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/S.R. 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM CLAY WHALEY ROAD TO U.S. 192 AND W. NOLTE ROAD INTERCHANGE

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 between Clay Whaley Road and U.S. 192 (Milepost 239 to Milepost 242)

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, May 31, and nightly through Thursday, June 4. Daytime intermittent shoulder closures, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday, June 1, and daily through Friday, June 5.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 is being widened from two to four lanes in each direction, from Clay Whaley Road (formerly Kissimmee Park Road) to U.S. 192 in Osceola County. This project includes constructing a new interchange at W. Nolte Road and removing the existing ramps at Clay Whaley Road once the new interchange is open to traffic. Construction will continue through early 2029. Approximate cost: \$193 million.

OSCEOLA, ORANGE, SEMINOLE, BREVARD, LAKE, and SUMTER COUNTIES

**FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/S.R. 91 AND SAND LAKE ROAD/S.R. 482
INTERCHANGE DEVELOPMENT PROJECT**

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 between Beachline Expressway/S.R. 528 and Interstate 4 (I-4) (Milepost 255 to Milepost 258)

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, May 31, and nightly through Thursday, June 4.

Daytime shoulder closures, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday, June 1, and daily through Friday, June 5.

Eastbound and westbound Sand Lake Road/S.R. 482 between John Young Parkway/S.R. 423 and Chancellor Drive

Long-term single lane closures through late 2027.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: A new interchange is being constructed at Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 and Sand Lake Road/S.R. 482 in Orange County to enhance connectivity. This project also includes increasing roadway longevity and resiliency with the reconstruction of the Sand Lake Road bridge to accommodate new ramps, improving traffic flow by enhancing the intersection of Presidents Drive and Sand Lake Road, and providing sidewalks from John Young Parkway to Presidents Drive. Construction will continue through late 2027. Approximate cost: \$114.6 million.

**FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/S.R. 91 WIDENING PROJECT
FROM PARTIN SETTLEMENT ROAD TO OSCEOLA PARKWAY**

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 between Kissimmee/St. Cloud/U.S. 192/U.S. 441 (Exit 242) and Osceola Parkway (Exit 249)

Daytime shoulder closures, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday, June 1, and daily through Friday, June 5.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 is being widened from two to four lanes, in each direction, from Partin Settlement Road to Osceola Parkway in Osceola County. As part of this project, interchange improvements are planned at Osceola Parkway (milepost 249), as well as bridge improvements and replacements throughout the project limits. This project also includes installing new roadway lighting, updated signage, fresh pavement markings, and guard rail to promote safer and more efficient travel. Construction will continue through early 2031. Approximate cost: \$345 million.

**FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/S.R. 91 TRANSPORTATION SYSTEMS MANAGEMENT & OPERATIONS
(TSM&O) PROJECT AT OCOEE/S.R. 50 EXIT RAMP (EXIT 267B)**

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Enhancements are being made at the Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 exit ramp to Ocoee/S.R. 50 (Exit 267B) in Orange County. This project will increase roadway capacity and improve traffic flow by adding an outside lane on eastbound S.R. 50, improve resilience by upgrading the entrance and exit ramps on eastbound S.R. 50 to support the new lane, and enhance safety by installing a new traffic signal to reduce conflict points for vehicles exiting Florida's Turnpike onto eastbound S.R. 50. Construction will continue through early 2027. Approximate cost: \$6 million.

**FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/S.R. 91 WIDENING PROJECT
FROM CLERMONT/S.R. 50 TO MINNEOLA/HANCOCK ROAD**

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 between Minneola/Hancock Road and north of O'Brien Road (Milepost 273 to Milepost 279)

Overnight single lane closures, 6:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, May 31, and nightly through Thursday, June 4.

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 exit ramp to Clermont/S.R. 50 (Exit 272)

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, May 31, and nightly through Thursday, June 4.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 entrance ramp from Clermont/S.R. 50

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, May 31, and nightly through Thursday, June 4.

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 exit ramp to Clermont/S.R. 50 (Exit 272)

Overnight full ramp closures, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, June 1, and nightly through Thursday, June 4.

