



Florida's Turnpike Transportation Systems Management & Operations Project

at Ocoee/State Road 50 Exit Ramp

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise (Enterprise) is advancing a Transportation System Management and Operations (TSM&O) project at the Florida's Turnpike/State Road (S.R.) 91 exit ramp to Ocoee/S.R. 50 (Exit 267B), in Orange County. The project is designed to improve traffic flow, enhance safety, and strengthen regional mobility for drivers, residents, and businesses.

Project Benefits

- **Improved Traffic Flow:** Adding a new outside turn lane on eastbound S.R. 50 to provide better access to and from Marshall Farms Road and help reduce congestion where the Florida's Turnpike exit ramp merges onto S.R. 50.
- **Increased Durability:** Upgrading entrance and exit ramps on eastbound S.R. 50 to support the new turn lane, increasing roadway dependability and extending its service life.
- **Enhanced Safety:** Installing a new traffic signal to reduce conflict points for vehicles exiting Florida's Turnpike onto eastbound S.R. 50.

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction will take place during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience periodic construction light, noise, and dust throughout the project's duration. The Enterprise takes steps to reduce construction impacts and efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions.

Lane closures will generally take place during off-peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers. Closures and detours will be announced in advance in the Central and West Central Florida Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.

Schedule and Funding

Work is anticipated to be completed by late 2026.

Project Cost:

The project cost is approximately \$6 million.

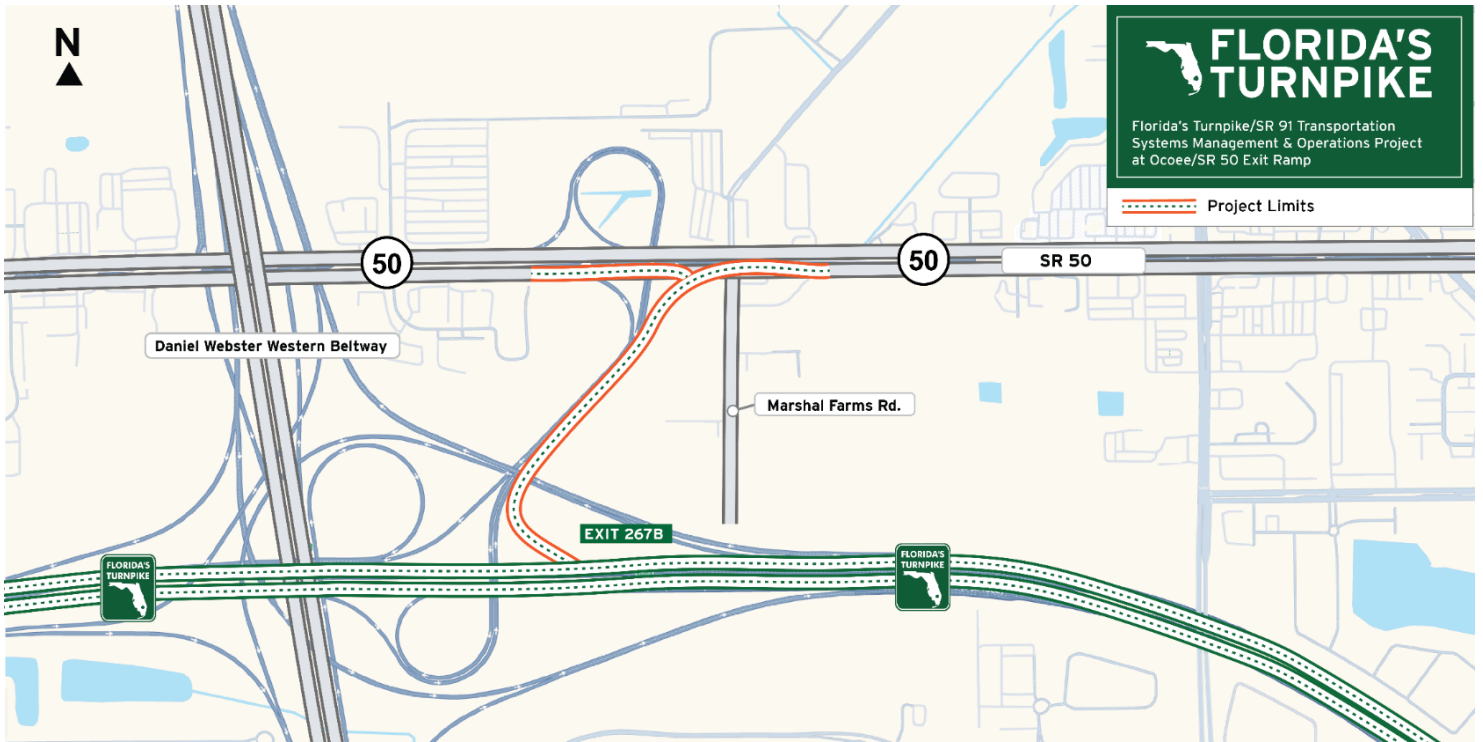
