



Polk Parkway/State Road 570 Resurfacing and Roadside Improvements Project

from west of Lakeland Highlands Road to south of U.S. 92

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise (Enterprise) is resurfacing Polk Parkway/State Road (S.R. 570) from west of Lakeland Highlands Road (milepost 8) to south of U.S. 92 (milepost 17) in Polk County.

This project is designed to extend the life of the roadway, enhance safety, and improve roadside conditions.

Project Benefits

- Extending roadway life and durability with new pavement, including all ramps to and from U.S. 98, Lakeland Highlands Road, and Winter Lake Road/S.R. 540
- Enhancing roadside safety with the installation of new guardrail and rumble strips.
- Improving drainage by upgrading existing drainage pipes.
- Increasing visibility with new highly reflective signs and pavement markings.

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction will take place during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience periodic construction noise, vibration, and dust. The Enterprise takes steps to reduce construction impacts and efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions.

Lane closures will generally take place during off-peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers. Closures and detours will be announced in advance in the Central and West Central Florida Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.

Schedule and Funding

Work is anticipated to continue through 2026.

Project Cost:

The project cost is approximately \$20 million.

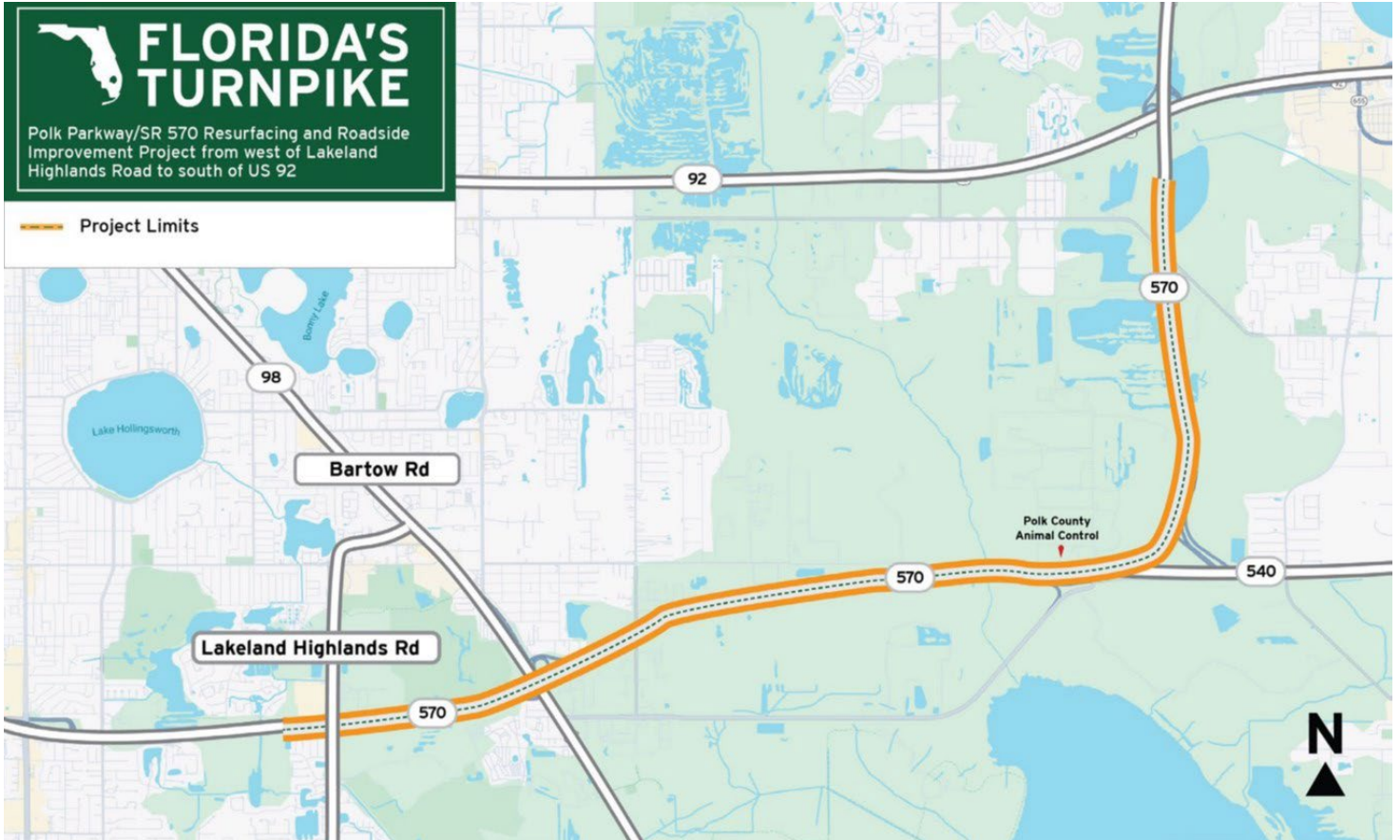
