

Florida's Turnpike Bridge Improvements Project

at Milepost 138

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is replacing the existing Florida's Turnpike bridge at milepost 138 in Martin County. These enhancements are part of the Enterprise's ongoing commitment to maintaining safe, dependable infrastructure throughout the state.

Project Benefits

- **Improved Travel Experience:** Reconstructing the bridge and roadway surface will provide a smoother ride for drivers, improving overall travel comfort.
- **Enhanced Safety:** Installing upgraded roadway lighting, new signage, fresh pavement markings, and new guardrail designed to enhance visibility and improve efficient travel.
- **Support Future Transportation Needs:** The new bridge is designed to accommodate future widening of Florida's Turnpike, helping ensure the corridor can continue to serve traffic demands.

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction activities will occur during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience occasional impacts from construction-related light, noise, vibration, or dust. The Enterprise is committed to minimizing these disruptions and takes steps to limit traffic delays and noise.

Lane closures will generally take place during off-peak hours to reduce impact to drivers. Information about closures will be provided in advance in the South Florida and Treasure Coast Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.

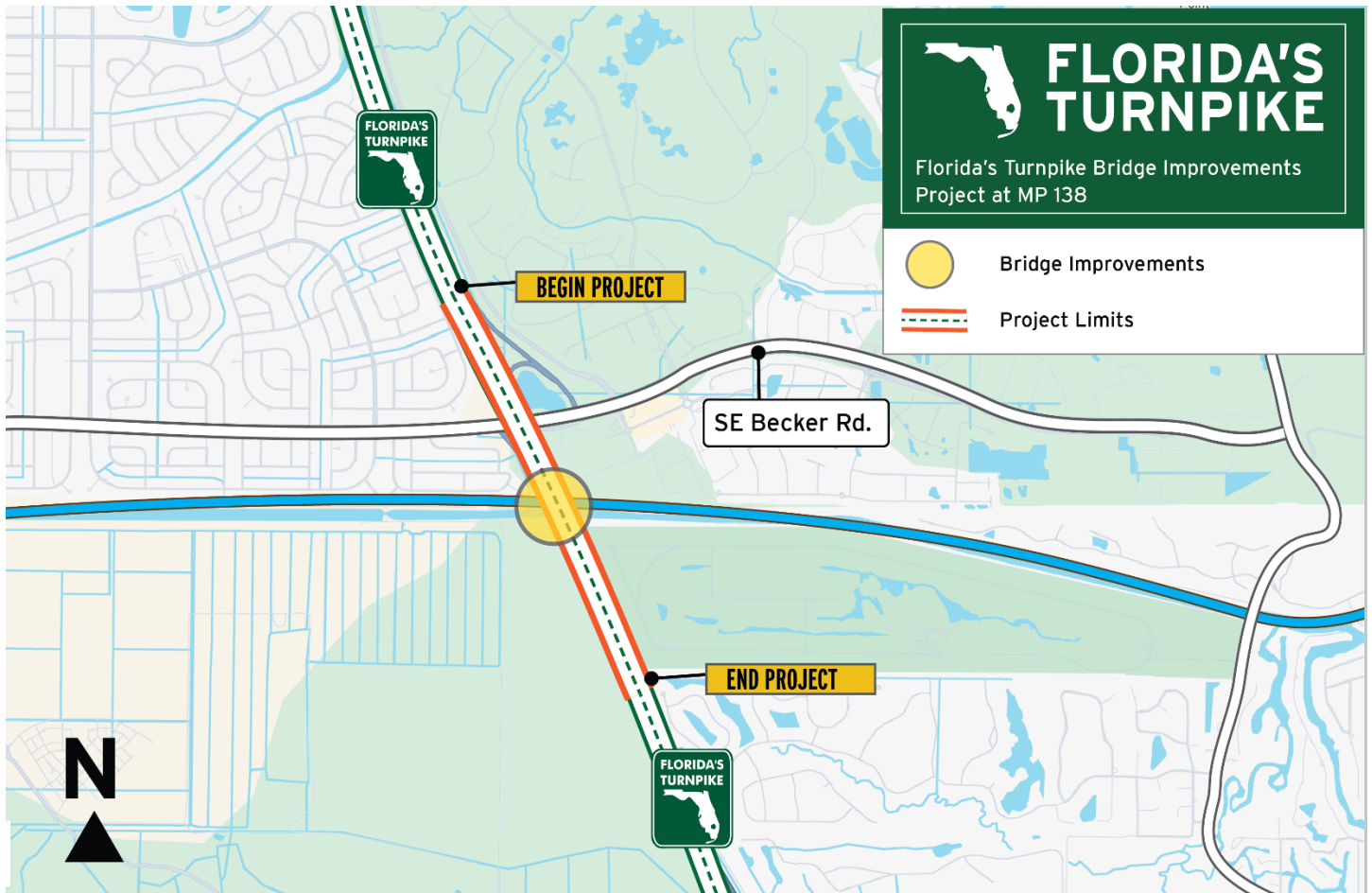
