FORT LAUDERDALE, Fla. — [Florida's Turnpike Enterprise](#) announces lane closures and work zone information for construction and maintenance projects in Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach, Martin, St. Lucie, Okeechobee and Indian River counties, for the week beginning Sunday, September 6. Motorists should drive with caution through the work zones and adhere to posted detour signs and speed limits. **Please pay special attention to the closures noted in red.**

Regularly scheduled construction and maintenance-related lane closures on Florida's Turnpike operated roads are suspended for the Labor Day holiday from 6 a.m. Friday, September 4, to 10 p.m. Monday, September 7, unless otherwise indicated below.

Tandem truckers should also pay special attention to the closures noted in red which include full road and ramp closures and closures of special significance.

TURNPIKE EXTENSION/STATE ROAD (S.R.) 821 WIDENING PROJECT FROM CAMPBELL DRIVE TO TALLAHASSEE ROAD

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 821 between Campbell Drive/SW 312 Street and Old Cutler Road (Milepost 3 to Milepost 7)

Overnight single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Tuesday, September 8, and nightly through Thursday, September 10.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 821 between Old Cutler Road and Campbell Drive/SW 312 Street (Milepost 7 to Milepost 3)

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 821 is being widened from four to six lanes from Campbell Drive/SW 312 Street to Tallahassee Road/SW 137 Avenue in Miami-Dade County. This project includes reconstructing the Turnpike bridges within the corridor, improving the interchanges at Biscayne Drive and Tallahassee Road and constructing a new northbound entrance ramp from Tallahassee Road. Construction is scheduled to continue through mid-2028. Approximate cost: \$99 million.

**TURNPIKE EXTENSION/S.R. 821 AND SURFACE STREET IMPROVEMENTS
FROM HAINLIN MILL ROAD/SW 216 STREET TO U.S. 1**

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 821 between Cutler Ridge Boulevard/SW 211 Street and U.S. 1 (Milepost 11 to Milepost 12.5)

Overnight single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 7 a.m., Tuesday, September 8, and nightly through Thursday, September 10.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 821 exit ramp to Caribbean Boulevard/SW 200 Street

Overnight single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6:30 a.m., Tuesday, September 8, and nightly through Thursday, September 10.

Eastbound Caribbean Boulevard/SW 200 Street between Turnpike South/Frontage Road South and Turnpike North/Frontage Road North

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 821 is being improved between Hainlin Mill Road/SW 216 Street and Caribbean Boulevard/SW 200 Street in Miami-Dade County. Work includes widening Hainlin Mill Road, Cutler Ridge Boulevard/SW 211 Street, the northbound Turnpike bridge over Caribbean Boulevard, westbound Eureka Drive underneath the Turnpike and southbound Frontage Road. Additional improvements include bridge repairs, noise walls along qualifying residential areas, upgrading signalization, pedestrian features, and lighting. Construction is scheduled to continue through mid-2027. Approximate cost: \$37 million.

**TURNPIKE EXTENSION/S.R. 821 WIDENING PROJECT
FROM NW 106 STREET TO INTERSTATE 75 (I-75)**

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 821 between NW 106 Street and I-75 (Milepost 34 to Milepost 39)

Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, September 8, and nightly through Thursday, September 10.

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 821 entrance and exit ramps at Flagler Station Boulevard/NW 106 Street (Exit 34)

Overnight full ramp closures, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, September 8, and nightly through Thursday, September 10.

Detour information:

- Flagler Station Boulevard/NW 106 Street/NW 116 Way traffic wishing to access northbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 821 will be directed to Okeechobee Road/U.S. 27, and travel west on Okeechobee Road to access northbound Florida's Turnpike.
- Flagler Station Boulevard/NW 106 Street/NW 116 Way traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 821 will be directed to NW 112 Avenue, travel south on NW 112 Avenue to NW 90 Street, travel east on NW 90 Street to NW 107 Avenue, travel south on NW 107 Avenue to NW 74 Street, and travel west on NW 74 Street to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.
- Northbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 821 traffic wishing to access Flagler Station Boulevard/NW 106 Street (Exit 34) will be directed to exit at Okeechobee Road/U.S. 27 (Exit 35), and travel east on Okeechobee Road/U.S. 27 to access NW 116 Way/NW 106 Street/Hialeah Gardens Boulevard.
- Southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 821 traffic wishing to access Flagler Station Boulevard/NW 106 Street (Exit 34) will be directed to exit at Okeechobee Road/U.S. 27 (Exit 35), and travel east on Okeechobee Road to access NW 116 Way/NW 106 Street/Hialeah Gardens Boulevard.

