



Transportation Systems Management & Operations Project

Daniel Webster Western Beltway/State Road 429 and U.S. 192 Interchange

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise (Enterprise) is advancing a Transportation Systems Management and Operations (TSM&O) project designed to enhance the Daniel Webster Western Beltway/State Road (S.R.) 429 and U.S. 192 interchange in Orange County. The project focuses on improving traffic flow, increasing safety, and supporting regional mobility for drivers, residents, and businesses.

Project Benefits

- **Increased Capacity:** Adding a new lane and extending the existing southbound SR 429 exit ramp to US 192 to help ease congestion.
- **Improved Mobility:** Enhancing traffic movement by constructing three right-turn lanes and two left-turn lanes at the intersection where the southbound SR 429 exit ramp meets US 192.
- **Enhanced Safety:** Installing new roadway lighting, updated signage, fresh pavement markings, and intelligent transportation system components to promote safer and more efficient travel.

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction activities will occur during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience occasional impacts from construction-related light, noise, vibration, or dust. The Enterprise is committed to minimizing these disruptions and takes steps to limit traffic delays and noise.

Lane closures will generally take place during off-peak hours to reduce impacts to drivers. Information about closures will be provided in advance through the Central and West Central Florida Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.

Schedule and Funding

The project cost is approximately \$14.5 million.

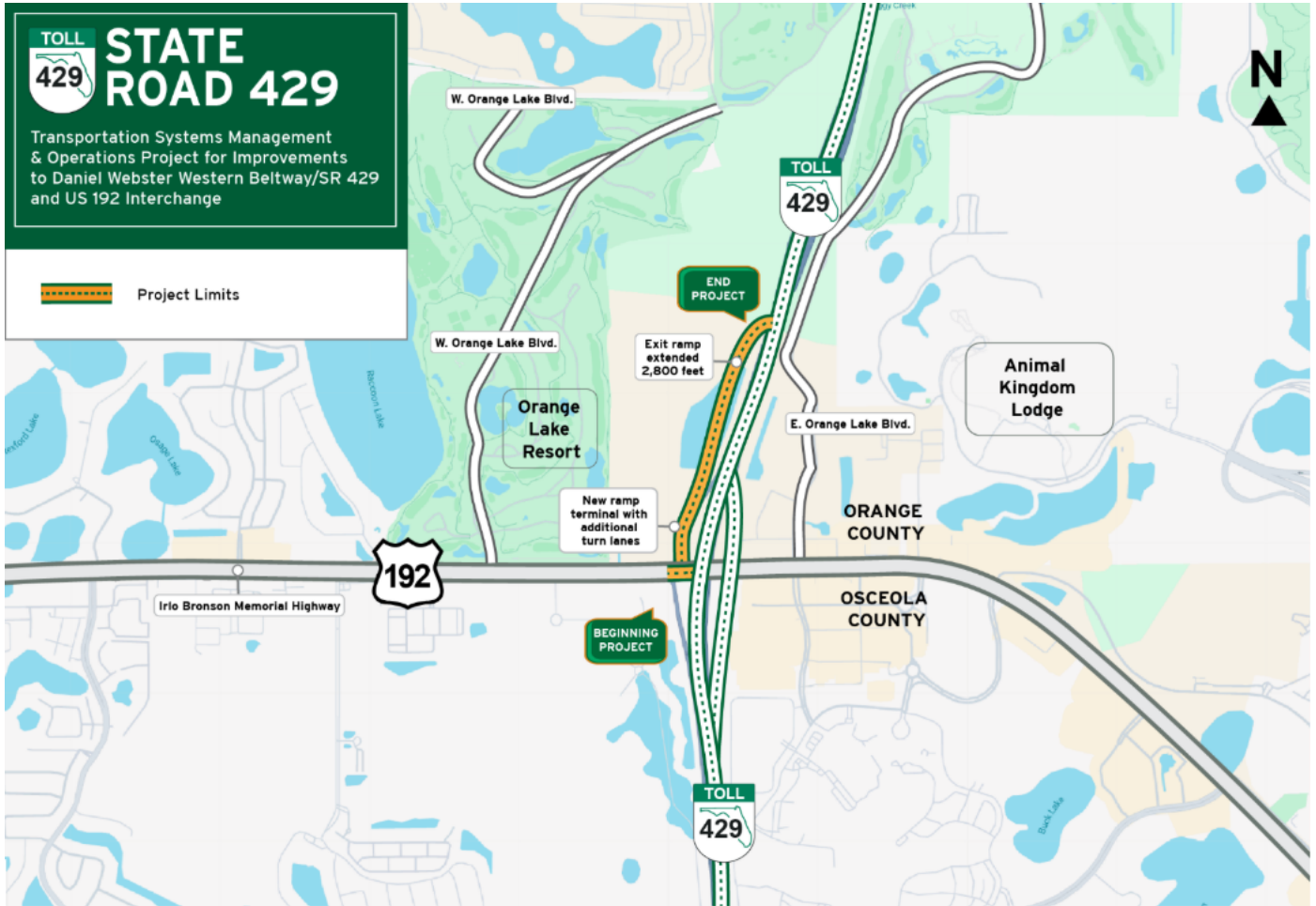
