



Central Turnpike Mainline/State Road 91 Widening Project

from North of Boynton Beach Boulevard to North of Lake Worth Road

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise (Enterprise) is widening the Central Turnpike Mainline/State Road (S.R.) 91 to four lanes in each direction, from north of Boynton Beach Boulevard/S.R. 804 to north of Lake Worth Road/S.R. 802 in Palm Beach County.

Project Benefits

- Shifting Central Turnpike Mainline between Boynton Beach Boulevard and Lake Worth Road to the west to avoid utility conflicts
- Reconstructing Hypoluxo Road bridge over the Turnpike to allow new road configuration
- Improving signage, pavement markings, signalization, lighting, and drainage
- Constructing sound walls along qualifying residential areas adjacent to Central Turnpike Mainline

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction will take place during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience periodic construction light, noise, and dust throughout the project's duration. The Enterprise takes steps to reduce construction impacts and efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions.

Lane closures will generally take place during off-peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers. Closures and detours will be announced in advance in the Central and West Central Florida Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.

Schedule and Funding

Construction Schedule:

Work is anticipated to be completed in 2027.

Project Cost:

The project cost is approximately \$170 million.

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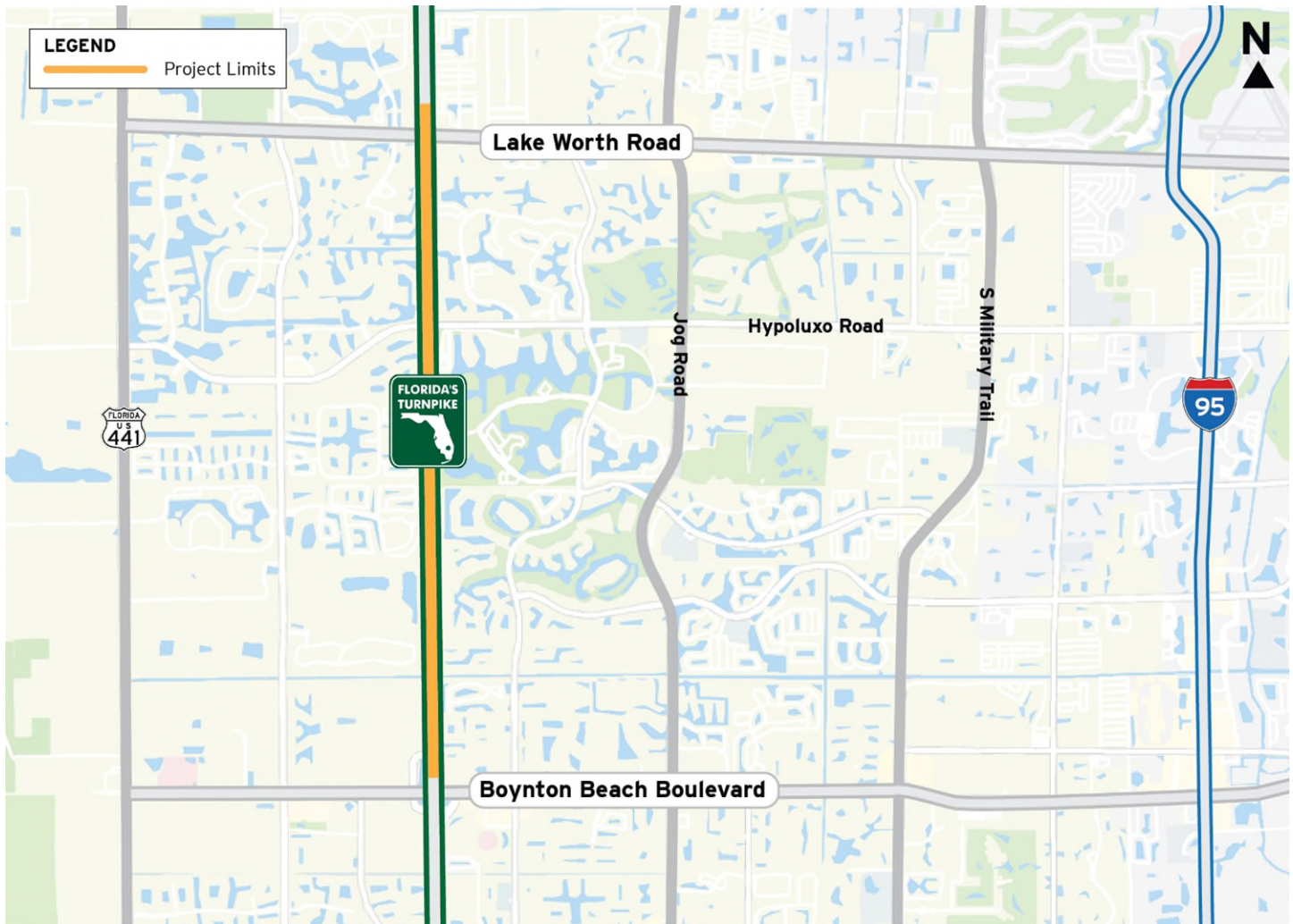
