



Florida's Turnpike/State Road 91 Widening Project

from South of O'Brien Road to North of U.S. 27 North

Project Description

Florida's Turnpike Enterprise is widening the Turnpike Mainline/State Road (S.R.) 91 from north of O'Brien Road to north of U.S. 27 North (mileposts 285 to 289), in Lake County.

Project Benefits

- **Increased Capacity:** Adding two lanes in each direction along the Turnpike from north O'Brien Road to north of U.S. 27 North to accommodate more vehicles and support growing travel demand.
- **Improved Traffic Flow:** Installing new toll gantries at the U.S. 27 North interchange ramps to provide more efficient tolling points and smoother travel through the interchange.
- **Extended Service Life:** Reconstructing the O'Brien Road bridge over the Turnpike and the Turnpike bridge over U.S. 27 to strengthen the structures and enhance their durability.
- **Strengthened Roadside Safety:** Installing new signage, highly reflective signage and pavement markings, lighting and drainage improvements, and upgraded Intelligent Transportation Systems.

Construction and Traffic Impacts

Construction will take place during both daytime and nighttime hours. Nearby residents and businesses may experience periodic construction light, noise, vibration, and dust through the project's duration. The Enterprise takes steps to reduce construction impacts and efforts will be made to limit traffic and noise disruptions.

Lane closures will generally take place during off-peak hours to minimize traffic congestion and delays for most drivers. Closures will be announced in advance in the Central and West Central Florida Weekly Lane Closures and Work Zone Advisory.

Schedule and Funding

Construction Schedule:

Work is anticipated to continue through mid-2030.

Project Cost:

The project cost is approximately \$132 million.

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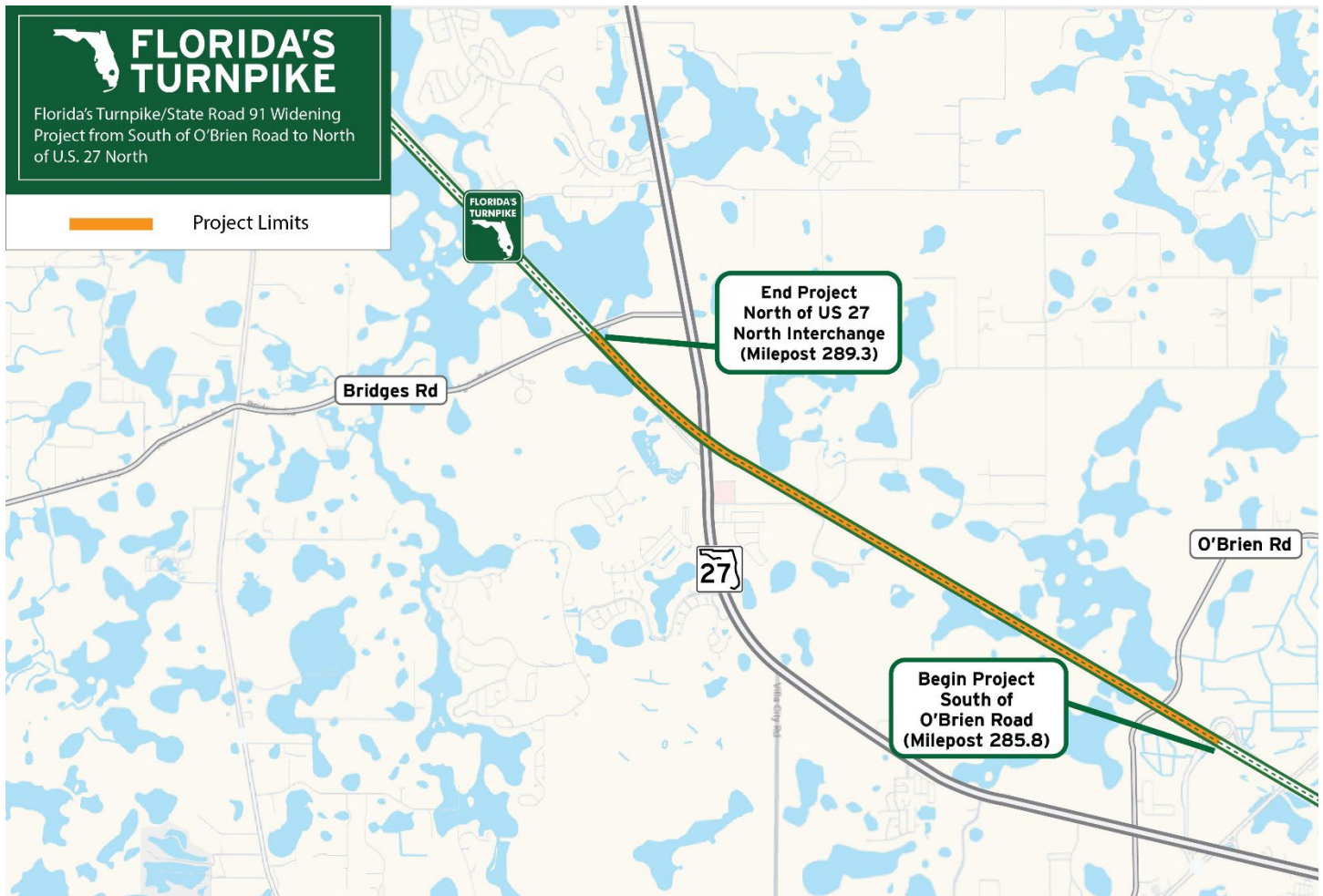