** Please note, the northbound and southbound entrance and exit ramps will not be closed at the same time.*

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 821 entrance and exit ramps at Okeechobee Road/U.S. 27 (Exit 35)

Overnight full ramp closures, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, September 8, and nightly through Thursday, September 10.

Detour information:

- Okeechobee Road/U.S. 27 traffic wishing to access northbound or southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 821 will be directed to Hialeah Gardens Boulevard/NW 116 Way/NW 106 Street, and travel west on NW 116 Way/NW 106 Street to access northbound or southbound Florida's Turnpike.
- Northbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 821 traffic wishing to access Okeechobee Road/U.S. 27 (Exit 35) will be directed to exit at Flagler Station Boulevard/NW 106 Street (Exit 34), and travel east on NW 106 Street to access Okeechobee Road.
- Okeechobee Road/U.S. 27 traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 821 will be directed to Hialeah Gardens Boulevard/NW 116 Way/NW 106 Street and travel west on NW 116 Way to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.
- Southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 821 traffic wishing to access Okeechobee Road/U.S. 27 (Exit 35) will be directed to exit at Flagler Station Boulevard/NW 106 Street (Exit 34), and travel east on NW 106 Street to access Okeechobee Road.

** Please note, the northbound and southbound entrance and exit ramps will not be closed at the same time. Additionally, this closure will not occur at the same time as the Flagler Station Boulevard/NW 106 Street ramps.*

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 821 exit ramp to northbound I-75 (Exit 39)

Overnight full ramp closures, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, September 8, and nightly through Thursday, September 10.

Detour information:

- Northbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 821 traffic wishing to access northbound I-75 (Exit 39) will be directed to exit at Flagler Station Boulevard/NW 106 Street (Exit 34), and travel east on Flagler Station Boulevard/NW 106 Street/NW 116 Way/Hialeah Gardens Boulevard to access northbound I-75.

** The northbound Florida's Turnpike exit ramp to northbound I-75 Express exit ramp remain open during this closure.*

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 821 entrance ramp from southbound I-75

Overnight full ramp closures, 10 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, September 8, and nightly through Thursday, September 10.

Detour information:

- Southbound I-75 traffic wishing to access southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 821 (Exit 5) will be directed to exit at Graham Dairy Road/NW 138 Street (Exit 2), travel south on NW 138 Street to Hialeah Gardens Boulevard/NW 116 Way, and travel southwest on Hialeah Gardens Boulevard/NW 116 Way to access southbound Florida's Turnpike.

** The southbound I-75 Express exit ramp to southbound Florida's Turnpike will remain open during this closure.*

Eastbound and westbound Okeechobee Road/U.S. 27 between NW 138 Street and NW 118 Avenue

Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, September 8, and nightly through Friday, September 11.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 821 is being widened to 10 lanes between NW 106 Street and I-75. The project entails constructing a new eastbound Okeechobee Road to southbound Florida's Turnpike entrance ramp and a new northbound Florida's Turnpike exit ramp to eastbound Okeechobee Road, as well as an additional lane in each direction on Okeechobee Road between west of the Turnpike and NW 107 Avenue. Work also consists of constructing a new diverging diamond interchange at Florida's Turnpike and NW 170 Street. Resurfacing, guardrail and fencing, lane striping, stormwater drainage, signage and lighting improvements will also be installed as part of this project. Construction will continue through mid-2026. Approximate cost: \$370 million.

GOLDEN GLADES INTERCHANGE (GGI) PROJECT

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 between Miami Gardens Drive/NW 183 Street and I-95

Overnight single and double lane closure, 10 p.m. Monday, September 7, to 6 a.m. Tuesday, September 8.

Overnight single and double lane closures, 9 p.m. to 5 a.m., Tuesday, September 8, and nightly through Thursday, September 10.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/S.R. 91 TRANSPORTATION SYSTEMS MANAGEMENT & OPERATIONS (TSM&O) PROJECT FROM TURNPIKE EXTENSION/S.R. 821 TO GRIFFIN ROAD/S.R. 818

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 between Turnpike Extension/S.R. 821 and Griffin Road/S.R. 818 (Milepost 47 to Milepost 54)

Overnight single lane closure, 10 p.m. Monday, September 7, to 6 a.m. Tuesday, September 8.

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Tuesday, September 8, and nightly through Thursday, September 10. A second lane may close at 9 p.m. and reopen by 5 a.m.

Eastbound and westbound Hollywood Boulevard/S.R. 820 between SW 64 Way and N 61 Avenue

Overnight single lane closure, 10 p.m. Monday, September 7, to 6 a.m. Tuesday, September 8.