Detour information:

- Northbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 traffic wishing to access Clermont/S.R. 50 (Exit 272) will be directed to exit at Ocoee/S.R. 50 (Exit 267B) to access S.R. 50.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 is being widened from four to eight lanes from Clermont/S.R. 50 to Minneola/Hancock Road in Lake and Orange counties. This project includes constructing a new Fosgate Road bridge over the Turnpike. The County Road (C.R.) 438 and C.R. 455 bridges will be replaced, as well as the Turnpike bridges over Jones Road, Old Highway 50, and Blackstill Lake Road. The West Orange Trail bridge over the Turnpike will be replaced with a prefabricated structure. New electronic tolling gantries will be installed, and the existing toll booths and canopies at the S.R. 50 entrance and exit ramps will be demolished. Safety improvements for this project include a new Intelligent Transportation system, signage, pavement markings, signalization, lighting, and drainage. Construction will continue through mid-2026. Approximate cost: \$162.3 million.

**FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/S.R. 91 WIDENING PROJECT
FROM MINNEOLA/HANCOCK ROAD TO O'BRIEN ROAD**

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 between Minneola/Hancock Road and north of O'Brien Road (Milepost 279 to Milepost 286)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, May 31, and nightly through Thursday, June 4.

Daytime intermittent shoulder closures, 10 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, June 1 and daily through Friday, June 5.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 exit ramp to Minneola/Hancock Road (Exit 278)

Overnight full ramp closures, 8 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, May 31, and nightly through Wednesday, June 3.

Detour information:

- Southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 traffic wishing to access Minneola/Hancock Road (Exit 278) will be directed to exit at Leesburg/Tavares/U.S. 27/S.R. 19 (Exit 289), travel south on U.S. 27 to Old Highway 50, and travel east on Old Highway 50 to access N. Hancock Road.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 is being widened from four to eight lanes from Minneola/Hancock Road to north of O'Brien Road in Lake County. This project includes replacing the bridges at Scrub Jay Lane, C.R. 561, U.S. 19, and U.S. 27/S.R. 19 South. New electronic tolling gantries and buildings will be installed, as well as new stormwater treatment facilities. Safety improvements for this project include new signage, pavement markings, signalization, and lighting. Construction will continue through late 2028. Approximate cost: \$233 million.

SOUTHERN CONNECTOR EXTENSION/S.R. 417 RESURFACING AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM CELEBRATION AVENUE TO INTERNATIONAL DRIVE

Northbound and southbound Southern Connector Extension/S.R. 417 between Celebration Avenue and International Drive/World Center Drive (Milepost 2 to Milepost 6)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. Sunday, May 31, to 6 a.m. Monday, June 1; and 8 p.m. Monday, June 1, to 6 a.m. Tuesday, June 2.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Southern Connector Extension/S.R. 417 is being resurfaced from Celebration Avenue (milepost 2) to International Drive/World Center Drive (milepost 6) in Osceola and Orange counties. Work will include paving the Southern Connector Extension mainline and the interchanges at Celebration Avenue (Exit 2) and Osceola Parkway (Exit 3). This project also includes installing new guardrails, rumble strips, and highly reflective signs and pavement markings, and upgrading existing drainage. Construction will continue through early 2026. Approximate cost: \$10.7 million.

SEMINOLE EXPRESSWAY/S.R. 417 WIDENING PROJECT FROM ALOMA AVENUE/S.R. 426 TO S.R. 434

Northbound and southbound Seminole Expressway/S.R. 417 between south of Aloma Avenue/S.R. 426 and north of S.R. 434 (Milepost 38 to Milepost 44)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, May 31, and nightly through Thursday, June 4.

Daytime shoulder closures, 10 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, June 1, and daily through Friday, June 5.

Eastbound and westbound Aloma Avenue/S.R. 426 underneath Seminole Expressway/S.R. 417

Overnight full road closures, 11:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Monday, May 31, and nightly through Thursday, June 4.

Detour information:

- Aloma Avenue/S.R. 426 traffic wishing to continue east will be directed to Tuskawilla Road/C.R. 419, travel north on Tuskawilla Road to Red Bug Lake Road, and travel east on Red Bug Lake Road to access Aloma Avenue.
- Aloma Avenue/S.R. 426 traffic wishing to continue west will be directed to Red Bug Lake Road, travel west on Red Bug Lake Road to Tuskawilla Road/C.R. 419, and travel south on Tuskawilla Road to access Aloma Avenue.
- Northbound Seminole Expressway/S.R. 417 traffic wishing to access westbound Aloma Avenue/S.R. 426 will be directed to exit at Aloma Avenue/S.R. 426 (Exit 38), travel east on Aloma

Avenue to Red Bug Lake Road, travel west on Red Bug Lake Road to Tuskawilla Road/C.R. 419, and travel south on Tuskawilla Road to access Aloma Avenue.

