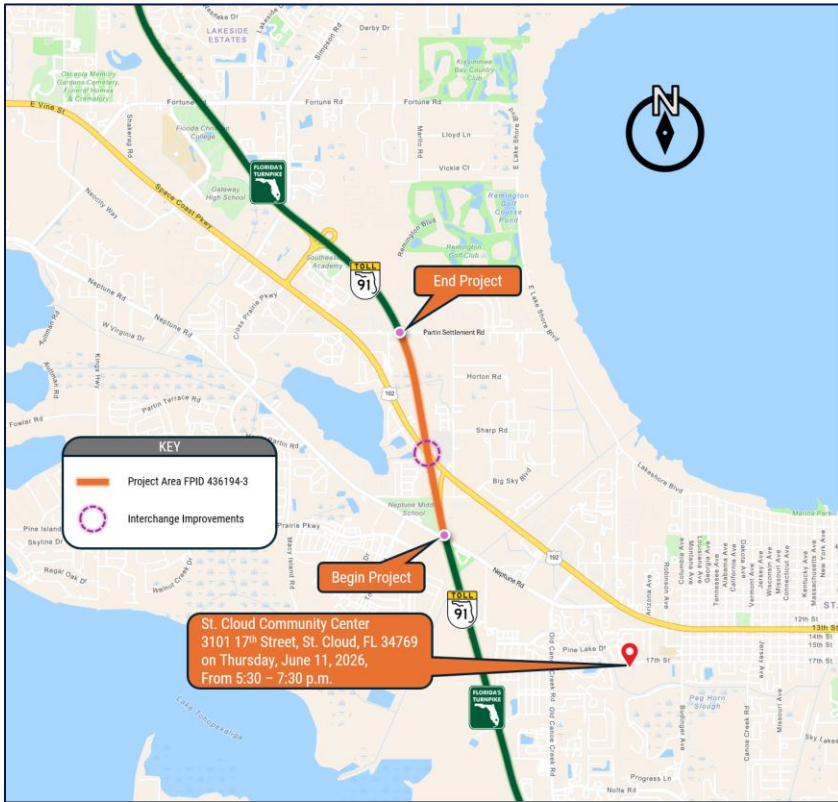

PROJECT OVERVIEW

The Florida's Turnpike Enterprise, part of the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), is planning to widen Florida's Turnpike (SR 91) from US 192 (Milepost 242) to Partin Settlement Road (Milepost 243.5) from four to eight lanes.

This project is in Design, which is the third phase of the typical FDOT project development process. During this phase, construction plans, specifications, and final estimates to build a project are developed.

The project is part of the Turnpike Widening Infrastructure Initiative that will provide additional capacity to meet future traffic demand, improve emergency evacuation times, and improve safety within the corridor.



KEY IMPROVEMENTS

- Widen Florida's Turnpike from four to eight lanes
- Provides interchange and intersection capacity improvements at US 192
- Enhance access for emergency responders and during hurricane evacuations
- Other improvements include signing and pavement markings, ITS, lighting, signalization, and noise walls.