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Tuesday, September 8, and nightly through Thursday, September 10.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Auxiliary Lanes are being added to Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 from the Turnpike Extension/S.R. 821 to Griffin Road/S.R. 818. This project will increase roadway capacity, reduce congestion and improve travel times. The project also includes safety improvements at Hollywood Boulevard/S.R. 820 and SW 63 Terrace by closing the median to reduce vehicle conflict points and accidents, and at Hollywood Boulevard and S. 62 Avenue by eliminating the eastbound and westbound turn lanes. Construction will continue through mid-2029. Approximate cost: \$230 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/S.R. 91 TSM&O PROJECT FROM SOUTH OF SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/S.R. 869 TO NORTH OF GLADES ROAD/S.R. 808

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 between Sawgrass Expressway/S.R. 869 one mile north of Glades Road/S.R. 808 (Milepost 71 and Milepost 77)

Overnight single and double lane closure, 10 p.m. Monday, September 7, to 6 a.m. Tuesday, September 8.

Overnight single and double lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Tuesday, September 8, and nightly through Thursday, September 10.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 is undergoing significant enhancements between south of Sawgrass Expressway/S.R. 869 (milepost 71) and north of Glades Road/S.R. 808 (milepost 76) in Broward and Palm Beach counties. As part of these improvements, a new lane is being added in each direction within the project limits to increase capacity, reduce congestion, and enhance safety. This project also includes installing new roadway lighting, signage, fresh pavement markings, and upgrading the intelligent transportation system to promote safer and more efficient travel. Noise walls will be constructed along qualifying residential areas. Construction will continue through 2029. Approximate cost: \$100 million.

**SAWGRASS EXPRESSWAY/S.R. 869 WIDENING
PROJECT FROM ATLANTIC BOULEVARD TO SAMPLE ROAD/S.R. 834**

Northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway/S.R. 869 between north of Atlantic Boulevard and north of Sample Road/S.R. 834 (Milepost 9 to Milepost 12)

Overnight single and double lane closure, 10 p.m. Monday, September 7, to 6 a.m. Tuesday, September 8.

Overnight single and double lane closures, 8:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Tuesday, September 8, and nightly through Thursday, September 10.

Northbound and southbound Sawgrass Expressway/S.R. 869 entrance and exit ramps at Sample Road/S.R. 834 (Exit 11)

Overnight full ramp closures, 11:30 p.m. to 6 a.m., Monday, September 7, and nightly through Thursday, September 10.

Detour information:

- Sample Road/S.R. 834 traffic wishing to access northbound Sawgrass Expressway/S.R. 869 will be directed to Coral Ridge Drive, and travel north on Coral Ridge Drive to access northbound Sawgrass Expressway.
- Sample Road/S.R. 834 traffic wishing to access southbound Sawgrass Expressway/S.R. 869 will be directed to Coral Ridge Drive, travel south on Coral Ridge Drive to Atlantic Boulevard, and travel west on Atlantic Boulevard to access southbound Sawgrass Expressway.
- Northbound Sawgrass Expressway/S.R. 869 traffic wishing to access Sample Road/S.R. 834 (Exit 11) will be directed to exit at Atlantic Boulevard (Exit 8), travel east on Atlantic Boulevard to Coral Ridge Drive, and travel north on Coral Ridge Drive to access Sample Road.
- Southbound Sawgrass Expressway/S.R. 869 traffic wishing to access Sample Road/S.R. 834 (Exit 11) will be directed to exit at Coral Ridge Drive (Exit 14), and travel south on Coral Ridge Drive to access Sample Road.

** Please note, the northbound and southbound entrance and exit ramps will not be closed at the same time.*

Eastbound Sample Road/S.R. 834 between Sawgrass Expressway/S.R. 869 and west of Sportsplex Drive

Daytime single and double lane closures, 7 a.m. to 3 p.m., Tuesday, September 8, and daily through Friday, September 11.

Westbound Sample Road/S.R. 834 between Sawgrass Expressway/S.R. 869 and west of Sportsplex Drive

Daytime single and double lane closures, 9 a.m. to 3 p.m., Tuesday, September 8, and daily through Friday, September 11.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Sawgrass Expressway/S.R. 869 is being widened from six to 10 lanes from north of Atlantic Boulevard to north of Sample Road/S.R. 834, in Broward County. The new lanes constructed as part of this project will open upon completion of future adjacent widening projects. The Sample Road interchange will be converted to a partial diverging diamond interchange. Construction will continue through early 2028. Approximate cost: \$99.7 million.

