



Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 Widening Project

from West Palm Beach Service Plaza to North of Southern Boulevard

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise (Enterprise) is widening Florida's Turnpike/State Road (S.R.) 91 from the West Palm Beach Service Plaza (milepost 94) to north of Southern Boulevard/U.S. 98/S.R. 80 (Exit 98) in Palm Beach County.

Project Benefits

- **Improved Traffic Flow:** Adding two lanes in each direction from the West Palm Beach Service Plaza (milepost 94) to north of Southern Boulevard/U.S. 98/S.R. 80 (Exit 98).
- **Increased Connectivity:** Reconstructing the Turnpike interchanges at Southern Boulevard/S.R. 80.
- **Strengthened Durability:** Reconstructing the bridges at Forest Hill Boulevard/S.R. 882 and Belvedere Road.
- **Enhanced Safety:** Installing new highly reflective signing and pavement markings which will increase visibility in all lighting and weather conditions.

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction will take place during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience periodic construction light, noise, and dust throughout the project's duration. The Enterprise takes steps to reduce construction impacts and efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions.

Lane closures will generally take place during off-peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers. Closures and detours will be announced in advance in the South Florida and Treasure Coast Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.

Schedule and Funding

Construction Schedule:

Work is anticipated to continue through early 2030.

Project Cost:

The project cost is approximately \$258 million.

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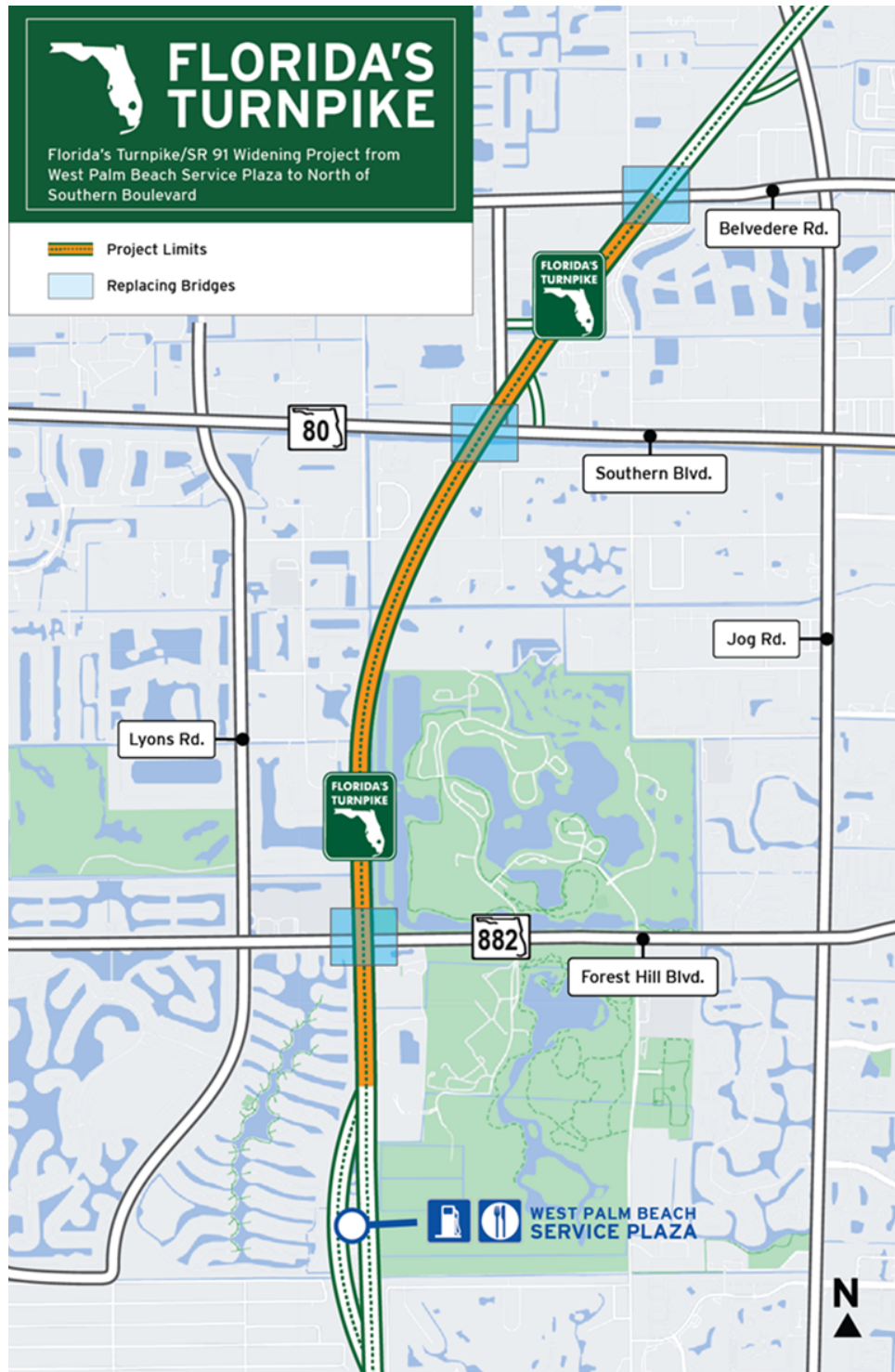
