CENTRAL TURNPIKE MAINLINE/STATE ROAD (S.R.) 91 (Mileposts 188 to 240) **OSCEOLA COUNTY**

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/S.R. 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM CLAY WHALEY ROAD TO U.S. 192 AND W. NOLTE ROAD INTERCHANGE

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 between Clay Whaley Road and U.S. 192 (Milepost 239 to Milepost 242)

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, July 19, and nightly through Wednesday, July 22.

Daytime intermittent shoulder closures, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday, July 20, and daily through Friday, July 24.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 is being widened from two to four lanes in each direction, from Clay Whaley Road (formerly Kissimmee Park Road) to U.S. 192 in Osceola County. This project includes constructing a new interchange at W. Nolte Road and removing the existing ramps at Clay Whaley Road once the new interchange is open to traffic. Construction will continue through early 2029. Approximate cost: \$193 million.

**FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/S.R. 91 AND SAND LAKE ROAD/S.R. 482
INTERCHANGE DEVELOPMENT PROJECT**

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 between Beachline Expressway/S.R. 528 and Interstate 4 (I-4) (Milepost 255 to Milepost 258)

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, July 19, and nightly through Thursday, July 23.

Daytime shoulder closures, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday, July 20, and daily through Friday, July 24.

Eastbound and westbound Sand Lake Road/S.R. 482 between John Young Parkway/S.R. 423 and Chancellor Drive

Long-term single lane closures through late 2027.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: A new interchange is being constructed at Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 and Sand Lake Road/S.R. 482 in Orange County to enhance connectivity. This project also includes increasing roadway longevity and resiliency with the reconstruction of the Sand Lake Road bridge to accommodate new ramps, improving traffic flow by enhancing the intersection of Presidents Drive and Sand Lake Road, and providing sidewalks from John Young Parkway to Presidents Drive. Construction will continue through late 2027. Approximate cost: \$114.6 million.

FROM PARTIN SETTLEMENT ROAD TO OSCEOLA PARKWAY**

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 between Kissimmee/St. Cloud/U.S. 192/U.S. 441 (Exit 242) and Osceola Parkway (Exit 249)

Overnight single lane closures, 7:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m., Sunday, July 19, and nightly through Tuesday July 21.

Nighttime single lane closures, 7:30 p.m. to 11:59 p.m., Wednesday, July 22.

Overnight single lane closures, 7:30 p.m. Thursday, July 23, to 5:30 a.m., Friday, July 24.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 between Osceola Parkway (Exit 249) and Kissimmee/St. Cloud/U.S. 192/U.S. 441 (Exit 242)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, July 19, and nightly through Thursday July 23.

Daytime shoulder closures, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday, July 20, and daily through Friday, July 24.

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 between U.S. 192/U.S. 441/Kissimmee/St. Cloud (Exit 242) and Osceola Parkway (Exit 249)

Overnight full road closure, 11:59 p.m. Wednesday, July 22, to 5 a.m. Thursday, July 23.

Detour information:

- Northbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 traffic wishing to continue north will be directed to exit at U.S. 192/U.S. 441/Kissimmee/St. Cloud (Exit 242), travel west on U.S. 192 to Main Street/Orange Blossom Trail/S.R. 441, travel north on Main Street/Orange Blossom Trail/S.R. 441 to Osceola Parkway, and travel east on Osceola Parkway to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.
- U.S. 192 traffic wishing to access northbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 from Cross Prairie Parkway will be directed west on U.S. 192 to Main Street/Orange Blossom Trail/S.R. 441, travel

north on Main Street/Orange Blossom Trail/S.R. 441 to Osceola Parkway, and travel east on Osceola Parkway to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 is being widened from two to four lanes, in each direction, from Partin Settlement Road to Osceola Parkway in Osceola County. As part of this project, interchange improvements are planned at Osceola Parkway (milepost 249), as well as bridge improvements and replacements throughout the project limits. This project also includes installing new roadway lighting, updated signage, fresh pavement markings, and guard rail to promote safer and more efficient travel. Construction will continue through early 2031. Approximate cost: \$345 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/S.R. 91 TRANSPORTATION SYSTEMS MANAGEMENT & OPERATIONS (TSM&O) PROJECT AT OCOEE/S.R. 50 EXIT RAMP (EXIT 267B)

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 exit ramp to S.R 50/Ocoee (Exit 267B)

Overnight full ramp closures, 10 p.m. Sunday, July 19, to 6 a.m. Monday, July 20.

Detour information:

- Northbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 traffic wishing to access eastbound S.R. 50 will be directed to exit at Spessard L. Holland East-West Expressway/S.R. 408/East/Orlando/Titusville (Exit 265), travel east on Spessard L. Holland East-West Expressway/S.R. 408 to Good Homes Road, and travel north of Good Homes Road to Access S.R. 50.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Enhancements are being made at the Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 exit ramp to Ocoee/S.R. 50 (Exit 267B) in Orange County. This project will increase roadway capacity and improve traffic flow by adding an outside lane on eastbound S.R. 50, improve resilience by upgrading the entrance and exit ramps on eastbound S.R. 50 to support the new lane, and enhance safety by installing a new traffic signal to reduce conflict points for vehicles exiting Florida's Turnpike onto eastbound S.R. 50. Construction will continue through early 2027. Approximate cost: \$6 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/S.R. 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM MINNEOLA/HANCOCK ROAD TO O'BRIEN ROAD

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 between Minneola/Hancock Road and north of O'Brien Road (Milepost 279 to Milepost 286)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, July 19, and nightly through Thursday, July 23.

Daytime intermittent shoulder closures, 10 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, July 20 and daily through Friday, July 24.

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 exit ramp to U.S. 27/S.R. 19/Leesburg/Tavares (Exit 285)

Overnight full ramp closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, July 19, and nightly through Thursday, July 23.

Detour information:

- Northbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 traffic wishing to access U.S. 27/S.R. 19/Leesburg/Tavares (Exit 285) will be directed to exit at Minneola/Hancock Road (Exit 278), travel south on N. Hancock Road to Old Highway 50, and travel west on Old Highway 50 to access U.S. 27

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 is being widened from four to eight lanes from Minneola/Hancock Road to north of O'Brien Road in Lake County. This project includes replacing the bridges at Scrub Jay Lane, C.R. 561, U.S. 19, and U.S. 27/S.R. 19 South. New electronic tolling gantries and buildings will be installed, as well as new stormwater treatment facilities. Safety improvements for this project include new signage, pavement markings, signalization, and lighting. Construction will continue through late 2028. Approximate cost: \$233 million.

**SEMINOLE EXPRESSWAY/S.R. 417 WIDENING PROJECT
FROM ALOMA AVENUE/S.R. 426 TO S.R. 434**

Northbound and southbound Seminole Expressway/S.R. 417 between south of Aloma Avenue/S.R. 426 and north of S.R. 434 (Milepost 38 to Milepost 44)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, July 19, and nightly through Thursday, July 23.

Daytime shoulder closures, 10 a.m. to 3 p.m., Monday, July 20, and daily through Friday, July 24.

Eastbound and westbound Aloma Avenue, Red Bug Lake Road, Winter Springs Boulevard and S.R. 434 under Seminole Expressway/S.R. 417

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 7 a.m., Sunday, July 19 and nightly through Thursday, July 23.

Southbound Seminole Expressway/S.R. 417 exit ramp to Aloma Avenue/S.R. 426 (Exit 38)

Overnight full ramp closures, 11:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, July 19, and nightly through Thursday, July 23.

Detour information:

- Southbound Seminole Expressway/S.R. 417 traffic wishing to access Aloma Avenue/S.R. 426 (Exit 38) will be directed to exit at Red Bug Lake Road (Exit 44), and travel east on Red Bug Lake Road to access southbound S.R. 426.

Southbound Seminole Expressway/S.R. 417 entrance ramp from Red Bug Lake Road

Overnight full ramp closures, 11:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, July 19, and nightly through Thursday, July 23.

Detour information:

- Red Bug Lake Road traffic wishing to access southbound Seminole Expressway/S.R. 417 will be directed to Aloma Avenue/S.R. 426, and travel west on Aloma Avenue to access southbound Seminole Expressway.

Westbound Seminole Expressway/SR 417 entrance ramp from Red Bug Lake Road

Overnight full ramp closures, 11:30 p.m. to 5 a.m., Sunday, July 19, and nightly through Thursday, July 23.