- Southbound Seminole Expressway/S.R. 417 traffic wishing to access eastbound Aloma Avenue/S.R. 426 will be directed to exit at Aloma Avenue/S.R. 426 (Exit 38), travel west on Aloma Avenue to Tuskawilla Road/C.R. 419, travel north on Tuskawilla Road to Red Bug Lake Road, and travel east on Red Bug Lake Road to access Aloma Avenue.

** Please note, the northbound and southbound exit ramps to Aloma Avenue will remain open during these closures.*

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Seminole Expressway/S.R. 417 is being widened from four to eight lanes between Aloma Avenue/S.R. 426 and north of S.R. 434 in Seminole County. This project includes adding two lanes in each direction of Seminole Expressway, replacing five bridges, and widening 12 existing bridges. Work also consists of installing new underdeck lighting, highly reflective signage, and pavement markings. Construction will continue through late 2030. Approximate cost: \$300 million.

SEMINOLE EXPRESSWAY/S.R. 417 RESURFACING AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM AIRPORT BOULEVARD TO TOWNE CENTER BOULEVARD

Northbound and southbound Seminole Expressway/S.R. 417 between Airport Boulevard and Rinehart Road (Milepost 49 to Milepost 56)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, May 31, and nightly through Thursday, June 4.

Daytime intermittent shoulder closures, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday, June 1, and daily through Friday, June 5.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Seminole Expressway/S.R. 417 is being resurfaced from south of Airport Boulevard (milepost 49) to north of Towne Center Boulevard (milepost 55) in Seminole County. Work will include paving Seminole Expressway and the ramps at Rinehart Road, W. 25th Street/H.E. Thomas Jr. Parkway, and Airport Boulevard. This project also includes enhancing the bridge deck expansion joints, installing new guardrails, signs and wrong-way vehicle detection system, and upgrading existing drainage. Construction will continue through late 2026. Approximate cost: \$17.4 million.

HEMPEL AVENUE BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT OVER SPESSARD L. HOLLAND EAST-WEST EXPRESSWAY/S.R. 408

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Hempel Avenue bridge over Spessard L. Holland East-West Expressway/S.R. 408 is being replaced in Orange County. The bridge will be made longer and raised to accommodate the future widening of S.R. 408 to four lanes in each direction. This project also includes adding a sidewalk in each direction across the bridge, enhancing pedestrian access and safety for the community. Construction will continue through early 2027. Approximate cost: \$23 million.

DANIEL WEBSTER WESTERN BELTWAY/S.R. 429 TRANSPORTATION SYSTEMS MANAGEMENT AND OPERATIONS PROJECT AT U.S. 192 INTERCHANGE

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Daniel Webster Western Beltway/S.R. 429 and U.S. 192 interchange is undergoing significant enhancements to increase capacity, improve mobility, and enhance safety in Orange County. As part of these improvements, we are adding a new lane and extending the existing southbound S.R. 429 exit ramp to U.S. 192. At the intersection of the southbound S.R. 429 exit ramp and U.S. 192, three right-turn lanes and two left-turn lanes will also be constructed. This project

also includes installing new signage, pavement markings, and lighting. Construction will continue through late 2026. Approximate cost: \$14.5 million.

**SUNCOAST PARKWAY/S.R. 589 RESURFACING AND SAFETY
IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM S.R. 54 TO S.R. 52**

Northbound Suncoast Parkway/S.R. 589 between Milepost 17 and S.R. 54 (Milepost 19)

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 7 a.m., Sunday, May 31, and nightly through Tuesday, June 2.

Southbound Suncoast Parkway/S.R. 589 between Milepost 17 and S.R. 54 (Milepost 19)

Overnight single lane closure, 7:30 p.m. Thursday June 4, to 5:30 a.m. Friday, June 5.

