



Florida's Turnpike Widening Project

from Partin Settlement Road to Osceola Parkway

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise (Enterprise) is widening Florida's Turnpike from two to four lanes in each direction, from Partin Settlement Road to Osceola Parkway in Osceola County. This project focuses on improving traffic flow, increasing safety, and supporting regional mobility for drivers, residents, and businesses.

Project Benefits

- **Increased Capacity:** Adding two new lanes in each direction and enhancing the interchange at Osceola Parkway to help ease congestion.
- **Improved Durability:** Reconstructing bridges throughout the project limits to increase roadway longevity and reinforce dependability.
- **Enhanced Safety:** Installing new roadway lighting, updated signage, fresh pavement markings, and guard railing to promote safer and more efficient travel.

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction activities will occur during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience occasional impacts from construction-related light, noise, vibration, or dust. The Enterprise is committed to minimizing these disruptions and takes steps to limit traffic delays and noise.

Lane closures will generally take place during off-peak hours to reduce impacts to drivers. Information about closures will be provided in advance through the Central and West Central Florida Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.

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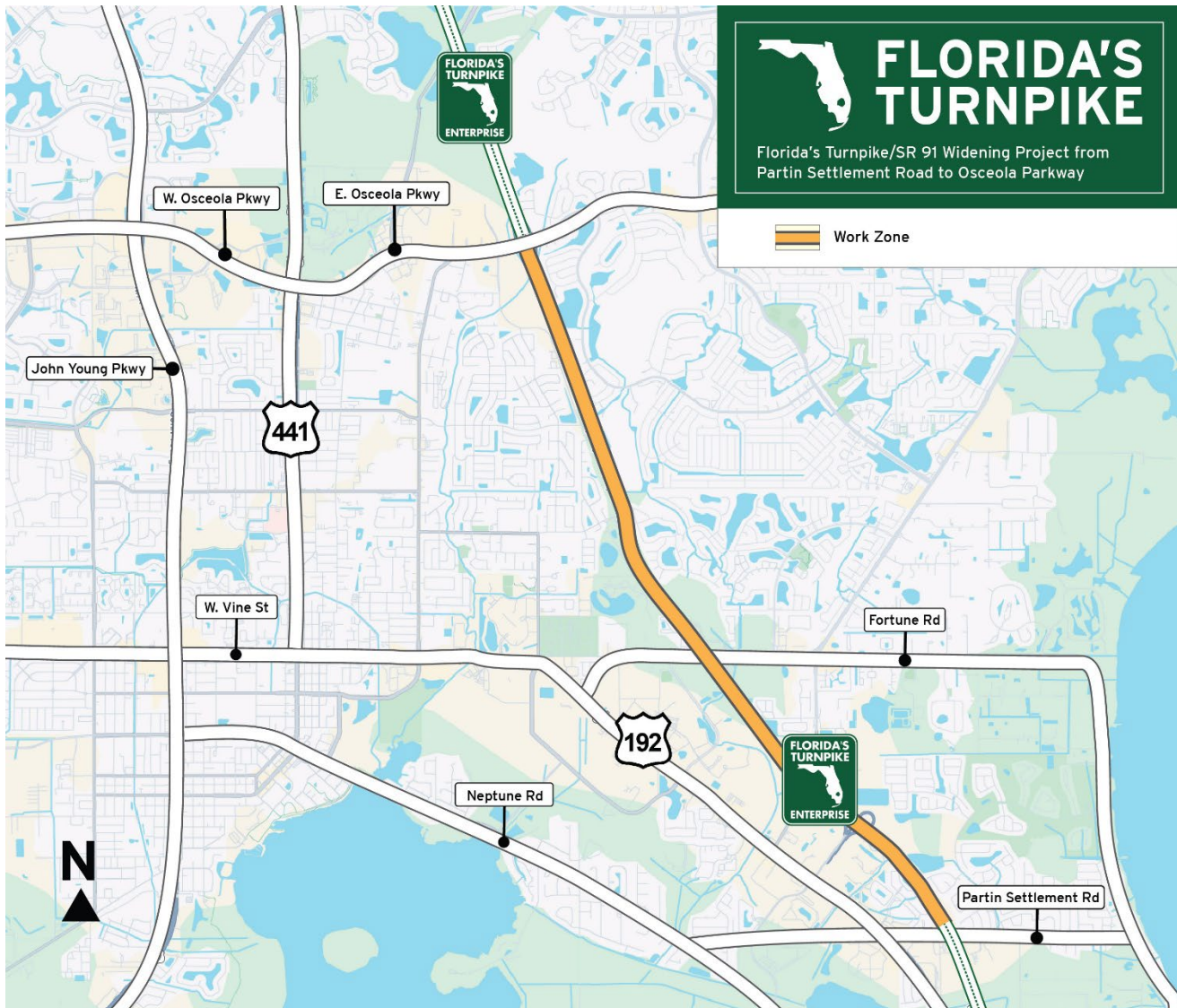