Detour Information:

- Red Bug Lake Road traffic wishing to access southbound Seminole Expressway/SR 417 will be directed to Aloma Avenue/SR 426, and travel west on Aloma Avenue to access southbound Seminole Expressway.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Seminole Expressway/S.R. 417 is being widened from four to eight lanes between Aloma Avenue/S.R. 426 and north of S.R. 434 in Seminole County. This project includes adding two lanes in each direction of Seminole Expressway, replacing five bridges, and widening 12 existing bridges. Work also consists of installing new underdeck lighting, highly reflective signage, and pavement markings. Construction will continue through late 2030. Approximate cost: \$300 million.

**SEMINOLE EXPRESSWAY/S.R. 417 RESURFACING AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT
FROM AIRPORT BOULEVARD TO TOWNE CENTER BOULEVARD**

Northbound and southbound Seminole Expressway/S.R. 417 between Airport Boulevard and Rinehart Road (Milepost 49 to Milepost 56)

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, July 19, and nightly through Thursday, July 23.

Daytime shoulder closures, 7 a.m. to 5 p.m., Monday, July 20, and nightly through Friday, July 24.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Seminole Expressway/S.R. 417 is being resurfaced from south of Airport Boulevard (milepost 49) to north of Towne Center Boulevard (milepost 55) in Seminole County. Work will include paving Seminole Expressway and the ramps at Rinehart Road, W. 25th Street/H.E. Thomas Jr. Parkway, and Airport Boulevard. This project also includes enhancing the bridge deck expansion joints, installing new guardrails, signs and wrong-way vehicle detection system, and upgrading existing drainage. Construction will continue through late 2026. Approximate cost: \$17.4 million.

**HEMPEL AVENUE BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT
OVER SPESSARD L. HOLLAND EAST-WEST EXPRESSWAY/S.R. 408**

Eastbound Spessard L. Holland East-West Expressway/S.R. 408 between Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 and Spessard L. Holland East-West Expressway/S.R. 408 entrance from S.R. 50/West Colonial Drive and Clarke Road

Overnight single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, July 19, to 6 a.m. Monday, July 20; and 10 p.m. Monday, July 20, to 6 a.m. Tuesday, July 21.

Westbound Spessard L. Holland East-West Expressway/S.R. 408 between S.R. 50/West Colonial Drive (Exit 1) and Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91

Overnight full road closure, 10 p.m. Sunday, July 19, to 6 a.m. Monday, July 20.

Detour information:

- Westbound S.R. 408 traffic wishing to access Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 will be directed to exit at S.R. 50 West Colonial Drive (Exit 1), and travel west on S.R. 50/West Colonial Drive to access Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91.
- Northbound Good Homes Road traffic wishing to access westbound S.R. 408 will be directed to continue north on Good Homes Road, and travel west on S.R. 50/West Colonial Drive to access Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91.

Eastbound Spessard L. Holland East-West Expressway/S.R. 408 between Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 and Spessard L. Holland East-West Expressway/S.R. 408 entrance from S.R. 50/West Colonial Drive and Clarke Road

Detour information:

- Northbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 traffic wishing to access eastbound Spessard L. Holland East-West Expressway/S.R. 408 (Exit 265) will be directed to exit at S.R. 50/Ocoee (Exit 267B), travel east on S.R. 50/West Colonial Drive to Clarke Road, and travel south on the S.R. 50/West Colonial Drive and Clarke Road entrance ramp to access eastbound S.R. 408.
- Southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 traffic wishing to access State Road 408 eastbound will be directed to exit at S.R. 50/Ocoee (Exit 276B), travel eastbound on S.R. 50/West Colonial Drive, and travel south on the S.R. 50/West Colonial Drive and Clarke Road entrance ramp to access eastbound S.R. 408.
- Northbound Daniel Webster Western Beltway/S.R. 429 traffic wishing to access eastbound Spessard L. Holland East-West Expressway/S.R. 408 via Florida's Turnpike will be directed to exit at S.R. 50/West Colonial Drive (Exit 23), travel eastbound on S.R. 50/West Colonial Drive, and

travel south on the S.R. 50/West Colonial Drive and Clarke Road entrance ramp to access eastbound S.R. 408.

