Construction Activities Begin Along Old Canoe Creek Road in Osceola County

Construction activities begin on Monday, March 23, 2026, along Old Canoe Creek Road in Osceola County.

Crews will begin clearing vegetation and removing trees within Florida's Turnpike right of way adjacent to the Woodland Terrace Apartments. Work will take place Monday through Friday between the hours of 7 a.m. and 6 p.m. While work is taking place, residents may experience periodic increases in noise, dust, and construction activity. The project team will monitor construction operations and take steps to minimize impacts to nearby communities whenever possible.

During these operations, Old Canoe Creek Road will remain open. Traffic control devices and signs will be installed to mark necessary closures and work zones. Please follow all posted signage and ensure all pets/animals are secured for the duration of construction activities in the area.

This work is part of the Florida's Turnpike/State Road (S.R.) 91 Widening Project from Clay Whaley Road to U.S. 192 & Nolte Road Interchange Development. For more information about this project, please visit:
