



Construction Alert

Noise Wall Construction Along Northbound Florida's Turnpike From North of Sawgrass Expressway to Glades Road in Broward and Palm Beach Counties

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is scheduled to start construction of a 22-foot-tall noise wall Monday, February 2, along Florida's Turnpike/State Road (S.R.) 91, between north of Sawgrass Expressway/S.R. 869 (milepost 71) and Glades Road.

As part of the construction of the 22-foot-tall noise wall, the existing chain-link fence located behind residential properties along the Enterprise right-of-way will be removed by construction crews.

The fence removal is expected to take approximately four weeks to complete. Once the fence removal is complete, noise wall panel installation will begin. Removal of vegetation within the Enterprise's right-of-way will prepare the area for the noise wall installation and allow access for construction equipment.

Residents are asked to secure all pets and animals during this period.

This work is part of the Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 Transportation Systems Management & Operations Project to add lanes from south of Sawgrass Expressway/S.R. 869 to north of Glades Road/S.R. 808 in Broward and Palm Beach counties.

You may experience increased noise and trucks hauling material during these periods. Our project team will monitor these activities to minimize impacts to residents and businesses.

Please note that this schedule may change due to inclement weather or unforeseen conditions.
