
West Palm Beach Service Plaza Improvements Project

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is improving the existing West Palm Beach Service Plaza located at Milepost 94 on Florida's Turnpike/State Road (S.R.) 91.

Project Benefits

- Reducing congestion by widening northbound Florida's Turnpike from two to four lanes within plaza limits (inside lane to open after construction of adjacent projects).
- Enhancing traffic flow by consolidating all truck parking on the north side of the plaza.
- Adding truck parking and passenger parking spaces.
- Improving conditions by modifying the existing pond to accommodate truck parking, and reconfiguration of existing diesel fuel pumps.
- Increasing roadside safety by installing new, lighting system throughout the plaza limits and adjacent widened northbound travel lanes, highly reflective overhead signage, wrong way detection systems and pavement markings.

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction will take place during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience periodic construction light, noise, vibration, and dust throughout the project's duration. Florida's Turnpike Enterprise takes steps to reduce construction impacts, and efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions.

Lane closures will generally take place during off-peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers. Closures will be announced in advance in the South Florida and Treasure Coast Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.

Schedule and Funding

Construction Schedule:

Work is anticipated to continue through early 2027.

Project Cost:

The project cost is approximately \$32.4 million.

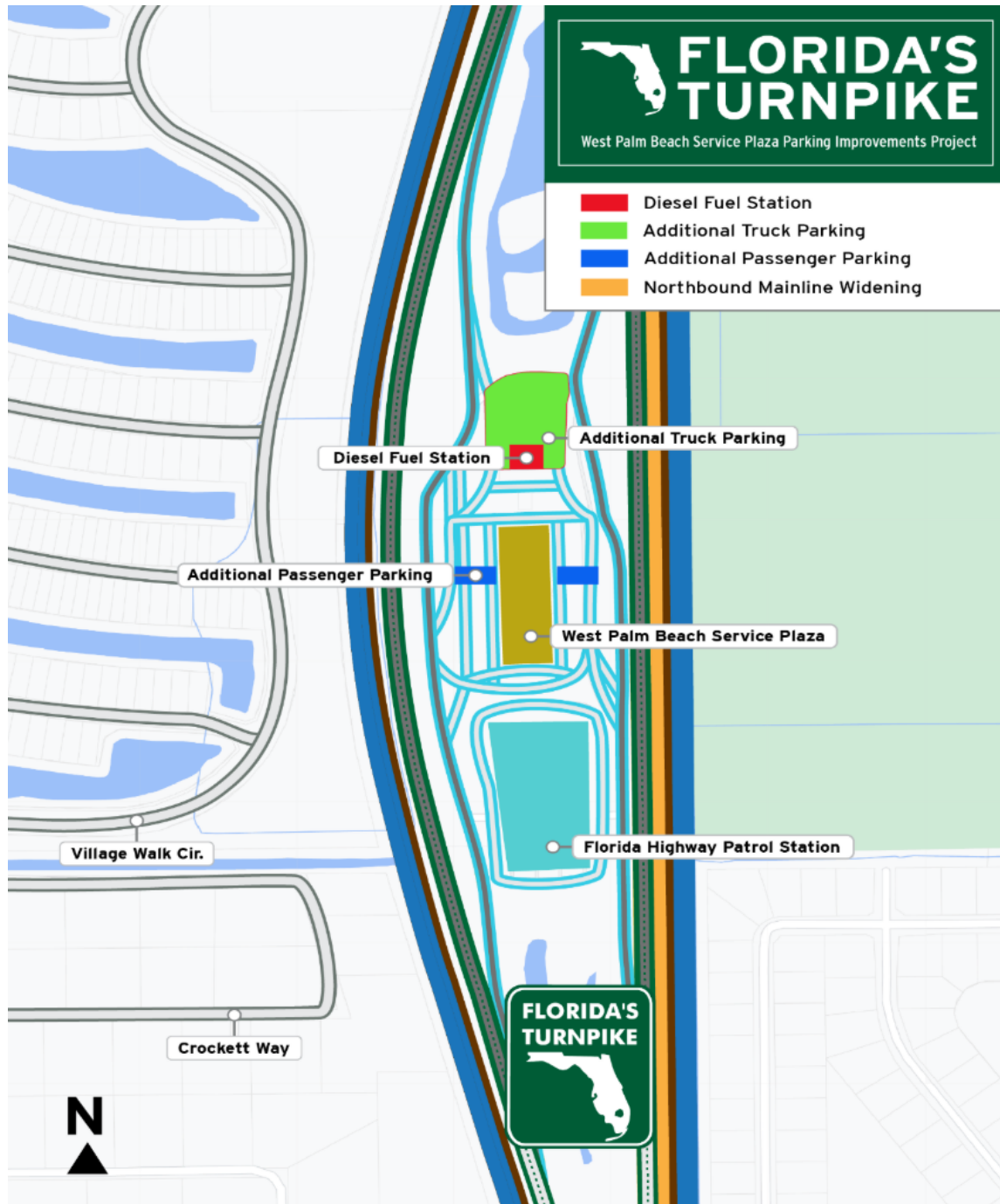
