



Suncoast Parkway Resurfacing and Safety Improvements Project

from North of Van Dyke Road to Hillsborough County Line

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is resurfacing approximately three miles of Suncoast Parkway/State Road (S.R.) 589 from north of Van Dyke Road/County Road (C.R.) 685A (milepost 14) to the Hillsborough County line (milepost 17) in Hillsborough County.

Project Benefits

- **Improved Rideability:** Resurfacing the existing travel lanes and shoulders to provide a smoother and more consistent driving experience.
- **Extended Roadway Life:** Replacing bridge joints on the northbound and southbound bridges to extend the service life of the roadway and improve long-term reliability.
- **Enhanced Safety:** Installing new signage, pavement markings, rumble strips, guardrails, lighting, and drainage improvements to improve visibility and enhance roadway conditions.

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction activities will occur during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience occasional impacts from construction-related light, noise, vibration, or dust. The Enterprise is committed to minimizing these disruptions and taking steps to limit traffic delays and noise.

Lane closures will generally take place during off-peak hours to reduce impacts to drivers. Information about closures will be provided in advance through the Central and West Central Florida Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.

Work is anticipated to continue through 2027.

The project cost is approximately \$6.6 million.

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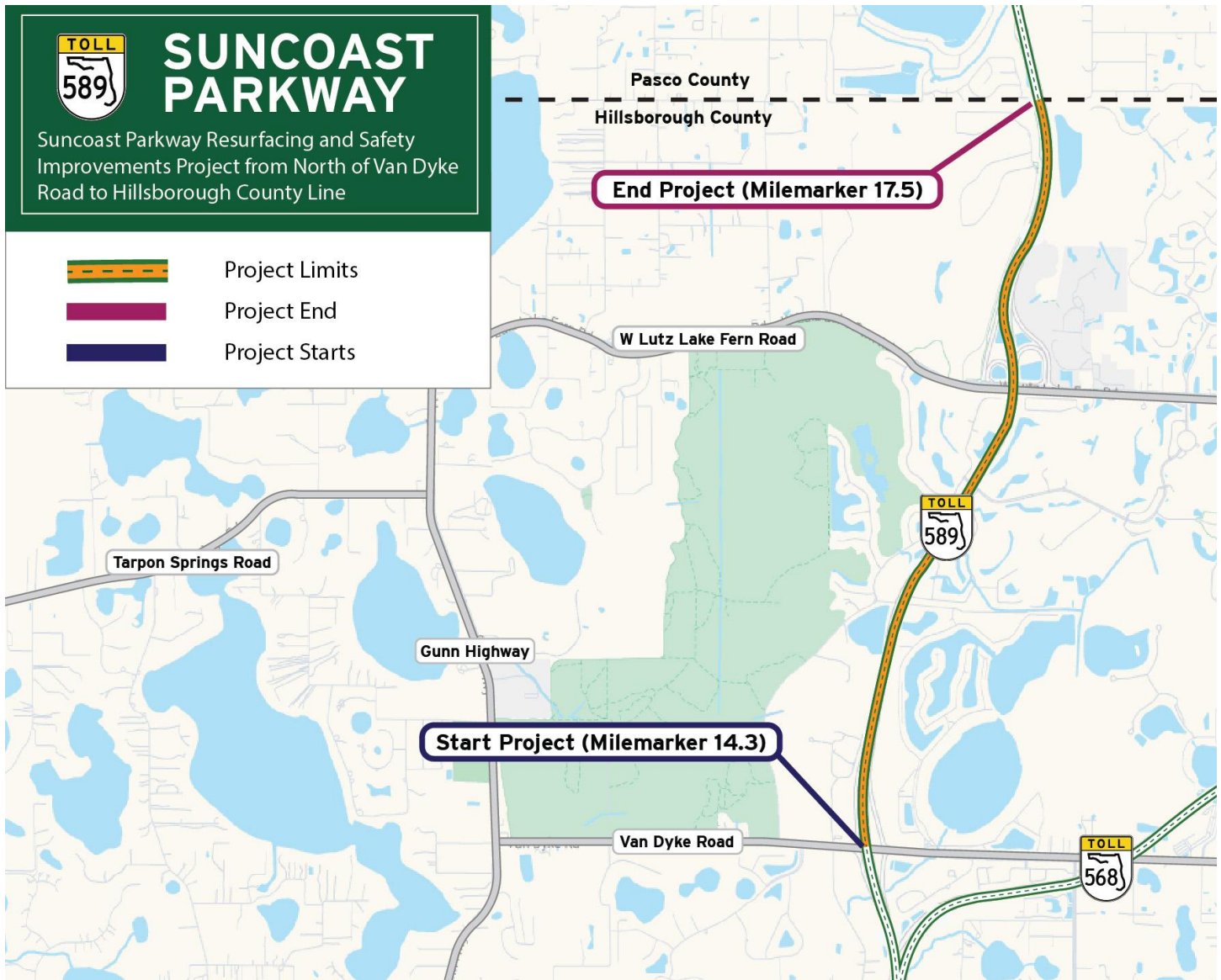