Southbound Suncoast Parkway/S.R. 589 between Milepost 17.5 and north of S.R. 54 (Milepost 19.5)

Southbound Suncoast Parkway/S.R. 589 between north of S.R. 54 (Milepost 20) and south of S.R. 54 (Milepost 18)

Overnight single lane closures, 7:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Tuesday June 2, and nightly through Thursday June 4.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Suncoast Parkway/S.R. 589 is being resurfaced from south of S.R. 54 (milepost 17.5) to north of S.R. 52 (milepost 28.5) in Pasco County. Safety improvements for this project include new signage, pavement markings, and replacing the bridge joints over Ridge Road. Construction will continue through early 2027. Approximate cost: \$23 million.

SUNCOAST PARKWAY/S.R. 589 AT S.R. 52 PEDESTRIAN OVERPASS PROJECT

Southbound Suncoast Parkway/S.R. 589 exit ramp to Dade City/New Port Richey/S.R.52 (Exit 27)

Daytime intermittent single lane closures, 7 a.m. to 5:30 p.m., Monday, June 1, and daily through Friday, June 5.

SUNCOAST PARKWAY/S.R. 589 EXTENSION PROJECT FROM W. NORVELL HIGHWAY/C.R. 486 TO C.R. 495

Northbound N. Citrus Avenue/C.R. 495 between W. Far Hills Lane and W. Emerald Oaks Drive

Daytime intermittent single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday, June 1, and daily through Friday, June 5.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Suncoast Parkway/S.R. 589 is being extended 5.5 miles from W. Norvell Bryant Highway/C.R. 486 to C.R. 495. This new four-lane tolled roadway (two lanes in each direction) will complete the interchange at C.R. 486, add a partial interchange at C.R. 495 and widen and realign C.R. 495. The project also includes installing new lighting, signage, pavement markings, guardrail and wrong-way driving vehicle detection technology. Construction will continue through mid-2030. Approximate cost: \$195 million.

POLK PARKWAY/S.R. 570 RESURFACING AND ROADSIDE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM WEST OF LAKELAND HIGHLANDS ROAD TO SOUTH OF U.S. 92

Eastbound and westbound Polk Parkway/S.R. 570 between east of Lakeland Highlands Road (Exit 9) and west of Lakeland/Auburndale/U.S. 92 (Exit 17)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, May 31, and nightly through Friday, June 5.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Polk Parkway/S.R. 570 is being resurfaced from west of Lakeland Highlands Road (milepost 8) to south of U.S. 92 (milepost 17) in Polk County. Work includes paving Polk Parkway, the U.S. 98 ramps, Lakeland Highlands Road, and Winter Lake Road. This project also includes installing new guardrails, rumble strips, highly reflective signs and pavement markings and upgrading existing drainage. Construction will continue through mid-2026. Approximate cost: \$20 million.

CENTRAL POLK PARKWAY/S.R. 570B PROJECT FROM POLK PARKWAY/S.R. 570 TO U.S. 17/S.R. 35

Westbound Polk Parkway/S.R. 570 exit ramp to Winter Lake Road/S.R. 540 (Exit 14)

Overnight full ramp closure, 9 p.m. Tuesday June 2, to 6 a.m. Wednesday June 3.

Detour information:

- Westbound Polk Parkway/S.R. 570 traffic wishing to access Winter Lake Road/S.R. 540 (Exit 14) will be directed to exit at U.S. 92 (Exit 17), travel east on U.S. 92 to Recker Highway/C.R. 655, travel south and east on Recker Highway to Spirit Lake Road, and travel south on Spirit Lake Road to access Winter Lake Road.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Central Polk Parkway/S.R. 570B, a new, four-lane (two lanes in each direction), tolled roadway is being constructed in Polk County. This new stretch of roadway will begin at Polk Parkway/S.R. 570 and Winter Lake Road/S.R. 540 and extend approximately 6.5 miles to U.S. 17/S.R. 35. Construction will continue through 2029. Approximate cost: \$257 million.

FIRST COAST EXPRESSWAY/S.R. 23 SAFETY ENHANCEMENTS PROJECT
FROM BLANDING BOULEVARD/S.R. 21 TO INTERSTATE 10 (I-10)

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: First Coast Expressway/S.R. 23 is undergoing enhancements between Blanding Boulevard/S.R. 21 (milepost 31) and I-10 (milepost 46) in Clay and Duval counties. Work consists of installing new wrong-way driving countermeasures, guardrail, and intelligent transportation system components. This project also includes enhancing traffic monitoring by updating infrastructure for CCTV connectivity and backup generator power. Construction will continue through late 2026. Approximate cost: \$8.2 million.