CENTRAL TURNPIKE MAINLINE/S.R. 91 (Mileposts 86 to 188)
PALM BEACH, MARTIN, ST. LUCIE, and OKEECHOBEE COUNTIES

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/S.R. 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM NORTH OF BOYNTON BEACH BOULEVARD/S.R. 804 TO NORTH OF LAKE WORTH ROAD/S.R. 802

Northbound and Southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 between Boynton Beach Boulevard/S.R. 804 and north of Lake Worth Road/S.R. 802 (Milepost 87 to Milepost 95)

Overnight single lane closure, 10 p.m. Monday, September 7, to 6 a.m., Tuesday, September 8.
Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Tuesday, September 8, and nightly through Thursday, September 10.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 is being widened to four lanes in each direction, from north of Boynton Beach Boulevard/S.R. 804 to north of Boynton Beach Boulevard/S.R. 804. This project also includes reconstructing the Hypoluxo Road bridge over Southern Turnpike Mainline to allow for the new road configuration. Additionally, sound barrier walls will be constructed along qualifying residential areas. Bridge widening, road milling and resurfacing, signage and signal improvements are planned. Construction will continue through early 2026. Approximate cost: \$170 million.

**WEST PALM BEACH SERVICE PLAZA
PARKING IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT**

Northbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 between south of Lake Worth Road/S.R. 802 and south of Southern Boulevard/U.S. 98/S.R. 80 (Milepost 94 to Milepost 95)

Overnight single lane closures, 10 p.m. to 6 a.m., Tuesday, September 8, and nightly through Thursday, September 10.

Southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 exit ramp to West Palm Beach Service Plaza (Milepost 94)

Overnight full ramp closures, 10 p.m. Wednesday, September 9, to 6 a.m. Thursday, September 10. If necessary, this closure may also occur from 10 p.m. Thursday, September 10, to 6 a.m. Friday, September 11.

Detour information:

- Southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 traffic wishing to access the West Palm Beach Service Plaza will be directed to southbound Florida's Turnpike, travel south on Florida's Turnpike to exit at Lake Worth Road/S.R. 802 (Exit 93), travel east on Lake Worth Road to the northbound Florida's Turnpike entrance ramp, and travel north on Florida's Turnpike to access the West Palm Beach Service Plaza.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The truck parking facility at the West Palm Beach Service Plaza is being improved. Truck parking will be consolidated in the northern section of the service plaza to enhance traffic flow and increase the number of available truck spaces. Construction will continue through late 2026. Approximate cost: \$32.4 million.

**FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/S.R. 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM
WEST PALM BEACH SERVICE PLAZA TO NORTH OF SOUTHERN BOULEVARD/U.S. 98/S.R. 80**

Eastbound Southern Boulevard/US 98/SR 80 between Pike Road and Drawdy Road

Overnight full closure, 10 p.m. Wednesday, September 9, to 6 a.m. Thursday, September 10.

Detour information:

- Eastbound Southern Boulevard/US 98/SR 80 traffic wishing to continue east will be directed to Pike Road, travel north on Pike Road to Belvedere Road, travel east on Belvedere Road to Jog Road, and travel south on Jog Road to access eastbound Southern Boulevard.

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 between West Palm Beach Service Plaza to north of Southern Boulevard/U.S. 98/S.R. 80

Overnight single lane closure, 10 p.m. Monday, September 7, to 6 a.m. Tuesday, September 8.

Overnight single lane closures, 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. Tuesday, September 8, and nightly through Thursday, September 10.

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 is being widened from two to four lanes, in each direction, from West Palm Beach Service Plaza to north of Southern Boulevard/U.S. 98/S.R. 80 in Palm Beach County. This project includes reconstructing the Turnpike bridges over Forest Hill Boulevard/S.R. 882, Southern Boulevard, and Belvedere Road. Additionally, sound barrier walls will be constructed along qualifying residential areas. Safety upgrades feature the installation of new highly reflective overhead signage and pavement markings, designed for optimal visibility in all lighting and weather conditions. Construction will continue through early 2030. Approximate cost: \$258 million.

FLORIDA'S TURNPIKE/S.R. 91 WIDENING PROJECT FROM NORTH OF SOUTHERN BOULEVARD TO NORTH OF OKEECHOBEE BOULEVARD/S.R. 704

Northbound and southbound Florida's Turnpike/S.R. 91 between Jog Road and north of Okeechobee Boulevard/S.R. 704 (Milepost 98 to Milepost 101)

Overnight single lane closure, 10 p.m. Monday, September 7, to 6 a.m. Tuesday, September 8.

Overnight single lane closures, 8 p.m. to 6 a.m., Tuesday, September 8, and nightly through Thursday, September 10.

Eastbound and westbound Okeechobee Boulevard/S.R. 704 between Vista Parkway and West Drive

Overnight single lane closure, 10 p.m. Monday, September 7, to 6:30 a.m. Tuesday, September 8.
