TRAVEL ADVISORY: ADDITIONAL ROAD CLOSURES IN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY DUE TO WILDFIRE ACTIVITY

Miami-Dade, FL - Due to wildfire activity in Miami-Dade County, all northbound and southbound lanes of S.R. 977/Krome Avenue/SW 177 Avenue between U.S. 41/S.R. 90/Tamiami Trail and U.S. 27/SR 25/Okeechobee Road remain closed.

In addition, to support wildfire response operations, all southbound lanes of Florida's Turnpike between NW 41 Street/Doral Boulevard and U.S. 27/S.R. 25/Okeechobee Road are closed.

Traffic is being rerouted based on the fire perimeter, smoke plume direction, and real-time visibility conditions.

Travelers are urged to use the following detour routes or find an alternate route.

S.R. 977/Krome Avenue/SW 177 Avenue between U.S. 41/S.R. 90/Tamiami Trail and U.S. 27/S.R. 25/Okeechobee Road Detours:

Northbound:

- Head east along U.S. 41/S.R. 90/Tamiami Trail to SW 107 Avenue
- Head north on SW 107 Avenue to Beacon Station Boulevard/NW 106 Street
- Head east on Beacon Station Boulevard/SW 106 Street to U.S. 27/S.R. 25/Okeechobee Road
- Head north on U.S. 27/S.R. 25/Okeechobee Road to S.R. 977/Krome Avenue

Southbound:

- Head south on U.S. 27/S.R. 25/Okeechobee Road to Beacon Station Boulevard/NW 106 Street
- Head west on Beacon Station Boulevard to SW 107 Avenue
- Head south on SW 107 Avenue to U.S. 41/S.R. 90/Tamiami Trail to SW 107 Avenue
- Head west on U.S. 41/S.R. 90/Tamiami Trail to SW 107 to Krome Avenue

Florida's Turnpike between NW 41 Street/Doral Boulevard (Exit 29) and U.S. 27/S.R. 25/Okeechobee Road (Exit 35)

Southbound:

- Exit at U.S. 27/S.R. 25/Okeechobee Road South (Exit 35)
- Head south along U.S. 27/S.R. 25/Okeechobee Road to S.R. 826/Palmetto Expressway
- Head south on S.R. 826/Palmetto Expressway to NW 41 Street/NW 36 Street/Doral Boulevard
- Exit west on NW 41 Street/ NW 36 Street/Doral Boulevard to Florida's Turnpike South

Motorists traveling through the area should expect an increased Florida Highway Patrol presence, particularly along northbound Florida's Turnpike.

Motorists are urged to exercise caution, remain alert for emergency vehicles and personnel, reduce speed as conditions warrant, and follow all directions from law enforcement and posted traffic control devices.

Motorists are encouraged to plan ahead, allow extra travel time, consider alternate routes, when possible, ensure their vehicles have adequate fuel, and stay alert for changing traffic conditions and visibility.

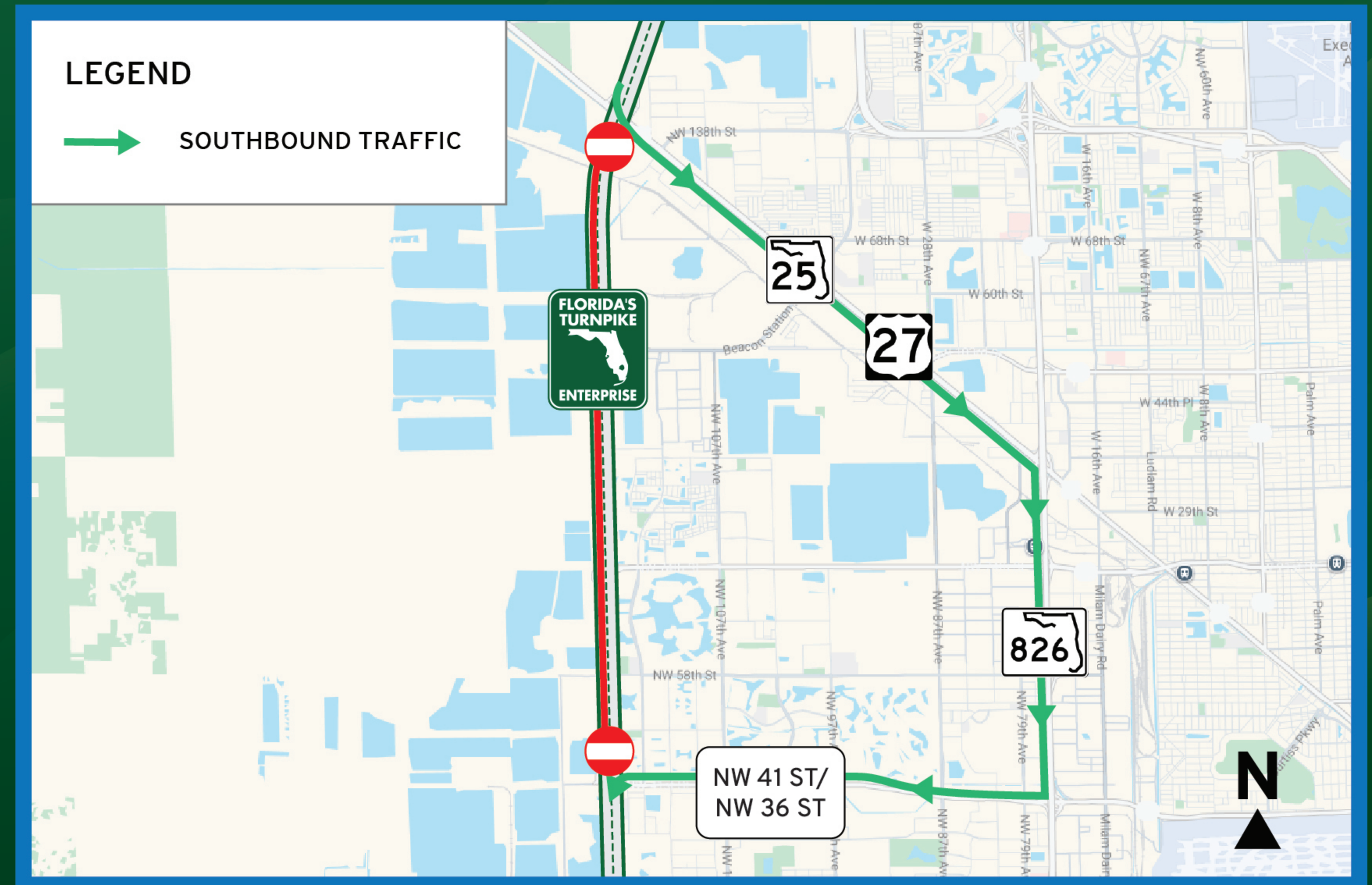

Southbound Florida's Turnpike Closes in Miami-Dade County- Use FDOT Detours
Travelers are urged to use the following detour routes or find an alternate route.

Southbound:

- Exit at U.S. 27/S.R. 25/Okeechobee Road South (Exit 35)
- Head south along U.S. 27/S.R. 25/Okeechobee Road to S.R. 826/Palmetto Expressway
- Head southbound on S.R. 826/Palmetto Expressway to NW 41 Street/NW 36 Street/Doral Boulevard
- Exit west on NW 41 Street/ NW 36 Street/Doral Boulevard to S.R. 821/Florida's Turnpike South
