# Suncoast Parkway/State Road 589 Resurfacing and Safety Improvements Project

from State Road 54 to State Road 52

---

## Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise (Enterprise) is resurfacing Suncoast Parkway/State Road (S.R.) 589 from south of S.R. 54 (milepost 17.5) to north of S.R. 52 (milepost 28.5) in Pasco County. This project is designed to extend roadway life, enhance safety, and improve roadside conditions.

## Project Benefits

- **Improved Rideability:** Resurfacing travel lanes and shoulders to provide a smoother and more consistent driving experience.
- **Increased Durability:** Extending the life of bridges by installing new joints to the northbound and southbound bridges over Ridge Road.
- **Enhance Safety:** Installing new signage, fresh pavement markings, and upgrading drainage.

## Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction activities will occur during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience occasional impacts from construction-related light, noise, vibration, or dust. The Enterprise is committed to minimizing these disruptions and taking steps to limit traffic delays and noise.

Lane closures will generally take place during off-peak hours to reduce impacts to drivers. Information about closures will be provided in advance through the Central and West Central Florida Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.

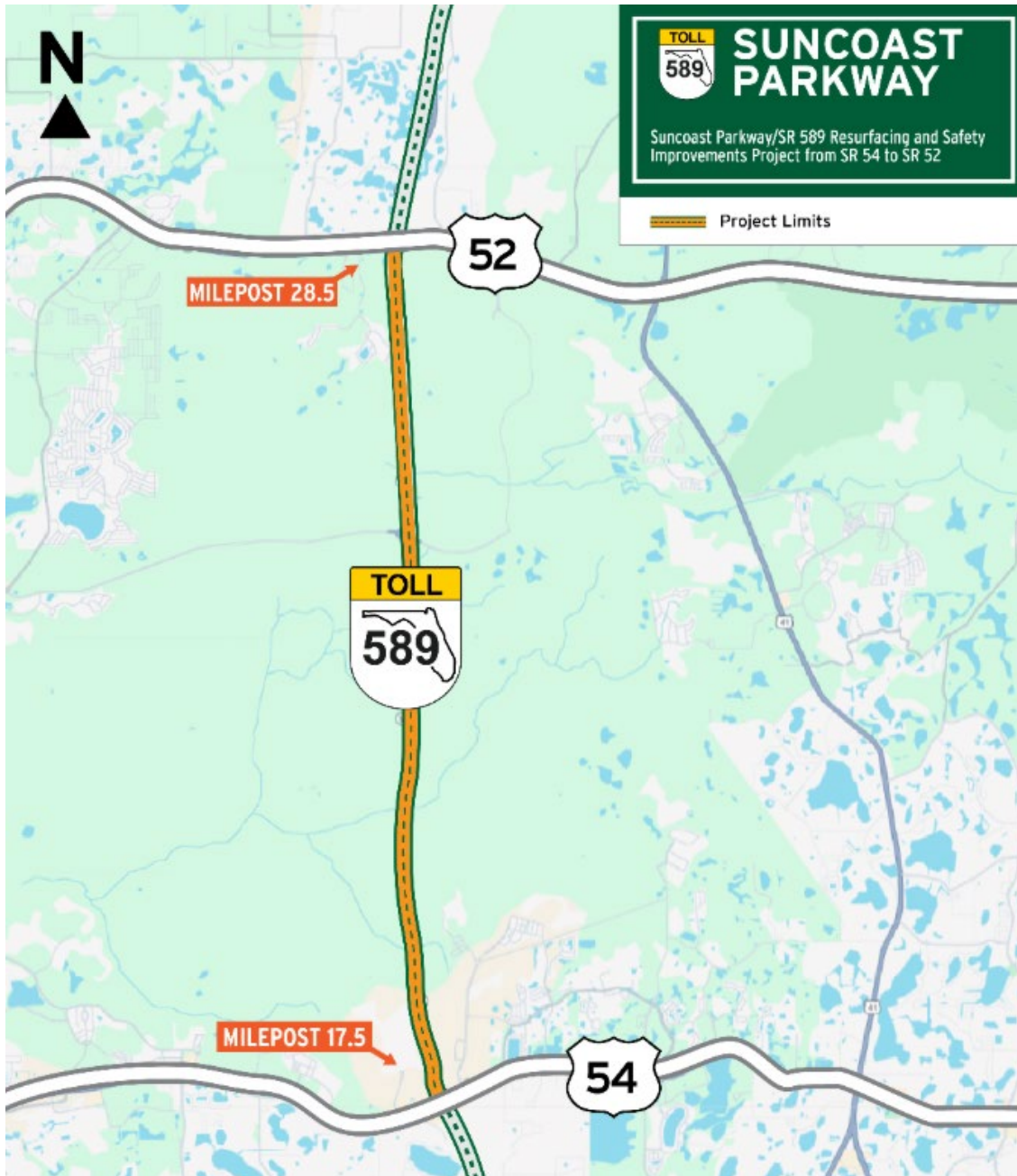