- Southbound Daniel Webster Western Beltway/S.R. 429 traffic wishing to access eastbound Spessard L. Holland East-West Expressway/S.R. 408 via Florida's Turnpike will be directed to exit at S.R. 50/West Colonial Drive (Exit 23), travel eastbound on S.R. 50/West Colonial Drive, and travel south on the S.R. 50/West Colonial Drive and Clarke Road entrance ramp to access eastbound S.R. 408.

Hempel Avenue Bridge over Spessard L. Holland East-West Expressway/S.R. 408

Overnight full road closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., Sunday, July 19, and nightly through Thursday, July 23.

Detour information:

- Northbound Hempel Avenue traffic wishing to continue north will be directed to travel east on Morton Jones Road to Woodlawn Cemetery Road, travel north on Woodlawn Cemetery Road to Old Winter Garden Road, and travel west on Old Winter Garden Road to access Hempel Avenue.
- Southbound Hempel Avenue traffic wishing to continue south will be directed to travel east on Old Winter Garden Road to Woodlawn Cemetery Road, travel south on Woodlawn Cemetery Road to Morton Jones Road, and travel west on Morton Jones Road to access Hempel Avenue.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Hempel Avenue bridge over Spessard L. Holland East-West Expressway/S.R. 408 is being replaced in Orange County. The bridge will be made longer and raised to accommodate the future widening of S.R. 408 to four lanes in each direction. This project also includes adding a sidewalk in each direction across the bridge, enhancing pedestrian access and safety for the community. Construction will continue through early 2027. Approximate cost: \$23 million.

DANIEL WEBSTER WESTERN BELTWAY/S.R. 429 TRANSPORTATION SYSTEMS MANAGEMENT AND OPERATIONS PROJECT AT U.S. 192 INTERCHANGE

No lane closures scheduled.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The Daniel Webster Western Beltway/S.R. 429 and U.S. 192 interchange is undergoing significant enhancements to increase capacity, improve mobility, and enhance safety in Orange County. As part of these improvements, we are adding a new lane and extending the existing southbound S.R. 429 exit ramp to U.S. 192. At the intersection of the southbound S.R. 429 exit ramp and U.S. 192, three right-turn lanes and two left-turn lanes will also be constructed. This project also includes installing new signage, pavement markings, and lighting. Construction will continue through late 2026. Approximate cost: \$14.5 million.

VETERANS EXPRESSWAY/SUNCOAST PARKWAY & POLK PARKWAY HILLSBOROUGH, PASCO, HERNANDO, CITRUS and POLK COUNTIES

SUNCOAST PARKWAY/S.R. 589 RESURFACING AND SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM S.R. 54 TO S.R. 52

Southbound Suncoast Parkway/S.R. 589 between Milepost 22.5 and Milepost 24.5

Overnight single lane closures, 7:30 p.m. to 5:30 a.m. Sunday, July 19, and nightly through Tuesday, July 21.

Safety improvements for this project include new signage, pavement markings, and replacing the bridge joints over Ridge Road. Construction will continue through early 2027. Approximate cost: \$23 million.

IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT FROM
MILEPOST 14.3 TO MILEPOST 17.5**

Southbound Suncoast Parkway/S.R. 589 exit ramp to Lutz Lake Fern Road/C.R. 582 (Exit 16)

Work will include paving and resurfacing the existing northbound and southbound travel lanes, shoulders, and interchange ramps. This project also includes new guardrails, sign improvements, and upgrading existing drainage. Construction will continue through summer 2027. Approximate cost: \$6.6 million.

**SUNCOAST PARKWAY/S.R. 589 EXTENSION PROJECT
FROM W. NORVELL HIGHWAY/C.R. 486 TO C.R. 495**

Northbound N. Citrus Avenue/C.R. 495 between W. Far Hills Lane and W. Emerald Oaks Drive

Daytime intermittent single lane closures, 9 a.m. to 4 p.m., Monday, July 20, and daily through Friday, July 24.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Suncoast Parkway/S.R. 589 is being extended 5.5 miles from W. Norvell Bryant Highway/C.R. 486 to C.R. 495. This new four-lane tolled roadway (two lanes in each direction) will complete the interchange at C.R. 486, add a partial interchange at C.R. 495 and widen and realign C.R. 495.
